YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox dropped their third game in their last four in a 2-0 shutout loss to Altoona on Tuesday. **Alex Pham** set a new Double-A high and matched his career-high with 11 strikeouts in 5.1 innings pitched but gave up a third inning solo homer to Termarr Johnson. The Baysox mustered just three hits on the night with **Jeremiah Jackson** tallying two of those hits. It's the fourth time this season that Chesapeake has been shut out.

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 13 of the 16 games played this season (1.99 ERA in 113 innings pitched), which leads the Eastern League. The Baysox have also already collected nine saves on the year, which leads all Double-A staffs, and have yet to blow a save. Last season, the Chesapeake bullpen led all of Double-A in strikeouts (724) and innings pitched (653.2).

CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems blasted his first homer of the season on Wednesday with a solo shot in the ninth. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is on a six-game hit streak and has reached base in 11 consecutive games. His six doubles are tied for the second-most in the Eastern League. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** has been an on-base machine for the Baysox to start his first full season at Double-A. The 24-year-old is on a 13-game on-base streak, which is the longest on the team and is tied for the third-longest in the league. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is tied for the league lead in walks (14) and is eighth in OBP (.421).

MR. ROGERS IS HERE

LHP **Trevor Rogers** begins a Major League rehab assignment today in Double-A Chesapeake. Rogers is working his way back from a right knee subluxation suffered during the offseason. The 27-year-old was acquired by the Orioles from the Marlins during the trade deadline for former Baysox INF Connor Norby and OF Kyle Stowers. In 25 starts last year between the Marlins and Orioles, Rogers posted a 4.92 ERA in 124.1 innings with 97 strikeouts over 56 walks.

ACTION JACKSON

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is tied for third in the Eastern League in hits (17) and tied for second in doubles (6) to start the season. Over his last six games, Jackson has five multi-hit performances and is batting .407 (11-for-27) with four doubles and four RBI. The 25-year-old has struck out only four times in 61 total plate appearances (6.5% strikeout rate), while averaging a 27.5% strikeout rate in his career.

ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (45), Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with six so far this season. Last year, the Baysox had the third-most one-run wins in the Eastern League (25).

TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

The Altoona Curve are the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The Curve won their most recent series over Somerset after winning four of the last five against the Patriots. Chesapeake won two of three on Opening Weekend in Altoona. Altoona's active roster features five Pirates' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): IF Termarr Johnson (No. 4), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 7), IF Jack Brannigan (No. 11), UTL Mitch Jebb (No. 13) and LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 14).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Wilber Dotel makes his fourth start of the season and his second against Chesapeake. The 22-year-old pitched five scoreless innings and struck out four in his first meeting against the Baysox. Dotel was a starter all of last season in High-A Greensboro and threw a career-high 106.1 innings, struck out a career-high 106 batters but posted a career-high 5.33 ERA. The Santo Domingo native was signed by the Pirates as an international free agent in 2020.

- Went 2-11 with a 4.92 ERA (68 ER/124.1 IP) with 140 hits (14 HR), 74 total runs, 56 walks, four hit batters, and 97 strikeouts in 25 games, all starts, between Miami and Baltimore; the 25 starts tied a career high (2021), the 14 homers were second most in his career (15, 2022), and the 11 losses were tied for a career high (2022)
- Went 2-9 with a 4.53 ERA (53 ER/105.1 IP) in 21 games with the Marlins and 0-2 with a 7.11 ERA (15 ER/19.0 IP) in four games with the Orioles
- Opened the season as the Marlins' fourth starter, making his season debut on March 31 at Pittsburgh (5.0 IP, 7 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 6 K)
- Posted a 3.17 ERA (17 ER/48.1 IP) in his final nine starts with Miami from June 9 to July 26 while allowing two or fewer runs in eight of those games
- Made his Orioles debut on August 1 at Cleveland (L: 4.1 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 3 K)
- Finished the year by making five starts with the Tides, going 1-2 with a 5.65 ERA (18 ER/28.2 IP) with 26 hits (3 HR), nine walks, and 30 strikeouts
- Surrendered a career-high 10 runs in his Norfolk debut on August 25 vs. Worcester (L: 4.1 IP, 9 H, 10 R, 10 ER, 1 HR, 3 BB, 2 K)
- Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on four hits and two walks with seven strikeouts on September 12 at Durham
- Did not make the AL Wild Card Series roster

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

2023: Made his third career Opening Day Roster...Started four games in April going 1-2 with a 4.00 ERA (8 ER/18.0 IP), a 1.22 WHIP, and a .229 opponent average before going on the 15-day Injured List with a left biceps strain on April 21...Made two rehab appearances, with Triple-A Jacksonville (W: 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K) on June 4 at Durham and Single-A Jupiter (4.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 7 K) on May 30 at Lakeland...Did not pitch the rest of the year after suffering a setback in his non-throwing shoulder and was transferred to the 60-day Injured List on June 14.

