# INDY BITS

ABOUT YESTERDAY: Paul Skenes, MLB Pipeline's No. 3 overall prospect, tossed a career high 4.1 innings and Nick Gonzales raised his batting average to .402 on the year as the Indianapolis Indians defeated the Omaha Storm Chasers at Werner Park on Wednesday afternoon, 7-4. The Indians combined to score five runs in the first two innings, enough to stave off a late comeback effort by the Storm Chasers. They jumped on the board in the first inning courtesy of a Malcom Nuñez RBI single to score Ji Hwan Bae following a leadoff walk. The Indians then piled on with four runs in the second, with a two-run double off the bat of Liover Peguero highlighting the frame. Omaha got one run back in the bottom of the second inning when Nate Eaton drove in CJ Alexander after a oneout triple. In the fourth, Nuñez collected his second RBI of the game with an RBI single to plate Peguero. The Storm Chasers matched the run on a fielders' choice and subsequent throwing error by Skenes. With Indianapolis still leading by four runs in the sixth inning, Gonzales continued a hot start to the season with his second home run of 2024. Omaha then cut into Indy's lead in the eighth via back-to-back singles by Eaton and Brian O'Keefe, but the comeback effort was stymied as Brent Honeywell ended the frame on a strikeout.

SKENES STRIKES OUT SEVEN: Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated as the No. 3 prospect in MiLB, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) made his fifth Triple-A start yesterday at Omaha and struck out seven over a career-high 4.1 innings. As the MiLB.TV Free Game of the Day, all eyes were on the 21-year-old, who has racked up 34 strikeouts in just 17.0 innings pitched this season. Skenes allowed his first run of the season in the second inning when CJ Alexander hit a one-out triple and was driven in on a Nate Eaton single. He also allowed an unearned run in the bottom of the fourth.

GONE FOR GONZO: Nick Gonzales, the International League's hottest hitter to begin the 2024, led the Indians yesterday with three hits in their afternoon victory in Omaha. He went 3-for-5 with two runs, a home run and two RBI, with his sixth-inning long ball marking his second of the season. The performance extended his league-leading on-base streak to a career-high 21 games dating back to Opening Day on 3/29. His current 20-gamer narrowly beats his previous career-high of 15 games from 4/9-30/22 with Double-A Altoona and is tied with Columbus' Johnathan Rodriguez for the longest in the IL this season. He also extended his hitting streak to 14 games dating back to 4/6, one game shy of tying Buffalo's Orelvis Martinez' league-leading 15-game hitting streak earlier this season. The middle infielder currently leads all International League leaders in batting average (.402), doubles (11) and hits (35), while also ranking among leaders in runs (2nd, 22), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 14), total bases (T-3rd, 54), OPS (6th, 1.074), on-base percentage (8th, .453) and slugging

**LOOK AT JAKE LAMB:** Jake Lamb and Nick Gonzales have been playing leap frog at the top of the International League batting average leaderboard this season, with Nick Gonzales leaping Lamb's .392 batting average (20-for-51) with a three-hit performance yesterday. As Indianapolis' designated hitter, Lamb reached base safely in three of four plate appearances with a team-high three walks in yesterday's contest. With the performance, he trails Gonzales in batting average while also ranking among league leaders in on-base percentage (2nd, .500) and OPS (7th, 1.069).

NO DOUBTING THE DOUBLES: The Indians' 53 doubles are the third-most among all 30 Triple-A teams this season behind Albuquerque (64) and Oklahoma City (60) and the most in the International League. In addition to leading the International League, Nick Gonzales is currently leading the Triple-A pack with 11 two-baggers. The Indians as a team are also hitting .276 (206-for-747), good for the third-best batting average in the IL behind Durham (.277, 222-for-802) and Buffalo (.276, 197-for-713).

OMAHA OUTHITS: The Indians were outhit by Omaha last night, 11-8, marking just the ninth time in 23 games that Indianapolis has been outhit by their opponent and the second game where they have emerged victorious while being outhit.

TODAY: The Indianapolis Indians will look to take a lead in the six-game series tonight at 7:35 PM ET in Omaha. Last season, the Indians went 5-12 vs. Omaha with a 5-4 record at Werner Park. Taking the mound for Indianapolis in his second start of the season is RHP Wily Peralta (1-0, 7.15) after tossing 3.0 one-run innings last Friday in his first start against St. Paul. Countering for the Storm Chasers will be RHP Luis Cessa (0-2, 8.31) in his fifth appearance (fourth start) this season. Cessa has made three career starts against Indianapolis in 2015 with Toledo and 2016 with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, going 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (8er/16.0ip) and 15 strikeouts.

NO PROBLEM FOR PERALTA: Wily Peralta made his first start of the 2024 season last Friday night and shut down the Saints offense with 3.0 innings of one-hit ball, his only baserunner surrendered coming via a Tony Kemp solo homer in the second inning. He paved the way for a successful bullpen day for Indianapolis in which just three pitchers combined to hold St. Paul to two runs. Nick Dombkowski tossed 4.0 one-run frames — tying the longest outing by an Indians reliever this season. Brady Feigl then entered, earning the win with 2.0 perfect innings and four strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 1954: In the second game of a twin bill at Columbus, left-hander Herb Score fanned 11 batters in a 7.0-inning, complete-game effort to give the Indians an 8-1 win and doubleheader sweep. The victory was the first of an American Association-leading 22 wins for the southpaw. He also led the league in ERA (2.62) and strikeouts (330), the latter holding as the American Association single-season record to this day. Indians center fielder Rocky Colavito homered in both contests, and Indy finished with eight long balls combined between the games.
