Today is the opener of a six-game series and an 18-game season series between the Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and Captains, High-A affiliate of the Guardians. The Nuts are 130-137 all-time vs. Lake County, 59-74 in Eastlake, with a 9-15 record last year (6-6 at home and 3-9 on the road).

Last Game, Sunday: Lansing 8, Quad Cities 2: The Lugnuts won five of six games in the home series over the River Bandits, winning an easy one in the finale behind seven strong innings from **Nathan Dettmer** and home runs from **Justin Riemer** and **Myles Naylor**.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa have the call of the game on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing.

On Deck: The Luggies and Caps play a morning affair tomorrow before the series turns back to evening affairs on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, wrapping things up with a Sunday matinee before Lansing returns to Michigan's state capital to welcome in reeling archrival West Michigan, losers of 19 of their last 20 games, those poor guys.

LUG-NOTES

Milestones: On Thursday, May 14, the Lugnuts won the 2,000th game in franchise history... and three days later, on Sunday, reliever **Jay Dill** became the 999th player in Lansing Lugnuts team history.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Devin Taylor at No. 10, Steven Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Family Ties: Lansing OF **Myles Naylor's** older brother, Bo, played for the Lake County Captains in 2019, batting .243/.313/.421 in 107 games, with 18 doubles, 10 triples and 11 home runs as a 19-year-old. (Myles and Bo's oldest brother, Josh, came up to the Majors through the Marlins' and Padres' systems.)

Starting Spotlight: Coming off a career high 6 2/3 innings in his last start, 20-year-old **Steven Echavarria** gets the ball tonight. Echavarria faced Lake County five times last year: May 2 (loss, 3 2/3 IP, 6 H, 5 R, 6 BB, 3 K); May 20 (6 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 3 BB, 6 K); May 25 (3 2/3 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 3 K); July 23 (3 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 3 K); and August 29 (win, 5 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K). In total: 1-1, 3.80, 21 1/3 IP, 21 H, 9 R, 13 BB, 18 K, .269 avg., and one home run hit by the great **Wuifredo Antunez**.

Impressive Stuff: Right-hander **Nathan Dettmer** took a no-hitter into the seventh inning at South Bend in his Midwest League debut on May 10, settling for 6 1/3 scoreless innings of one-hit ball. In his home debut on Sunday, Dettmer completed seven innings to match his career high. In 13 1/3 innings overall in High-A, Dettmer has allowed one run on seven hits and three walks while striking out 14.

Taylor-Made Success: Outfielder **Devin Taylor** leads the Midwest League runs batted in (32) while ranking 2nd in base hits (45), tied for 5th in walks (34), 6th in batting average (.319) and 8th in OBP (.444). Last week, Taylor went 9-for-21 with eight runs scored, four doubles and six walks, batting .419 with a .556 OBP and a 1.175 OPS.

The Mighty Casey: Infielder **Casey Yamauchi** was also excellent last week: 9-for-23, nine runs scored, seven walks (compared to just one strikeout), and a .391 batting average, .531 OBP and .922 OPS.

That's Too Many Walks: On Wednesday, May 13, the first seven Lugnuts batters of the bottom of the 6th inning all drew walks in what turned out to be a 10-walk, two-single, nine-run rally amid a 13-walk 15-3 win over Quad Cities. Two days later, the Nuts drew 14 walks to tie a single game franchise record in a 12-9 victory over the River Bandits. In 12 total meetings with Quad Cities, the Lugnuts totaled 90 walks.

Green Power: **Rodney Green, Jr.'s** 490-foot home run into the second floor of the Outfield Lofts apartments, breaking a 4-4 tie in the eighth inning to lift the Nuts to a 7-4 win, on May 12 is the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League.

Bolting to the Show: The most recent Lugnut to make his MLB debut is 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte**, who went 2-for-2 for the A's on May 13 to become the 203rd all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the third this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**).

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

MAY 19 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: The Lake County Captains out-hit the Lugnuts, 10-2, but the Nuts beat the Captains, 2-1, at Classic Park. In the sixth inning, Kevin Pillar's sacrifice fly and Andy Burns's RBI double supplied all of the scoring the Lugnuts needed. The Caps left 12 runners on base. **2024:** Trailing 9-5 entering the sixth inning, the Lake County Captains chipped away, tied the game with two runs in the ninth, and topped the Lugnuts in ten innings, 13-9, on Sunday afternoon at Jackson® Field™. A day after winning a 15-11 slugfest, the Nuts scored three runs in the first inning, two in the third, three in the fourth and one in the fifth, battering Lake County starter Carter Spivey for 12 hits – including a double, triple and home run from Henry Bolte. But Jay Driver and Magnus Ellerts each tossed two scoreless innings, and the Captains offense rallied, tallying one in the sixth and one in the seventh against Will Johnston before plating a pair in the ninth against Yehizon Sanchez on an Alex Mooney sac fly and a two-out fielding error by shortstop Angeles. In the tenth inning, Maick Collado bounced a two-run single over the head of first baseman Will Simpson, Jonah Advincula laid down a perfect squeeze, and Nate Furman delivered an RBI single to supply the winning margin. Leadoff hitter Furman and 2-hole Mooney each reached base six times, Furman on four singles and two walks, and Mooney on three singles and three walks.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarría posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball – the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

Pro Ball: After signing, Echavarría debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
