NEWS & NOTES

WOW, NO COW!: Today the Renegades suit up as Minor League Baseball's 121st team, the Malmö Oat Milkers. The promotion is part of a MiLB-wide partnership deal with Oatly in which every team will suit up for one unforgettable game as the Oat Milkers.

FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Renegades recently completed a stretch where they played 24 of 36 games away from home. Hudson Valley is currently playing 15 of 24 games at Heritage Financial Park.

WALK-OFF MAGIC: Hudson Valley earned their fifth walk-off victory of the season on Saturday night vs. Wilmington. Josh Moylan scored Jace Avina with a walk-off single down the left-field line to secure a 4-3 win.

LEFTY PUNCHOUTS: Ben Shields was dominant on Friday night, matching his career-high with nine strikeouts in 5.1 scoreless innings. The southpaw didn't allow a hit until the sixth inning, and only allowed two baserunners to reach safely in his entire outing.

HOME, SWEET HOME: Sebastian Keane continued his tremendous success at Heritage Financial Park on Wednesday night, tossing six scoreless innings while striking out five. The right-hander retired 17 of the last 19 batters he faced, earning his fourth quality start of the season.

IT'S WILMINGTON, AGAIN!: The Renegades and Blue Rocks complete their third series of the season today. Hudson Valley traveled to Delaware for the first week of May, where they split four games with Wilmington. Two games were postponed due to rain at Frawley Stadium.

HE WENT TO JARED: Jared Serna continues to be one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League. The Renegades infielder was 2-for-4 on Wednesday with two RBIs and two runs, which included his 12th home run of the season.

NY SLUGGERS: The Renegades currently have the third-highest team OPS in the South Atlantic League (.748), and have the third-best mark in High-A. With 145 doubles in 2024, Hudson Valley has the most doubles in High-A this season, nine more than any other team.

CONSISTENCY: Baron Stuart overcame a tough first inning on Tuesday night, eclipsing the four-inning mark for the 11th time in 11 starts this season. The right-hander set his career-high in strikeouts last Wednesday vs. Greensboro, recording 10 punchouts in 4.1 innings.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: Cam Schlittler continued his strong pitching on Saturday night vs. the Blue Rocks, allowing just two runs in 4.2 innings and striking out seven batters. Schlittler has struck out six or more batters in five of his last

six starts. His ERA now sits at 2.44 this season through 12 starts, which is the second-best mark in the South Atlantic League. His .172 opposing average is the lowest in the SAL.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: The Renegades bullpen collectively sports a 3.31 ERA (112 ER/304.2 IP) this season, the second-best mark in High-A. Trent Sellers, Eric Reyzelman, and Matt Keating combined to allow just one unearned run in 4.1 innings out of the bullpen on Friday night.

OFFENSIVE ASSISTANCE: It was announced Wednesday that Rafael Flores was being called up to Double-A Somerset. Flores leaves the Renegades as the all-time franchise leader in hits (154) and doubles (32). Flores has been one of the best hitters in the South Atlantic League since being reinstated off the IL on May 10.

STELLAR STARTERS: Starting pitching continues to be excellent for the Renegades. Twenty-six of the last 28 starters have allowed three earned runs or less in their outings. In the last 28 games, 22 starters have gone at least 4.1 innings. On Wednesday, Sebastiane Keane tossed six scoreless innings while striking out five, retiring 17 of the last 19 batters he faced.

LIMITING HITS: Hudson Valley pitchers have allowed only 473 hits through 72 games. The Renegades have allowed the second-fewest hits in MiLB, trailing only the Carolina Mudcats (A, MiLB). Incredibly, the Lansing Lugnuts (OAK, A+) have allowed a staggering 649 hits through 72 games, most among all non-AAA teams.

