BROOKLYN CYCLONES (32-33, 32-33) vs. Jersey Shore Blueglaws (38-27, 38-27)

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones saw their losing skid pushed to three games in a 2-0 loss to Jersey Shore on Wednesday night...The contest marked the eighth time this season Brooklyn was held scoreless in a game...The only runs of the contest came on a two-run single from 2B William Bergolla in the fourth... Despite the loss, the 'Clones outhit the BlueClaws for a second straight night, collecting seven hits to Jersey Shore's six...RHP Jonathan Pintaro impressed in just his second start and third overall appearance with Brooklyn, spinning six innings of two-run ball, but suffered his second defeat...RHP Henry Henry tossed a scoreless inning of relief in his Cyclones debut, striking out two... Brooklyn left nine men total on-base, and left at least one man on in seven of the nine frames...The win keeps Jersey Shore's first-half hopes alive - the Blue-Claws can win the North Division's first-half title with a win AND a Greensboro loss on Thursday.

SUPER STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old tallied a career-high-tying four hits in last Sunday's loss at Hudson Valley...Consuegra has accomplished the feat four times, most recently on April 13, 2023, at Winston-Salem...He is also the second Cyclone to reach that mark in 2024, joining OF Nick Morabito (5/28 @ JS)...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, he's hitting .306/.415/.571 with a .986 OPS... The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 14 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 65 points (171 to .236) and his OPS by 227 points (.519 to .746) during the stretch... Since that date, the right-handed slugger is tied for third in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for fourth in doubles (8), fifth in total bases (56), eighth in slugging (.571) and OPS (.986), and tied for eighth in RBI (20)... On Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL Jaylen Palmer (204) for the most games played in franchise history (205)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (185) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF Ronny Mauricio (63) for single-season RBI.

JOLTIN' JEFREY: IF/OF Jefrey De Los Santos is in the midst of perhaps his best stretch of the 2024 season...The Higüey, D.R. native has already notched six multi-hit games in June...During the calendar month, De Los Santos has hit safely in all but three games...The left-handed swinger is tied for second in the league in triples (2), eighth in slugging (.609) and OPS (1.032), and ninth in batting average (.348) in the month...Since May 16, the 21-year-old is second on the 'Clones in batting average (.286) and OPS (.896), trailing only OF **Stanley Consuegra** in both categories.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has been one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League throughout 2024...The 23-year-old is tied for ninth in the circuit in extra-base hits (23), 10th in total bases (97), and tied for 10th in RBI (35)...Lorusso is tied for third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in triples (3), fourth in OPS (.831) and slugging (.471), fifth in extra-base hits (23), and tied for fifth in home runs (9) and RBI (35).

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (32), and ninth in on-base percentage (.441)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is second in the league in steals (21), tied for second in runs scored (29), 10th in on-base percentage (.385) and tied for 10th in hits (40).

JUNIOR MINTS: INF Junior Tilien enters play with the second-longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, and fourth-longest of the year, reaching in 24 consecutive games since Game I of a doubleheader on May I6 at Bowling Green...Greenville OF Allen Castro has the longest active streak in the circuit at 25 games...Greenville's INF Kristian Campbell reached in 34-straight contests from April I1 to May 31, the SAL's longest run in 2024...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .270/.364/.393 slash line with a .757 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, I1 RBI, and I4 walks...The Infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF José Peroza reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilien also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9... He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped the last home series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs,

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn returns home for a six-game series, including the final three games of the season's first half, against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore boasts seven of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF Aidan Miller (2), OF Justin Crawford (4), INF William Bergolla (11), OF Emaarion Boyd (16), OF Hendry Mendez (22), LHP Sam Aldegheri (23), RHP George Klassen (28)... The Cyclones split both series played in 2024 at Shore Town Ballpark, going 6-6 in 12 contests...Brooklyn does not return to Jersey Shore in the 2024 regular season, hosting the final 15 meetings...In 2023, Brooklyn dropped the season series to the Jersey Shore, 15-11...The Cyclones were 11-6 in Lakewood and 4-5 on Coney Island...Dating back to 2021, Brooklyn leads the all-time series, 52-45 (.536).

