Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fifth in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Lugnuts are 5-5 against the Loons this year, dropping four of six in a series at Dow Diamond in mid May before winning three of the first four in this series. It is the first time since early June that Great Lakes has lost as many as three games in a series.

Off the Field: Tonight is Hall of Fame Day, with **Steve Avery** and **Frank Tanana** getting inducted in a special pregame plaque unveiling ceremony into the Michigan Baseball Hall of Fame, located behind the left field wall. Avery excelled at Taylor's John F. Kennedy High School, going on to pitch 11 MLB seasons, the last with the Detroit Tigers. Tanana starred at Detroit Catholic Central, going on to pitch 21 MLB seasons, including eight with the Tigers. **LAFCU Fireworks** will follow the game.

Last Night: **Lugnuts 1, Loons 0.** A third-inning RBI double from **Tyler Soderstrom** supplied the game's only run, as southpaw **Jack Owen** set down the first 14 batters he faced, settling for six innings with one base runner allowed (a Jose Ramos fifth-inning single) and seven strikeouts in a two-hit Lugnuts shutout. The game was played in two hours and three minutes.

The Future is Now: Outfielder **Denzel Clarke**, the A's No. 14 prospect, is among the top prospects selected for the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on Saturday, July 16, Major League Baseball announced today. The 22-year-old Clarke, MLB Pipeline's No. 14 Athletics prospect and No. 3 Athletics outfield prospect, becomes the fourth current Lugnut to participate in the Futures Game, joining Ángel Perdomo (2016) and Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. (2017). A native of Pickering, ON, Clarke was drafted by the Athletics in the fourth round in 2021 from Cal State Northridge. He joined the Lugnuts on June 14 from Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .295/.420/.545 with 14 doubles, two triples, seven home runs and 14 stolen bases. He has two doubles and two home runs through 13 games with the Lugnuts, though he has not played since June 29th.

RiSPy Business: The Loons went just 0-for-1 with runners in scoring position last night.

A Night for Pitchers: Last night marked the Lugnuts' second 1-0 win of the year, with first coming in ten innings on May 28 at Beloit. The Sky Carp also handed the Lugnuts a 1-0 loss on June 22, with the only run coming on a Cody Morissette leadoff home run.

Running Hot: SS/2B **Euribiel Angeles** went 3-for-3 with two singles, a double, and a walk yesterday and is 5-for-7 with a walk in two games against Great Lakes and now has 14 hits in his last 31 at-bats (.452) and 18 hits in his last 43 at-bats (.419). His walk yesterday was his first since June 12th; he only drew two total walks in June.

Soder Pop: With his RBI double yesterday, **Tyler Soderstrom** has eight RBIs in this series and is three away from matching Cedar Rapids' Christian Encarnacion-Strand's total of 60 for the Midwest League lead. Soderstrom is 5th with 131 total bases, 4th with 32 extra-base hits and 5th with 14 home runs. Others among the league leaders include **Kumar Nambiar**, who is tied for 1st with 28 relief appearances, while **Trayson Kubo** is 4th with seven saves.

Nuts to the Show: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018) and catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever **Danny Young** (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

The Injury Bug: When OF **Lawrence Butler** departed Monday's game and was placed on the Injured List, he became the latest top A's prospect on the Lugnuts' Injured List. Butler (MLB Pipeline's No. 17 prospect) joins pitcher **Gunnar Hoglund** (No. 6, 60-day IL), outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 9, 7-day IL), pitcher **Mason Miller** (No. 16, 60-day IL) and pitcher **Grant Holman** (No. 30, 7-day IL).

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: The Lugnuts were swept in a doubleheader at Quad Cities, 2-1 in 10 innings (2 hours, 25 minutes) and 4-3 in 11 innings (2 hours, 56 minutes): 21 combined innings on a day that was slated to feature only 14. In Game 2, Henderson Alvarez was one strike away from a complete game when DH Jon Edwards let it rip on an 0-2 pitch and crushed a game-tying two-run homer. Coupled with a 5-3 12-inning loss to South Bend in their previous game, the Lugnuts played 10 extra-innings in three contests and did not score in any of them. This was the Nuts' 10th doubleheader of the year. In 20 doubleheader games, Lansing finished 6-14.

What's in a Name? Besides Seth Beer, currently slugging for Arizona, pitcher Clarence Beers saw action in one game in relief in 1948 for St. Louis... middle name of Ausweger is Blake's mother's maiden name.

Scouting Report: Noted for fastball touching 97 mph, though slider is considered best pitch... posted 17% SwStr % at Stockton.

Hometown: Manhattan Beach is in southwestern Los Angeles County, bordering the Pacific Ocean, with a beach stretching over two miles... motto: "Sun, Sand, Sea"... city name was decided by coin flip, with landowners George Peck and John Merrill arguing between the names Shore Acres and Manhattan; they flipped to decide the name, and Manhattan won... the postmaster added "Beach" to the end to differentiate it.

Glory Days: Attended Loyola High School (the "Cubs"), a private all-boys Roman Catholic prep school in Los Angeles that first opened in 1865... Loyola also produced Royals broadcaster Ryan Lefebvre, volleyball great Sinjin Smith, linebacker Anthony Barr, and New York Giants outfielder Fred Snodgrass, who played with Christy Mathewson on John McGraw's powerful Giants teams... Beers distinguished himself at Loyola, named a 2017 Perfect Game First Team All-State, First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American.

Hail to the Victors: Pitched four years at Michigan... in College of Literature, Science and the Arts... as a freshman, made two appearances: 1/3 IP vs. Army, 3 BB, 1 K, 4 R, and 0 IP vs. Western Michigan, 2 BB, 1 HBP, 3 R... finished with 135.00 ERA... sophomore year was better: 6.04 ERA, 14 G, 2 GS, 1 sv., 22 1/3, 24 H, 1 HR, 10 BB, 15 K, 5 HBP, 7 WP... as a junior, was at his best, though season was pandemic-shortened: 3.13 ERA, 4 GS, 23 IP, 15 H, 0 HR, 5 BB, 21 K, 6 WP... as a senior: 8.42 ERA, 13 G, 5 GS, 25 2/3 IP, 30 H, 2 HR, 20 BB, 21 K, 7 WP... notable Wolverines: Hall of Famers Ted Simmons, Charlie Gehringer, Barry Larkin and George Sisler, plus Bill Freehan, JJ Putz, Mike Matheny, Chris Sabo, Ryan LaMarre and Jake Cronenworth.

Pro Ball – Better Late Than Never: Debuted on the very last day of the 2021 season, getting the start in the Arizona Complex League on September 18th... allowed one run (James Triantos HR) on two hits in one inning, striking out one; A's lost, 5-4, in a walk-off.

2022 - Stockton: Started the third game of the year for the Ports, April 10 at Fresno (4 2/3, 7 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 4 K, 2 HR)... followed up with a gem: 6 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K vs. Modesto, April 17... that was the start of five consecutive six-inning outings: April 17 vs. Modesto, April 24 at Inland Empire (6 IP, 3 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 7 K), May 1 vs. Fresno (6 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 10 K), May 8 vs. San Jose (6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 BB, 9 K), May 15 at Rancho Cucamonga (6 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 3 HR, 1 BB, 8 K)... in final start in Stockton, allowed five runs on nine hits in five innings vs. Modesto, May 22, done in by a four-run 5th, though he walked none and whiffed eight... in May: 23 IP, 3 BB, 35 K... vs. LHH: .292/.358/500, 3 HR, 5 BB, 11 K... vs. RHH: .231/.257/.365, 4 HR, 2 BB, 40 K... baserunners: 8-for-10 successful.
