#### MEYER STARS AS JUMBO SHRIMP BLANK BULLS 7-0

Max Meyer fanned eight over 5.0 perfect innings Tuesday to lead Jacksonville to a 7-0 triumph over Durham. Meyer departed from the game while warming up for the sixth inning due to a calf cramp. Durham did not earn its first hit until the seventh, and the Bulls mustered just two for the game. The Jumbo Shrimp offered plenty of run support for Meyer as well; Peyton Burdick homered in the first and Jacksonville tallied five runs in the second to go up 6-0. A Charles Leblanc RBI double in the second capped the scoring at 7-0.

#### **MAX POWER**

Jumbo Shrimp starter **Max Meyer** was dominant in Tuesday's series opener in Durham. The right-hander struck out eight of the 15 Bulls he faced, retiring each of them before departing from the game. Jacksonville carried a perfect game for 5.2 innings before **Zach Pop** walked a man, with Durham's **Cal Stevenson** ended the no-hit bid with a leadoff single against Pop in the seventh. The effort resulted in the Jumbo Shrimp's first shutout of the season, after going 9-6 in such games in 2021.

### LEBLANC OF THE BALL

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Charles Leblanc** collected two more hits and an RBI in Tuesday's victory over Durham, continuing his sizzling start to the season. The native of Laval, QC in Canada is 9-for-18 (.500) to begin the season. Of those nine hits, five have gone for extra bases with his three doubles and two home runs. Leblanc leads the International League in batting average, slugging (1.000) and OPS (1.571) while reaching base in 12 of his 21 plate appearances to rank second in on-base percentage (.571).

### BATMEN

Through seven games on the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have compiled 35 runs, a total of 5.0 per game, which is tied for fourth in the International League. Jacksonville has done this mainly by scoring in bunches thus far this season. The Jumbo Shrimp have plated multiple runs in an inning in 10 of the 20 frames the club has tallied in thus far. Additionally, the club's has avoided long scoring droughts for the most part, with just one scoreless stretch of more than six innings throughout the campaign's first seven games.

### POWER UP?

Though Jacksonville is 2-5 to start the season, the Jumbo Shrimp have popped seventh home runs thus far, tied for eighth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast of late; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. The last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its league in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers.

#### RISP-Y BUSINESS

The Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for fourth in the International League in runs per game at 5.0 runs per game, accomplishing that feat despite ranking no better than eighth in any major offensive category. The biggest indication as to why has been the club's strong performance with runners on base. With the bases empty, Jacksonville is hitting just .208/.295/.338, producing a .633 OPS that ranks 14th in the 20-team league. However, with runners on base, the club's batting line has surged to .264/.344/.436, with the resulting .780 OPS placing third in the circuit. Perhaps the club's true talent level is somewhere in the middle; Jumbo Shrimp hitters have a .274 BABIP with the bases empty but .321 with runners on base. Both figures are far from the baseball-wide .300 batting average on balls in play.

### LEWIN AND <del>CLARK</del> BURDICK

Both **Lewin Díaz** and **Peyton Burdick** have gotten off to a strong starts to the season. Díaz is 9-for-28 to begin the campaign, slashing .321/.355/.464/.819 with a double, home run, seven RBIs and four runs scored. Meanwhile, Burdick, the Marlins' Minor League Player of the Year in 2021, is 7-for-his-first-26, compiling a batting line of .269/.387/.500/.887 with two homers, four RBIs and seven runs. Thus, of the 35 runs the Jumbo Shrimp have scored this season - a figure that ranks fourth in the International League - the pair have accounted for 19 of those tallies (not double-counting home runs), a ratio of 54.3 percent.

### SHRIMP SKEWER

Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have at least nine strikeouts in six of the season's first seven games.

#### ABOUT BRAXTON

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

### 2022 SEASON

### 2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season.

-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

### 2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.

-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames.

### 2019 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted to Jacksonville on August 28 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the southpaw ranked fourth in the Florida State League in batting average against (.230), fourth in strikeouts (118) and ninth in ERA (3.34).

-Out of the 109 pitchers in the Florida State League with at least 50.0 innings pitched, Garrett was 11th in xFIP (2.72) and 20th in strikeout percentage (26.9 percent). He had posted the circuit's 10th-lowest fly ball rate (27.8 percent) and 15th-highest ground ball rate (52.7 percent).

### **2018 SEASON**

-Garrett did not pitch during the 2018 season, as he was recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

### 2017 SEASON

-The Florence, Ala., native did not allow more than one run in each of his first three professional starts. However, he surrendered four runs on six hits in 1.2 frames on May 25 against Kannapolis, which turned out to be his final outing before he underwent Tommy John Surgery.

### ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Had he not decided to turn pro, Garrett had signed to pitch at Vanderbilt University.