and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 22 of 23 games, hitting .278/.420/.443 with an .863 OPS...The Bronx native has scored a whopping 20 runs with a double, four home runs, 18 RBI, and 19 walks...Since that date, Suero is tied for fifth in the SAL in walks (19), tied for ninth in runs scored (20), and 10th in on-base percentage (.420)...The third-year pro has also reached in 11-straight contests since June 6...Suero is hitting .316/.460/.579 with a 1.039 OPS in that span, accumulating 10 runs, a double, three home runs, 13 RBI, and 11 walks to 12 strikeouts.

OH, HENRY!: The Oyclones added RHP Henry Henry from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 25-year-old made his Brooklyn debut on June 19th vs. Jersey Shore, tossing one scoreless inning of relief work where he accumulated two strikeouts and allowed one hit...Signed by New York as a minor league free agent on May 16, the San Cristobal, D.R. native spent the first eight seasons of his professional career in the San Diego Padres...Between High-A Fort Wayne and Double-A San Antonio, Henry was 3-4 with a 5.19 ERA (29 ER in 50.1 IP) with 35 walks and 37 strikeouts in 34 appearances (three starts) in 2023...Henry Henry is not to be confused with former Pittsburgh Pirates infield prospect Henry Henry or the Cyclones' legendary on-field emcee King Henry.

WALK THIS WAY: INF William Lugo has had a keen eye at the plate in 2024, drawing 47 walks...That number ranks second in the South Atlantic League, while his 19.9% walk rate is first...Among minor leaguers with 230 or more plate appearances, Lugo sits fourth in walk rate...Major League Baseball's top prospect and Triple-A Norfolk's (Baltimore) SS Jackson Holliday, as well as Lugo's former Cyclone teammate and Double-A Binghamton's IF/OF Ryan Clifford are tied for the MiLB lead (22.0%).

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs Dakota Hawkins (5.0 IP), Joey Lancellotti (1.0), and Joshua Cornielly (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history June 4's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP Brandon Moore tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is one of four no-hitters in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP Joander Suárez hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP Sal Maglie tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

CALM, COLÓN, COLLECTED: RHP Jeffrey Colón was sublime out of the bullpen for the Cyclones last Wednesday night...The 24-year-old stranded the bases loaded with one out in the second inning, hurling 6.2 innings of shutout ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings on the hill was the longest effort by the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native since he threw 6.2 innings in a start, taking a no-decision, on May 26, 2023, vs. Winston-Salem...The 6.2 innings of the bump also matched the longest outing by a Cyclone pitcher this year...RHP Jonah Tong tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in a start vs. Hudson Valley on May 21...Colón is the first Brooklyn relief pitcher to toss 6.2+ innings since RHP Jordan Geber posted 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the win vs. Aberdeen on May 7, 2023...Colón and Geber are the only South Atlantic League pitchers to throw 6.2+ innings in a single game since the start of the 2023 season.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP Josh Hejka earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with Hunter Parsons (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 60 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-3 record with a 2.37 ERA (26 ER in 98.2 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 24 and striking out 87.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)... Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Friday at Hudson Valley...Game was delayed two hours at the start due to rain and shortened to a seven-inning contest...Surrendered three runs (two earned) on four hits over 5.0 innings...Walked three and struck out three...Induced a pair of double plays...Threw 78 pitches and 44 strikes (56.41%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** to start the bottom of the sixth with Brooklyn trailing 3-1...The Cyclones scored two in the seventh to tie and a run in the eighth to comeback and defeat the Renegades in eight innings, 4-3.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America* and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

THE TONG SONG: The 20-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In 12 appearances (10 starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA (15 ER in 50.1 IP)...Among Minor League pitchers with 50.0+ innings pitched, Tong is fifth in FIP (2.33) and sixth in strikeout rate (34.7%).

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zachary Fruit**, teammate RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
