



Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the opener in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the first of 18 meetings between the two ballclubs this year. Last year, the Nuts finished 9-15 vs. the Captains, going 2-9 in Eastlake and 7-8 at home. Lansing is coming off dropping the final three games of a six-game series at home to Great Lakes, falling in four of six overall.

On the Air: Logan Potosky and Tyler Danburg deliver the call via Bally Live and MiLB TV, while Jesse Goldberg-Strassler has the audio call via StreamGuys.

Sunday: Loons 12, Lugnuts 4. The Loons clinched the series victory in the finale at Jackson Field, holding the Lugnuts to two hits and receiving home runs from Dylan Campbell and Chris Newell amid a 15-hit performance.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a noon matinee for the second game of this six-game series, followed by night games on Thursday, Friday and Saturday. Upon the series' conclusion, the Lugnuts will return to Michigan's state capital for a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Dayton Dragons and South Bend Cubs.

2009: 12,992 fans watch Michigan State pick up its first CTSD win, routing the Lugnuts 12-2 in the 3rd Annual Crosstown Showdown presented by Auto-Owners Insurance. The Nuts commit four errors in the loss, two by left fielder Kenny Wilson. The game lasts nine innings..

2015: Rowdy Tellez's 16th-inning two-run home run of Great Lakes first-baseman-turned-emergency-pitcher Josmar Cordero gave the Lugnuts 4-2 win at Dow Diamond. The game lasted four hours and 51 minutes and ended one inning shy of tying the franchise record for most innings played.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.


Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of California League Pitcher of the Week with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.

In a Nutshell: One of five undrafted free agents on the Lugnuts, joining fellow pitchers Dylan Hall, Garrett Irvin and Jack Owen, and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing: former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 Lugnuts win, April 3.

Family of Athletes: Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

At Pella High School: 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

Onward to Des Moines: Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

International Stage: With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
