LRST TIME OUT

Syracuse, NY (June 28) -Scranton/Wilkes Barre dropped the second half opener 7-4 to Syracuse on Wednesday night. The RailRiders had three homers in the loss, including a team-high 20th for Estevan Florial.

Florial hammered the sixth pitch of the game for a leadoff home run. Then, Ben Rortvedt singled and Andres Chaparro walked to reach. Carlos Narvaez raced out an infield single to load the bases. Jamie Westbrook drew a walk sending in Rortvedt for a 2-0 advantage.

In the top of the second, Michael Hermsillo launched a 400-foot homer for a 2-0 advantage.

Nick Meyer led off the next frame with a home run of his own to get Syracuse on the board.

Westbrook began the fourth with a solo shot, his 10th of the season, to get the run right back.

A two-run fifth brought the Mets closer. Meyer had his second home run of the game just over the left field fence. DJ Steward recorded an RBI single making it 4-3. In the sixth, Syracuse batted through the order and then some. Back-to-back singles and a walk loaded the bases. Rafael Ortega singled up the middle to tie the game at four apiece. Jonathan Arauz knocked an RBI base hit to drive in two for the go-ahead runs. Mark Vientos capped off the inning with a line drive to left plating a run for a 7-4 advantage.

Tanner Tully (L, 5-2) pitched five and a third innings of work allowing six runs on ten hits. He left with the bases loaded in the sixth. DJ Snelten tossed the final two outs allowing the inherited runs to score and one more of his own. Deivi Garcia and Greg Weissert each threw a clean frame. Mike Vasil got the start for the Mets pitching just three innings. He let up four runs on six hits. Zach Muckenhirn and Eric Orze (W, 2-2) each tossed two clean frames. Steven Ridings and Jimmy Yacobonis (S, 2) threw a scoreless frame apiece.

NEWS & NOTES

BEETER TO THE FUTURE - RailRiders starter Clayton Beeter has been selected to represent the New York Yankees at the Futures Game during the All-Star break this season. The righty will join outfielder Spencer Jones out in Seattle. Beeter has started just one contest for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre after being promoted from Double-A Somerset on June 23. For the Patriots, he started 12 games, going 6-2 with a 2.08 ERA and 76 strikeouts across 60.2 innings. At the time of his promotion, Beeter led the Eastern League in ERA (2.08) and wins (6), while placing second in strikeouts (76) and third in opponent average (.204)

BULLPEN BEST - The RailRiders bullpen has impressed this season with a 3.86 earned run average in 308.0 innings pitched. The staff has totaled 362 strikeouts to just 173 walks. The 'pen was second in the International League with 19 saves led by Greg Weissert's six. Matt Krook impressed out of the pen with a 1.23 ERA in 21.0 innings pitched while Colten Brewer recorded a 1.37 ERA in 19.2 innings.

FIRST SHUTTY TOSSED - After being shutout five times this season, the last time being on Sunday, June 25 at home versus the Buffalo Bisons, the RailRiders have shutout their opponent. Starter Will Warren pitched 5.1 scoreless innings out of the gate. Four relievers combined for four clean frames. The staff allowed just six hits and five free passes. The toughest jam was in the first inning when Warren loaded the bases, but a strikeout ended the inning without a run.

WESTBROOK IS WORKING - In his birthday month, Jamie Westbrook has shined up at the plate. He is batting .368 in 17 games played with 21 total hits. In this time he had a team-high 15-game hitting streak. Westbrook has had four homers and 13 runs batted in the month. He has walked, 7, more than he has struck out, 6.

EGREGIOUS ERRORS - The RailRiders have committed a total of 71 errors on the season with one last night. This puts them fourth in the International League in this category two teams at 74. Andres Chaparro has the most with 11. Syracuse has made 53 miscues. Visalia leads all of Minor League Baseball with 106 errors.

HOMER HEAVEN - The RailRiders were the first International League team to hit 100 home runs and they now have 126. This puts them second in all of Minor League Baseball to the Las Vegas Aviators who have hit 127. Syracuse has 108 as a team. The New York Yankees have totaled 116. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. SWB homered 20 times against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty.

WHO'S ON FIRST -The RailRiders have had seven different first basemen this season. Andres Chaparro leads the way with 27 starts, while Billy McKinney has made 23 starts there. Mickey Gasper and Jake Bauers have also played their hands at first base this season. Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez each made their first professional start at the corner this season and now have each defended there a couple of times. Franchy Cordero also played a handful of frames at first.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect outfielder Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

YANKEES GOT HIM: Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

TJ TIME: Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS: Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeout

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2023: In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP, breaking his previous career mark of 5 IP, set in his final two starts of 2022. In the performance, Beeter started the Patriots' second shutout win of the season.
- 2022: Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER)
- 2021: Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing
