PATRIOTS POWER PAST PORTLAND The Portland Sea Dogs fell 7-5 to the Somerset Patriots on Tuesday night. Portland took a 3-0 lead in the top of the second after back-to-back doubles. A two-run double from Anthony (16) would put Portland on the board before a double from Campbell (13) would drive in Anthony. Somerset scored a pair in the bottom of the third inning after an RBI triple from Alexander Vargas along with an RBI single from Spencer Jones. In the bottom of the fourth inning, the Patriots tied the game with an RBI single from Grant Richardson before taking the 4-3 lead after Anthony Seigler grounded into a force out to score the leading run. Alex Binelas tied the game yet again after an RBI single to score Kyle Teel in the top of the fifth inning. Richardson ripped a two-run homer in the bottom of the sixth inning to give the Patriots a 6-4 lead. Binelas continued the momentum with an RBI double (9) in the top of the seventh inning to inch back. A solo homer from Spencer Jones in the bottom of the inning extended a two-run Somerset lead and sealed the deal. 7-5.

SEA DOG STREAKS Kristian Campbell enters today riding a 13-game hit streak which currently represents the longest active streak in the Eastern League. Across the last 13 games, Campbell has gone 18-49 (.367) with 11 runs scored, seven doubles, eight RBI, eight walks, seven strikeouts, and three stolen bases while notching a .475 OBP. Roman Anthony enters today riding a six-game hit streak where he has gone 7-27 (.259) with four runs scored, one double, one triple, one homer, four RBI, and three stolen bases. Karson Simas completes the hit streaks with a four-game streak of his own. In that span, Simas has gone 4-13 (.308) with one run scored, two doubles, three RBI, and three stolen bases. Phillip Sikes also sports an 11-game on base streak that dates back to July 3rd. Sikes has a .413 OBP with nine walks and three stolen bags in that span.

NEW PITCHERS IN PORTLAND RHP David Sandlin and LHP Connelly Early were promoted to Portland from High-A Greenville prior to the series opener with the Patriots. Sandlin made 10 starts for the Drive prior to his promotion where tallied a 5.12 ERA and struck out 50 over a combined 31.2 innings. Sandlin was aqquired from the Kansas City Royals on February 17, 2024 in exchange for RHP John Schreiber. Sandlin was originally selected by KC in the 11th round of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft. At the time of being traded to Boston, was ranked by Baseball America as the Royals' No. 20 prospect. LHP Connelly Early made 15 starts for the Drive prior to his promotion where he notched a 3.72 ERA. Early allowed just 24 walks while striking out 90 across 67.2 innings this season. Early was drafted by Boston in the fifth round of the 2023 Draft out of University of Virginia. Prior to UVA, Early attended Army West Point (2020-21). Early and Kyle Teel reunite after being battery mates in the 2022-2023 season at UVA.

SUMMARIZING SOMERSET This week will mark the second of three total series against the Patriots this season. Portland last faced Somerset May 14th-19th where they split a six-game series with the Patriots. Portland will welcome Somerset for the final series and lone home series August 20th-26th.

THIS DAY IS SEA DOGS HISTORY July 24, 2015 – Portland scored 10 runs over innings 2-4, smacking out 21 hits in a 10-5 win over New Hampshire...Oscar Tejeda went 4-for-4, 2 RBI and reached base five times...David Chester finished 3-for-5, 3 RBI.

PITCHING PREVIEW RHP Wikelman Gonzalez will have the start in game two of the series in what will be his 13th start and 16th appearance this season. Gonzalez last pitched on July 12th in Hartford where he tossed 3.0 scoreless innings to start in a no decision. Gonzalez struck out two and did not allow a walk. Has faced Somerset once this season on May 16th at TD Bank Ballpark where he earned the winning decision after pitching 5.0 innings allowing one run on two hits while walking three and striking out six. He held Somerset to a .118 average and 1.80 ERA against him which is the lowest of a Sea Dogs starter this season.

Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

MICKEY JIANG - COACH

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

KYLE SASALA- COACH

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

2023 Season

Recognized by the Red Sox as the organization's Minor League Starting Pitcher of the Year. Went 9-4 with a 3.96 ERA (49 ER/111.1 IP) and a .190 opponent AVG in 25 starts between High-A Greenville (15 GS) and Double-A Portland (10 GS). Led Minor League Baseball (min. 100.0 IP) with 13.58 SO/9.0 IP and a 35.2% strikeout rate (168 SO in 111.1 IP). Named an MiLB.com Organization All-Star. Recorded 10+ SO in a start 4 times, including a career-high 12 SO on 5/27 at Rome. Began the season with Greenville and went 0-2 with a 15.58 ERA, 3.00 WHIP, and .294 opponent AVG in 4 April starts (8.2 IP, 15 ER, 10 H, 16 BB). In 10 starts during May and June, went 6-0 with a 2.55 ERA, 1.11 WHIP, and .175 opponent AVG (49.1 IP, 14 ER, 31 H, 24 BB). Won 4 consecutive starts from 6/10-30 (1.29 ERA, 21.0 IP, 3 ER, 10 H, 8 BB, 36 SO)...Struck out 10 batters in consecutive outings on 6/23 at Bowling Green and 6/30 at Asheville. Promoted to Portland on 7/14... Allowed 4 ER in 2.2 IP on 8/19 at Binghamton, but posted a 1.77 ERA (9 ER/45.2 IP) in his other 9 outings with the Sea Dogs.

Is in his 6th professional season. Added to the Sox' 40-man roster on 11/14/23. Ranked by Baseball America as the Red Sox' No. 7 prospect and top pitching prospect...Also rated by BA as having the best curveball in the organization. Also ranked by Baseball America as a top Sox prospect entering 2022 (No. 13) and 2023 (No. 12). Has struck out 30.4% of batters faced (399 of 1,312) and averaged 11.63 SO/9.0 IP in his minor league career. Has twice been named his league's Pitcher of the Week: Carolina League (8/18-14/22) and Eastern League (7/17-23/23). Participated in the Red Sox Rookie Development Pro- gram in January 2024... The program included 2 workouts daily, seminars focused on assimilation into Major League life on and off the field, an RBI clinic with the Red Sox Foundation, and a visit to Boston Children's Hospital. Attended Red Sox Winter Weekend in January 2024, signing autographs and posing for pictures with fans.


