**TODAY'S GAMES:** Coming off a 5-2 victory, the Space Cowboys have won three straight and have a chance to clinch their second straight series with a win on Friday night... Dating back to last season, Sugar Land has won eight straight games at Isotopes Park where the Space Cowboys won nine of 12 games in 2023.

**ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT:** Sugar Land was held off the board in the first but a Shay Whitcomb solo homer in the second gave the Space Cowboys a 1-0 lead after two... Joey Loperfido added his sixth homer of the year in the third, and Corey Julks and Loperfido each drove in runs in the fifth to make it 4-0 Space Cowboys... On the hill, RHP AJ Blubaugh gave up just two hits and struck out six in 5.0 shutout innings for his Triple-A debut... Grant Lavinge hit a two-run homer in the sixth to cut it to 5-2 Sugar Land, but a combination of Bryan King, Logan VanWey and Wander Suero combined for 3.0 shutout innings, giving up just one hit to lock up a Space Cowboys victory.

**ROSTER MOVES:** 4/12 - RHP Joel Kuhnel contract selected by Houston... LHP Parker Mushinski optioned to Sugar Land... RHP Wander Suero designated for assignment... RHP Miguel Diaz signed as a free agent and assigned to Sugar Land... 4/10 - RHP Spencer Arrighetti recalled by Houston... RHP A.J. Blubaugh promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus... LHP Julio Robaina transferred to Corpus... RHP Wander Suero optioned to Sugar Land... OF Cooper Hummel designated for assignment...

**HOME GROWN TALENT:** Sugar Land's active roster has 13 players that were drafted by the Astros, five free agent signings, four players acquired in trades, two international free agents, one waiver claim, one MiLB Rule 5 Draft pick and two undrafted free agent.

**PROSPECTING:** The Space Cowboys roster sports six of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline, including: OF/INF Joey Loperfido (#6), RHP A.J. Blubaugh (#8), RHP Rhett Kouba (#14), INF Will Wagner (#15), INF Jacob Amaya (#23) and OF Pedro León (#27).

**SERIES-OUSLY SPEAKING:** With a victory on Saturday night, the Space Cowboys picked up their first series win on the year in their first six-game series and are 1-1-0 overall on the season... In 2023, Sugar Land went 6-15-2 in six-game series including 4-8-1 overall at Constellation Field.

**FAST STARTERS:** Through the first 12 games of the year, the Space Cowboys own a +21 run differential in the first inning, having plated 21 runs without giving up a run in the opening stanza... The Space Cowboys have scored first in 11 of 12 games and have scored in the first inning in nine of 12 contests... They have also scored multiple runs in six of 12 games.

**ONE-HIT WONDER:** Sugar Land one-hit the Aviators on Friday night, hurling their first shutout of 2024 in just their seventh game of the year... It took Sugar Land until September 5, 2023 to throw their first shutout last season (Game 133)... Friday was the fourth one-hitter thrown in Space Cowboys history.

**LOWDOWN ON LOPERFIDO:** OF Joey Loperfido has followed up his breakout 2023 season with a hot start to 2024... Loperfido homered in his first at bat on Opening Night at Round Rock, and launched another first inning home run on 3/30, part of a two-homer game... It was the fourth multi-homer game of Loperfido's career, with the last coming on 4/21/23 vs. San Antonio while Loperfido was with Double-A Corpus Christi.

The 24-year-old has hit safely in five straight games and also scored at least one run in five straight, extending his streak on Thursday night with his sixth homer of the year... He leads the Pacific Coast League in Runs Scored (14) and is 2nd in Home Runs (6) & Total Bases (32), 3rd in SLG (.711), T-3rd in RBI (15), 9th in OPS (1.069).

**DEBUT SZN:** This week in Albuquerque, the Space Cowboys have had a pair of pitchers make their Triple-A debut with LHP Julio Robaina and RHP AJ Blubaugh... Robaina allowed two runs in 4.2 innings with five strikeouts... Meanwhile, Blubaugh gave up just two hits while tying a career-high 5.0 innings, not allowing a run with six strikeouts... Blubaugh generated 17 swings-and-misses, including six of 11 swings on his fastball and five of 11 swings on his curveball.

**HEY, I'M WALKIN'!:** On Tuesday night at Albuquerque, the Space Cowboys drew 14 walks, a single-game franchise record, surpassing 13 walks in a game which Sugar Land last achieved on... Tuesday, April 2 vs. Las Vegas... 11 of the walks against Albuquerque came in the 5th, 6th and 7th inning... The Space Cowboys have worked 71 walks in 2024, tied with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the most in MiLB.

**HITS FROM HAVANA:** OF Pedro León had his nine-game hitting streak snapped on Thursday night, going 0-for-5, but is still batting .349 (15-for-43) with four doubles and 13 RBI... León also had his RBI streak snapped at seven games, the longest streak of any player in the PCL in 2024... He is tied for third in the PCL in Hits (15), T-5th in RBI (13) and 8th in Batting Average (.349).