MIDWEST REINFORCEMENTS: Jace Avina debuted with the Renegades on April 17 after being traded to New York for Jake Bauers in November from Milwaukee. The 20-year-old has been crucial all season for the Renegades. Avina is hitting .289 (68-for-235) with 21 doubles, 40 RBIs, 33 runs scored and a .850 OPS in 60 games.

INTERNATIONAL OUTREACH: The Hudson Valley Renegades and the Bhutan Baseball & Softball Association have partnered to present Bhutan Night on August 20 at Heritage Financial Park. The team is currently fundraising to bring over several Bhutanese baseball players for baseball and cultural enrichment tour of the Hudson Valley and New York.

DEFENSIVE ISSUES: The Renegades have the sixth-most errors in MiLB, with 98 errors in 73 games. Their .962 fielding percentage is tied for fourth-worst in the minors. On Wednesday and Friday, the Renegades played error-free on their way to victories. Hudson Valley did not commit an error in four of the six games of the series against Greensboro. However, they lost all four games. They entered the series 14-1 in contests where they do not commit an error: Hudson Valley is 16-5 in those scenarios this season.

HEATING UP: Renegades infielder Roc Riggio has started to swing the bat much better lately. During an 18-game on-base streak, Riggio is 18-for-64, slashing .279/.388/.529 with 11 extra-base hits and a .917 OPS. The Oklahoma State product has a hit in 15 of his last 18 games. Riggio hit his fifth home run of the season on Sunday. His on-base streak is the longest active streak among Renegades players.

POWER SURGE: Garrett Martin has been hot at the plate recently. In his last 11 games, Martin is 12-for-43 (.306) with four home runs, three doubles, a triple, and a 1.014 OPS. The outfielder hit his seventh home run of the season on Friday versus Wilmington, one of three long balls for the Renegades in the game. Martin has also not committed an error in 38 games in the outfield this season for Hudson Valley.

NEW FACE: Brenny Escanio has quickly made an impact since being called up from Single-A Tampa. The 21-year-old is 9-for-32 (.281) with five RBIs and five doubles in ten games.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Stuart struggled with his command early on Tuesday against Wilmington, walking three of the first four batters of the game, but settled in after that to toss 4.1 innings of two-run ball in a series-opening victory. He scattered five hits across the outing and struck out three while throwing a season-high 94 pitches. After he departed, Trent Sellers and Mason Vinyard closed the door with 4.2 scoreless innings combined to seal a 3-2 win.

**2024 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season in on the Renegades Break Camp Roster... promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on 5/23... transferred to the Renegades on 5/24.
- Threw his first quality start of the season on 5/15 vs Jersey Shore: 6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 BB, 4 K, 1 HR (two-run HR to Bryan Rincon) in front of largest crowd in Heritage Financial Park history (5,619). Stuart retired the first 11 batters he faced before an Otto Kemp single with two outs in the fourth.
- Called up to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to make a spot start on 5/23 (Game 1) vs. Syracuse, threw a complete game: W, 7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 4 BB, 2 K. Joined **Sean Boyle** in 2021 as pitchers called directly up to Triple-A from the Renegades who went on to throw a complete game in a spot start (Boyle threw no-hitter at Worcester on 8/19/21).

- Began the season in Extended Spring Training... assigned to Tampa Tarpons on April 25... transferred to Hudson Valley on Aug. 2.
- Made his professional debut on April 30 at Jupiter: L, 4.2 IP, 6 H, 6 R, 4 ER, 0 BB, 5 K.

- Was a starting pitcher at USF, but transitioned to the bullpen at Pittsburgh. Led the Panthers with 27 appearances and seven saves, which was tied fifth in the ACC and fourth-most in a single season in program history.
- Helped lead Pitt to the semifinals of the ACC Tournament for the first time since 2018.
- Was a Nursing major at USF, majored in Communications/Cyber Security at Pitt.
- When MLB Draft Tracker Twitter account was hacked before the 2022 draft, the account tweeted out that the first overall pick of the draft was Baron Stuart.
