### **FRES-NOTES**

POWERING PAST THE PORTS: The Fresno Grizzlies (19-15) sizzled past the Stockton Ports (13-20) 7-5 Wednesday night from Banner Island Ballpark. Fresno moved to 16-4 when scoring first (12-1 on the road), 16-4 when plating three or more runs (12-2 on the road) and 5-0 away from home when supplying 10 or more hits. The Grizzlies picked up their first away Wednesday win and first victory by two runs. Fresno is now 10-1 on the road against the California League North Division. The Grizzlies drawed ahead 2-0 in the top of the first from a pair of singles. Jake Snider ripped a single to left and Jason Hinchman poked an infield single to third. Fresno cut the deficit to one in the top of the second when Aldan Longwell lined a double to left, adding GJ Hill. Longwell was not done yet, typing the contest in the top of the fifth with a rocket moonshot to dead center, his second longball of 2024. A frame later, the Grizzlies took a 5-4 advantage when EJ Andrews Jr. lifted a sacrifice fly to left, his second one of the series. Snider extended the Fresno lead to 7-4 in the seventh when he swatted a two-RBI single to center past a drawn infield. Overall, the Grizzlies offense recorded 11 hits with Longwell, Snider and Braylen Wimmer combining for nine of them. The trio of batters yielded one clout, a pair of doubles, five RBI, two stolen bases and five runs scored. Fresno starter Bryan Perez had a tale of two stories in his resilient outing. Perez was tagged for four runs on five hiths in the first before flipping a switch on the mound. He tossed five scoreless innings after that, allowing just three hits and one walk while fanning nine. Perez (2-1, win) finished with a career-high ixi innings, permitting four runs (earned), on eight hits and one free pass while striking out a personal-best 12 (five more than previous career-high). His 12 punchouts were the most by a Grizzlies pitcher this season and two shu of the little me record set by Tim Lineccum (14) on April 29, 2007. Collin Baumgartner (hold, 4) and Braden Carmichael

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the second of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the second set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 68-24 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 37-7 all-time record (8-4 last year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

LET EMENER EAT: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to LHP Austin Emener. The southpaw was selected by the Rockies in the 16th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of East Tennessee State, In one season with the Buccaneers, Emener appeared in 15 games (eight starts), going 2-4 with one save and a 5.40 ERA. He became the first pitcher in the nation to throw a four-strikeout inning during the season (reached on wild pitch).

AN ACE IN JACE: Grizzlies' RHP Jace Kaminska has been lights out over six starts this season. Kaminska is 2-1 with a 1.52 ERA and 0.91 WHIP, with the latter two ranking first in the California League. In 29.2 innings, he has allowed five runs (all earned), on 21 hits, six walks and two hit-by-pitches while punching out 34. Kaminska has started consecutive shutouts, giving Fresno five shutouts this season. He has tossed 12 straight scoreless innings, allowing nine hits and three walks while striking out 13.

HERRERA IS HIM: Grizzlies' LHP Welinton Herrera has nine consecutive scoreless outings from April 12-May 14. Herrera has tossed 13 innings, allowing six hits, two walks and one hit-by-pitch while striking out 25.

MADDEN IS MASTERFUL: Grizzlies' RHP Jake Madden has six straight scoreless appearances from April 19-May 12. Madden has tossed 11 innings, allowing four hits and three walks while fanning eight.

RISP IS A RISK: In the month of May, the Fresno Grizzlies hold a 6-8 record with 39 total runs scored (2.79 runs a game). A big reason for the lack of offense is the Grizzlies' inability to score with runners in scoring position (RISP). Over the 14 games in the month, Fresno is 23-for-117 (197) with four different instances where the team went 0-fer with runners in scoring position. The Grizzlies offense left eight runners on base and went 3-for-12 with RISP in the win yesterday.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had a great start to the season (30 games), going 27-for-93 (290 AVG/489 OBP/473 SLG/,962 OPS) with two homers, two triples, seven doubles, 18 RBI, 21 runs (one walk-off run), 31 walks, seven hitby-pitches and seven stolen bases. The Louisville product is ranked tied for first in the California League with a .489 OBP and tied for first in walks (31), Snider's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has also had an outstanding start to the season (33 games), going 40-for-135 (.296 AVG/.345 OBP/.474 SLG/.819 OPS) with four homers (one grand slam), three triples, six doubles, 21 RBI, 16 runs, 10 walks and two stolen bases. The Cuban native is ranked among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. He is ranked tied for first in hits (40), tied for second in total bases (64), tied for third in triples (3), sixth in extra-base hits (15), tied for seventh in homers (4), eighth in slugging percentage (474), tied for eighth in batting average (.296) and ninth in RBI (21). Perez had hit safely in his first 18 games and 23 of first 24 games to start the season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It was the second longest hit streak in the Grizzlies/Rockies affiliation since Drew Romo in 2021 (21 games, July 6-August 15) and it was the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball at the time. Perez went 26-for-76 (.342 AVG/.383 OBP/.579 SLG/.962 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and two stolen bases in that hit streak stretch. Like Snider, Perez's triple on April 24th against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kleschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.