2022: Was with the Marlins the entire season...Spent time on the 15-day Injured List with low back spasms (7/26-8/31) and with a left lat strain (9/19-end of season)...Made 23 starts...Allowed a career-high 15 home runs and a .274 batting average against (116-for-423) in 107.0 innings...Recorded his 200th career strikeout against leadoff hitter J.T. Realmuto on April 16 vs. Philadelphia; became the first left-hander in MLB history to strike out 200 hitters in his first 34 games (all starts) while maintaining a career ERA under 3.25, and the 12th pitcher to accomplish this feat (all 11 others were right-handed)...Suffered a career-high four consecutive losses from July 6-25...Made four starts after returning from injury on August 31...Went 6.0-plus innings in three-straight starts from August 31 to September 12 and posted a 2.98 ERA (6 ER/18.1 IP) in that stretch...In the fourth outing, was pulled after 1.0 inning with an injury, landing him back on the Injured List for the remainder of the year...Struck out a season-high nine batters in a season-best 6.1 innings on September 12 vs. Texas...Held lefties to a .194/.288/.296 (19-for-98) slash line with one home run against...Righties batted .298/.366/.520 (97-for-325) with 14 homers.

2021: Went 7-8 with a 2.64 ERA (39 ER/133.0 IP), 46 walks, and 157 strikeouts in 25 starts; finished with the second-best ERA by a rookie in Marlins history behind José Fernández (2.19) in 2013 and the third-most strikeouts by a rookie in team history behind José Fernández (187, 2013) and Scott Olsen (166, 2006)...Finished second in the NL Rookie of the Year voting behind Cincinnati's Jonathan India; received one first-place vote...Selected as an NL All-Star for the first time, the sixth Marlins rookie to earn the honor since 1993; surrendered two unearned runs on two hits in the fourth inning of the game at Coors Field in Colorado...Earned NL Rookie of the Month in April and May...Had his streak of 22 straight starts allowing three runs or less dating back to September 26, 2020, snapped on September 10 at Atlanta; the streak set a Marlins record.

2020: Was a non-roster invitee to Spring Training...Participated in the Alternate Training Site at Triple-A Jacksonville...Had his contract selected on August 25 and made his MLB debut that day vs. New York-NL in game two (4.0 IP, 1 H, 5 BB, 6 K)...Went 1-2 with a 6.11 ERA (19 ER/28.0 IP) with 32 hits (5 HR), 20 total runs, 13 walks, two hit batters,

and 39 strikeouts in seven games, all starts...Set a career high with 10 strikeouts in 6.0 innings on September 6 at Tampa Bay...Was on the Marlins' Postseason rosters in the Wild Card Series vs. Chicago-NL and Division Series vs. Atlanta...Made his playoff debut in relief of Game 3 of the NLDS at Minute Maid Park (1.2 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 2 K). **2019:** Posted a 6-10 record with a 2.90 ERA (44 ER/ 136.1 IP) and 150 strikeouts over 23 starts between High-A Jupiter (18 GS) and Double-A Jacksonville (5 GS); walked 33 batters and allowed 10 home runs...Opened the season at Jupiter and went 5-8 with a 2.53 ERA and 122 strikeouts in 110.1 innings with 24 walks...Earned Florida State League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star honors...Ranked second in the league in strikeouts...Did not qualify for the ERA title, but would have ranked third, while his 1.10 WHIP would have tied for third...Struck out 10+ in four starts; had one such start in 2018...Transferred to Double-A on August 3; at the time of promotion, led the FSL in strikeouts (122), opponent average (.232), and WHIP (1.10)...Made five starts with the Jumbo Shrimp to end the season and went 1-2 with a 4.50 ERA (13 ER/26.0 IP).

2018: Spent the entire season with Single-A Greensboro...Made his professional debut on May 22 vs. Kannapolis (L: 3.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 1 HBP, 2 BB, 5 K)...Finished the season 2-7 with a 5.82 ERA (47 ER/72.2 IP) with 86 hits (4 HR), 48 total runs, 27 walks, two hit batters, and 85 strikeouts in 17 games, all starts.

2017: Did not pitch after being selected 13th overall by Miami in the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

AMATEUR: Graduated from Carlsbad (NM) High School...Won the New Mexico 6A State Championship as a junior in 2016...Was committed to Texas Tech University before signing with Miami.

PERSONAL: Married, wife's name is Tessa...The couple was married in November 2022, and former Marlins teammates Braxton Garrett and Will Stewart were both groomsmen at their wedding...His cousin is Cody Ross, 12-year MLB veteran from 2003-15 with the Detroit Tigers, Los Angeles Dodgers, Cincinnati Reds, Florida Marlins, San Francisco Giants, Boston Red Sox, Arizona Diamondbacks, and Oakland Athletics; Ross won the 2010 World Series with the Giants and was named the MVP of the NLCS against Philadelphia that season.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
