Yesterday's 6-5 loss to Nashville pushed the Storm Chasers out of first place and into a two-way tie for second place with the lowa Cubs.

Omaha has been in either 1st or second place after 6 of their last 7 games, and 9 of 16 games this season... the Storm Chasers have spent four days in first place, including two days in sole possession of the top spot in the league.

Scranton/WB sits just 0.5 game ahead of Omaha in the standings, with an 11-5 record... the Railfiders opened the year 3-4 but have won 8 of their last 9 games.

Pratto has homered in each of his last three games, the second Storm Chaser to homer in 3 straight games this year, already the fourth to homer in back-to-back games in 2024. In 2021, Pratto had separate stretches of home runs in 4 straight games, August

19 to 22, then long balls in 3 consecutive games, August 25 to 27 ... he previously homered in back-to-back games three times in 2022.

EATON IT UP

Nate Eaton's 9-game hitting streak entering play today ranks tied 2nd in the International League, creeping closer on his career-best streak.

Over his last 9 games, Eaton is hitting .455 (15-for-33) with a 1.107 OPS ... his average is the highest in the league among 6 players with 7+ game streaks.

In his career, Eaton's career-best is a 10-game hitting streak, which he's done 3 times, most recently from June 8 to 19, 2022 with Omaha, where he hit .385 (15-for-39).

Eaton also enters today on a 10-game on-base streak, tied with Drew Waters for the longest streak on the team this year ... over those 10 games, he has a .500 on-base percentage, with 3 walks in addition to 15 hits (.455 average).

PUSHING P(ORTER)

Storm Chasers catcher **Logan Porter** was named the International League's Player of the Week last week, after one of the top offensive performances in Minor League Baseball.

Porter led the league last week with a 1.400 slugging percentage and 2.050 OPS, going 8-for-15 (.533 average) at the plate against the Stripers.

6 of Porter's 8 hits last week went for extra bases, with 2 doubles, 1 triple and 3 home runs for a team-best 21 total bases ... he homered in three straight games – April 9, 11 and 12 – and drove in 7 runs, while tying for the team lead with 4 walks and stealing the third base of his career.

Porter has a 6-game hitting streak entering today, where he is 11-for-24 (.458).




