YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Sea Dogs, 12-11, to open the series. In the second, Nick Decker opened the scoring with a solo homer. **Will Wilson** tied the game in the top of the third with an RBI single. The Sea Dogs moved back in front with a run scoring on an error in the bottom of the third. Richmond took a 3-2 lead in the fourth with a sac fly by **Christian Koss** and an RBI single by **Carter Howell**. **Victor Bericoto** extended the lead to 4-2 with a solo homer, his team-leading seventh of the year, in the fifth. Wilson and Bericoto hit RBI singles in the sixth to push the lead to 6-2. In the bottom of the sixth, Kristian Campbell hit a two-run homer to close the score to 6-4. **Jimmy Glowenke** extended the lead back to three runs with a solo homer in the seventh. Later in the inning, **Adrian Sugastey** hit an RBI double, Howell singled in a run and Wilson brought home a run with a groundout to open a 10-4 lead. The Sea Dogs closed the score to 10-9 in the bottom of the seventh with RBI singles by Marcelo Mayer and Kyle Teel and a three-run triple by Blaze Jordan. In the eighth, Sugastey opened an 11-9 lead with an RBI single but the Sea Dogs scored three runs in the bottom of the inning to take a 12-11 lead, including a run scoring on an error, a single by Mayer and a groundout by Teel. **Nick Sinacola** started for Richmond and allowed two runs (one earned) in five innings. Howell, Koss and **Jairo Pomares** each collected three hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, in the second of a six-game series on the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. This week's series is the final road set for the Flying Squirrels this year against the Northeast Division. It is also the only series between these two teams this year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a five-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night and have now won four-of-six. They had gone 3-9 in their previous 12 from since May 29 through Tuesday. In their previous 13 games from May 15-28, they went 11-2. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won three-of-their-last-five series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9 and then winning four-of-six last week at New Hampshire. Over the last six games since last Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels are batting .310 (71-for-229), which is the best in the league, with eight homers and 40 runs scored (6.7 runs per game).

THE SEA DOGS are in first place in the Northeast Division, a half-game ahead of second-place Hartford with six games remaining in the season's first half. The Sea Dogs lead the Eastern League in batting average (.269), runs (361), hits (576) and walks (267). Portland's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including OF Roman Anthony (No. 1), SS Marcelo Meyer (No. 2), C Kyle Teel (No. 3), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 5), 3B Blaze Jordan (No. 17), INF/OF Eddinson Paulino (No. 20), RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 25), RHP Angel Bastardo (No. 26) and INF Kristian Campbell (No. 30). The roster also includes 10 players ranked on MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list, including Mayer (No. 1), Anthony (No. 2), Teel (No. 3), Gonzalez (No. 5), Jordan (No. 19), Paulino (No. 22), Dobbins (No. 25), Bastardo (No. 26), RHP Bryan Mata (No. 27) and Campbell (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Wil Jensen** makes his second start of the season. He made his first start of the year last Thursday at New Hampshire and allowed a season-high five runs in 1.2 innings. Prior to that outing, he had not allowed a run in his previous four starts for the Flying Squirrels. He pitched his previous three games out of the bullpen with Triple-A Sacramento before being assigned back to Richmond last Tuesday. At the time of his promotion to Triple-A on May 24, Jensen had the third-lowest ERA (1.91) in the Eastern League (min. 28 IP) and had worked the second-most relief innings (28.1). Among Eastern League relievers (min. 20 IP) through his May 24 promotion, Jensen had the fifth-lowest ERA. Jensen is in his third season with the Flying Squirrels. Dating back to 2022, Jensen is 12-4 with a 3.16 ERA in 56 games, including 10 starts, for the Flying Squirrels. For the year in 2023, Jensen led the Eastern League and ranked 10th in MiLB (min. 80 IP) in ERA (2.53) while leading the Flying Squirrels in wins (7) and ranking third in strikeouts (93). He also ranked second in the minors (min. 85 IP) in runners left on base (86.8%) while ranking second in Double-A in relief innings pitched (75.0). Jensen was signed by the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2020 out of Pepperdine University, where he led the nation in ERA that year. - **For more on Jensen, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Robert Kwiatkowski makes his first start of the year. He last pitched out of the bullpen on Friday at Reading and allowed one run in 2.1 innings. In his last three games dating back to June 6, Kwiatkowski is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA (1 ER/7.1 IP). He also threw three appearances for Triple-A Worcester from April 28-May 7 and did not allow a run in 6.1 combined innings. Kwiatkowski grew up in Lawrenceville, Ga., and attended Spartanburg Methodist College in South Carolina before transferring to Marshall University in West Virginia for his 2019-2020 seasons. He signed with the Red Sox as a non-drafted free agent in 2020. Kwiatkowski first reached Double-A with Portland last season, posting a 3.78 ERA in eight appearances, including two starts.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,008).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: **Andy Thomas** is batting .309 (30-for-97) over his last 27 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 18 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .260. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout. He finished the series with seven hits in five games started.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 10 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with three homers, three doubles, two walks and nine RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on Friday night and added a homer on Tuesday. In his last 20 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .303 (23-for-76) with six homers, four doubles, nine walks and 18 RBIs.

HELLO, JAIRO: In the current road trip, **Jairo Pomares** is batting .444 (12-for-27) with three homers, three doubles and eight RBIs. He went 1-for-4 last Tuesday before picking up a pair of hits, including a double, on Wednesday night, driving in a season-high three runs. He matched the three RBIs last Thursday night with a double and a homer. Pomares homered for the second straight game on Friday night, one of his two hits in the game. On Sunday, he added a solo homer for his third longball of the road trip. On Tuesday to open the series at Portland, Pomares went 3-for-5 with a double and scored twice.

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** hit his first Double-A homer of the year on Saturday night, a two-run shot in the Flying Squirrels' 3-2 win over the Fisher Cats. In his four games with Richmond, Martorano is batting .313 (5-for-16) with the homer and a walk. In parts of four seasons with the Flying Squirrels, Martorano has played 201 games. His 23 career homers are tied for ninth in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with **Tyler Fitzgerald**, **Dylan Davis** and **Hunter Cole** and two behind the next spot on the list, with is 25 by **Frankie Tostado** in eighth.

SERVING UP THE DONUTS: On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels threw their ninth shutout win of the season, which is tied with Akron for the most in the Eastern League this season, both one ahead of third-place Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have pitched shutouts in six-of-their-last-10 wins dating back to May 25. Last week, they started and ended the series in New Hampshire with 5-0 shutout wins on Tuesday and Sunday.

BIG-LEAGUE BIVENS: Former Flying Squirrels pitcher **Spencer Bivens** made his MLB debut for the Giants on Sunday afternoon at Oracle Park. He picked up a winning decision in the Giants' 13-6 win over the Angels. Bivens started his outing with a strikeout of Zach Neto before surrendering a homer to Nolan Schanuel. Following the home run, he retired his final eight batters in order and finished his day with four strikeouts. Bivens pitched 27 games for the Flying Squirrels last year, going 5-4 with a 3.69 ERA. Bivens became the third Virginia-born Flying Squirrels player to reach the majors in team history, joining **Jarrett Parker** and **Connor Overton**.

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 26) and LHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes five Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23), OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26) and RHP **Carson Ragsdale** (No. 30).
