## SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (88-50) vs. MIDLAND ROCKHOUNDS (66-72) LHP IXAN HENDERSON (9-7, 2.59 ERA) vs. LHP GAGE JUMP (5-6, 3.64 ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** The Cardinals travel to Texas' Permian Basin to visit Midland (A's) for Game 2 of the best-of-3 Texas League Championship Series ... RockHounds lead the series, 1-0, after a 6-3 win in Sunday's Game 1 ... Game 3 (if nec.) is Wednesday at Momentum Bank Ballpark.

**HEN'S HOUSE:** LHP Ixan Henderson makes his 2nd postseason start in Game 2 ... picked up the win in Game 1 of NDS at Tulsa after pitching 6.0-shutout innings ... allowed 3 hits, struck out 4, and did not issue a walk ... started once vs. MID in regular season and allowed 2 runs on 3 hits over 4.2 IP in a no-decision on 8/3 at Hammons Field ... finished season ranked 1st in TXL among qualified starters in ERA (2.59), 2nd in WHIP (1.15) and tied 4th with 134 strikeouts.

**GAME 1:** Springfield fell, 6-3, at home on Sunday in the opening game of the series ... IF Jeremy Rivas hit a go-ahead 2-run HR in the 2nd inning but the Cardinals didn't score after that ... IF Leo De Vries hit 2 HRs for RockHounds including a go-ahead shot in the 7th ... LHP Pete Hansen allowed only 1 run over 5.0 IP in the start.

**KINGS OF THE NORTH:** Springfield advanced to its 1st TXLCS since 2012 by sweeping Tulsa in the NDS ... Cardinals won both 1st and 2nd half North titles ... marked the 2nd time in franchise history (2007) the team won both halves ... finished with TXL's best record at 88-50.

**WE MESS WITH TEXAS:** Springfield went 21-3 in games played in the stat of Texas this season ... went 40-8 vs. the South Division overall.

**YOU FROM MIDLAND:** Springfield and Midland played only 1 series during the regular season ... Cards swept the 6-game set from 8/26 to 8/31 including 3-straight walk-off wins to end the series ... this marks the 1st-ever postseason matchup between Springfield and Midland ... the RockHounds have won 6 TXL titles outright and have 1 shared title ... their last championship was in 2017, which capped off 4-straight titles ... Midland lost in the TXL to Arkansas last year.

**AWARD WINNERS:** The Texas League postseason awards were announced on Wednesday ... IF JJ Wetherholt was named TXL MVP, LHP Ixan Henderson earned TXL Pitcher of the Year honors, and Patrick Anderson was named the Manager of the Year ... Wetherholt, Henderson, OF Joshua Baez, and LHP Brycen Mautz were all named postseason All-Stars ... is the Cards 4th-straight year winning MVP (C Jimmy Crooks, OF Thomas Saggese, and OF Moises Gomez) ... is the 2nd-straight season winning Pitcher of the Year (RHP Tink Hence) and Manager of the Year (Jose Leger).

**PLAYOFFS PAST:** The Cardinals are in the playoffs for the 3rd-straight year and 8th time overall ... lost in NDS to Arkansas the last 2 seasons ... have advanced 2 TXL Championship Series twice (2007 & 2012) and won it all once (2012).

**HEAR, HEAR:** Radio broadcast for tonight's game available on Cardinals radio home, Classic Rock 106.7 FM, and springfieldcardinals.com ... Jason Schwartz provides the play-by-play.