VAN-WHY NOT: RHP Logan VanWey has not allowed a run in his first five outings in 2024, throwing more than an inning in two of his first five appearances... The righty has given up just three hits in 6.2 innings and struck out nine, including a scoreless inning on Thursday night.

**TWIN KILLINGS:** Defensively, the Space Cowboys have turned 15 double plays in their first 12 games, getting at least one twin killing in 10 of 12 games... Sugar Land leads the Pacific Coast League in fielding percentage (.986) and leads Minor League Baseball in double plays... The Space Cowboys turned 143 double plays in 2023, which ranked seventh in the PCL.

**SPACE COWBOYS IN THE SHOW:** For a third consecutive day, the Space Cowboys had a player get his contract selected by the Astros on Wednesday... RHP Spencer Arrighetti had his contract selected on Wednesday night and made his Major League debut in Kansas City versus the Royals... RHP Wander Suero had his contract selected on Tuesday by Houston... RHP Blair Henley had his contract selected by the Astros on Monday night and made his Major League debut against the Rangers... While Henley allowed five runs, he did not receive a decision in a 10-5 Astros victory... Meanwhile, former Space Cowboys righty Ronel Blanco was named the American League Pitcher of the Week after throwing a no-hitter on April 1 vs. Toronto and following it up with 6.0 one-hit innings on Sunday at Texas.

**WHIT-BOMBS RETURN:** After winning the Joe Bauman Award in 2023 for leading Minor League Baseball in home runs with 35, INF Shay Whitcomb uncorked his first long ball of the year on 3/31 at Round Rock, a grand slam in the ninth... Whitcomb's grand slam left the bat at 111.4 mph and needed just 4.4 second to sail 430 feet out of the ballpark.

**WALK THIS WAY:** On 4/2 vs. Las Vegas, the Space Cowboys drew 13 walks, which tied the franchise record for most walks in a single game at the time... The other time Sugar Land earned 13 free passes was in Game 2 of a doubleheader on August 19, 2022... The Space Cowboys scored 17 runs in the sixth inning of that game and would end up winning 21-4 in seventh innings... Sugar Land would break the walks record one week later on 4/9 @ Albuquerque, drawing 14 walks.

**HISTORY FOR BLANCO:** Former Space Cowboys reliever and starter RHP Ronel Blanco (2021-23) authored the 17th no-hitter in Astros' franchise history on April 1 at Minute Maid Park, walking just two batters... The no-hitter came in Blanco's 8th career start in the Majors... Blanco becomes the first Space Cowboys hurler to make his debut and then throw a no-hitter in the Major Leagues... LHP Framber Valdez appeared in two games with Sugar Land in 2021 before throwing his no-hitter on August 1, 2023.

**RIDE THE BIKE!:** On June 24, 2023, OF Pedro León hit for the cycle in reverse order, homering in the 3rd, tripling in the 5th, doubling in the 7th and singling in the 8th... It is the first cycle in Space Cowboys history and the first for León at any level in his career... The La Habana native also reached on a walk and a hit by pitch and scored all six times he reached, setting a new single-game record for runs scored in Space Cowboys history.

**SEEING 20-20-20:** Both Pedro León (23 2B, 21 HR) and Joey Loperfido (27 2B, 25 HR) posted seasons in 2023 in which they had at least 20 doubles and 20 home runs while stealing at least 20 bases (León - 21; Loperfido - 27)... They were two of just 23 players in Minor League Baseball to have at least 20 doubles, 20 homers and 20 stolen bases, with Corpus Christi OF Kenedy Corona joining them (21 2B, 22 HR, 32 SB)... INF Shay Whitcomb came just one double shy of joining that group, but along with León and Loperfido was one of just 33 players with at least 20 steals and 20 home runs.

**UN DULCE IDENTIDAD:** As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will once again rebrand on multiple occasions in 2024 as "Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard once again be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at slspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on Milb.TV, Mlb.TV, the Milb App and on Bally Live. Garrett Greene returns for his second season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his fourth season calling games for Sugar Land.

**NOW HERE'S A STOREY:** Mickey Storey returns for his fifth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his fourth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with three seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

**REST OF THE CREW:** Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Thomas Whitsett, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Whitsett enters his first season as the Space Cowboys pitching coach, replacing Erick Abreu, who joined the Atlanta Braves in 2024 as their bullpen coach. Whitsett was the Astros' Assistant Pitching Coordinator in 2023 and served as the Pitching Coach for Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022. He also worked as a pitching coach for Single-A Fayetteville in 2019 before spending a year out of the Astros organization as the director of player development for pitching at the University of Arizona in 2021. Westlake returns for his second season as Sugar Land's hitting coach and previously was the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi in 2022 and a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his third season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

**A LITTLE ABOUT US:** Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.
