RIDERS USE SIX-RUN THIRD TO HAND JUSTIN VERLANDER LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Corpus Christi Hooks by a final score of 10-3 on Saturday night at Riders Field. Justin Verlander (0-1) took the mound for a rehab start on Saturday night against Frisco in front of 11,622 fans at Riders Field. It was the 13th-largest crowd in franchise history. **Nathaniel Lowe** spent his second rehab game with the RoughRiders as well, going 0-for-2 with a walk and a run scored over five innings. In the first inning, **Aaron Zavala** and **Liam Hicks** opened the frame with back-to-back hits, but Verlander was able to maneuver his way through two scoreless innings. **Emiliano Teodo** cruised through his first three innings, allowing just one baserunner. He finished his outing with 4.0 innings pitched giving up just one run on no hits, four walks and five strikeouts. The RoughRiders offense then sent 10 batters to the plate in the third inning against Verlander, scoring six runs. **Frainyer Chavez** opened the scoring with a double that plated **Cody Freeman**. An error, a pair of singles and an RBI double by **Abimelec Ortiz** brought five more runs across, giving the Riders a 6-0 lead. Verlander finished with a final line of 4.0 innings pitched, allowing six runs (five earned) on seven hits and one walk while striking out three. Jordan Brewer scored the first run of the contest for Corpus Christi on a wild pitch by Teodo in the top of the fourth inning. Michael Knorr came on in relief in the fifth and allowed two runs to score on a double by Freeman, bringing home **Kellen Strahm** and Ortiz. He was tagged for two more runs on an opposite field homer off the bat of Zavala in the eighth. The RoughRiders lineup consisted of five multi-hit performances, coming from Zavala, Hicks, Ortiz, Freeman and Chavez. Zavala and Freeman each recorded two RBI. **Aidan Anderson** (2-0) earned the win after spinning 3.0 innings, conceding two runs on two hits with three punchouts.

NATHANIEL LOWE TO TAKE US HIGHER:

World Series Champion **Nathaniel Lowe** is expected to begin his rehab assignment with the RoughRiders today. Lowe, who has missed the entire start to the 2024 season because of an oblique injury suffered in Spring Training, has been the starting first baseman for the Rangers over the last three seasons. In 2022, he captured the American League Silver Slugger Award at first base, slashing .302/.358/.492/.851 with a 139 OPS+ before winning the 2023 Rawlings Gold Glove at first base. In the postseason last year, Lowe hit a pair of home runs against the Houston Astros in the ALCS. In his first two rehab games, he has gone 0-for-6, reaching on an error and walking once.

ACKER HACKS THEM UP:

Starter **Dane Acker** was strong in his start on Opening Day for the RoughRiders, tossing 4.2 innings, allowing just one run, and threw just as well in his second start of the season against Corpus Christi. After tying his career high with seven strikeouts in his second start, he has allowed just one run over 8.2 innings while striking out 11 and walking three. The righty is allowing just a .167 batting average against.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been treating Double-A like Little League so far in 2024, batting .433 (13-for-30)/.514/.533/1.047 through the first eight games with three doubles, four RBIs and six walks. The catcher had multi-hit games in the first five contests. He is fourth in the Texas League in batting average (.433), fifth in OBP (.514) and second in hits (13). Hicks won the batting title in the Arizona Fall League, hitting .449 over 18 games after hitting .269/.408/.368/.776 with the Riders over 77 games in 2023 with 14 doubles, three home runs and 40 RBIs.

LITTLE PAPI ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz had a fine three-game series in Wichita to start the season, and is hitting .357 (10-for-28)/.500/.643/1.143 five doubles, a home run, five RBIs and eight walks through the first eight games of the season. In the series finale on Sunday against the Wind Surge, he committed an eighth-inning throwing error from first base, allowing the game-tying and go-ahead runs to score, but redeemed himself when he hammered a two-run double in the top of the ninth in a 12-8 win for the Riders. Ortiz led all of MiLB with a .619 SLG in 2023 and was fourth in the minors in home runs (33) and OPS (.990) between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

After leading the league and setting a franchise record in walks in 2023, the RoughRiders once again pace the Texas League and all of Double-A in bases on balls this season with 49 on the offensive side in the first eight games (6.1 per game). Frisco's OBP (.361) is fourth in the league while their OPS is eighth (.696) because of a .335 SLG, which is ninth in the 10-team league. **Kellen Strahm's** 146 career walks with the RoughRiders is now second in franchise history. Guilder Rodriguez is first with 206.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
