Today's Game

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the fourth/fifth-of-18 games between the teams this season and fourth/fifth-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. New Hampshire returns to Reading from June 10-15 and the Fightin Phils head to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. Reading won the 2024 season-series over the Fisher Cats 11-6, and leads the season-series 3-0.

Game 33 Recap

The script turned from Thursday and it was a low-scoring affair on Friday night as Reading won 3-2 to extend its season-best winning streak to four games. Gabe Mosser started and turned in his best outing of the season. He went a season-high, and team-high, 6.2 innings and allowed just one runs on three hits, along with six strikeouts. The Fightin Phils struck first in the bottom of the first, thanks to a two-run home run from Hendry Mendez. Aidan Miller then clubbed his fourth home run of the season in the bottom of the fifth to make it 3-0, Reading. New Hampshire scored a run in the top of the seventh, thanks to a solo home run from Eddinson Paulino. The Fisher Cats made it 3-2 in the eighth with a run off Andrew Baker and Josh Hejka picked up his first save with Reading in his Fightin Phils debut with a scoreless top of the ninth inning.

It's Miller Time

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller stayed hot with two hits, two runs, a double and home run in Friday night's game. Miller reached base all four times as he was also walked and hit by a pitch in the win. Miller has now reached base in 23 of his last 26 games played in, dating back to April 12 and has a .354 on-base percentage over that stretch. Miller has also proven to be a threat on the base paths as his 12 steals rank tied for fourth in the Eastern League.

Go Keaton Go

Keaton Anthony stayed red-hot with his second-straight multi-hit game on Friday night. Anthony has multiple hits in back-to-back games, three-of-four, and four-of-six contests. He has also doubled in back-to-back games, three-of-four and five-of-seven contests. Since May 7 (six games), anthony is slashing .440/.462/.760 (1.222 OPS), with three runs, five doubles, one home run and seven RBI. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 5th AVG (.317), 7th SLG (7th), 5th OPS (.890), 1st 2B (13), 3rd XBH (16) and 6th RISP AVG (.350).

Mashing Mendez

Hendry Mendez picked up his second-straight multi-hit game on Friday night, and also homered in his second-straight contest as well. After now homering over the first 24 games he played in this season, Mendez now has home runs in three of the last six games he's played in. If Mendez homers in the first game he plays on Saturday, he will become the first R-Phil to homer in three-straight games sine Gabriel Rincones Jr. from Aug. 9-10, 2024, at Akron. This week, Mendez is slashing .455/.417/.1.091 (1.508 OPS), with three runs, one double, two home runs and four RBI. Entering play today, Mendez is seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.306) and ninth in on-base percentage (.376).

Alumni Spotlight

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Friday that Phillies No. 8 Prospect Mick Abel will make his Double-A debut on Sunday, starting on the mound against the Pittsburgh Pirates. Abel played in Reading in the back-part of the 2022 season and all of 2023. He struggled last season in Lehigh Valley (AAA), but has been spectacular for the IronPigs this season. Abel will become the first former R-Phil to make their big-league debut in 2025. With Abel's debut, the Phillies will become the last team in baseball to have a player make their major league debut this season.

Chace Update

Phillies Manager Rob Thomson announced on Friday afternoon that Fightin Phils pitcher, and Phillies No. 5 prospect, Moises Chace will undergo Tommy John Surgery and miss the remainder of the 2025 season. Chace was acquired by the Phillies, along with Seth Johnson, in a trade that sent Gregory Soto to Baltimore in July of 2024. Chace was stellar down the stretch of last season for the Fightin Phils, which included a 13-strikeout game at Somerset at the end of August.

Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters today with a 14-21 record, sitting in fifth place in the Northeast Division. 2024 was a down season for New Hampshire, as they finished with an Eastern League-worse 52-84 record. The Fisher Cats went 3-2 last week against Hartford at home and after this week return back home and welcome Somerset. The Fisher Cats' roster features six of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Charles McAdoo (13), RJ Schreck (20), Ryan Jennings (21), Jace Bohrofen (24), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

On the Mound for the Cats

Righty Ryan Watson starts game one tonight for New Hampshire. Watson is 2-2, with a 1.85 ERA over six games and five starts this season. On May 10 vs Hartford, he took the loss, allowing six runs (three earned) over five innings, with three strikeouts. The 26-year old signed with the Blue Jays as a free agent in May of 2024 after pitching for Florence in the Frontier League. Righty Deveraux Harrison starts game two for the Fisher Cats. Over six starts, Harrison is 2-4, with a 5.81 ERA. On May 11 vs Hartford, Harrison earned the win, allowing two runs on three hits over six innings, with five strikeouts. The 24-year old was drafted by Toronto in the ninth round of the 2022 draft out of Long Beach State.

King bounced back with five-solid innings in game one of last Saturday's doubleheader at Binghamton. He matched a season and career-high with five innings and tossed a career-best 77 pitches. After cruising through the first three innings, he allowed one run each in the fourth and fifth frames, but was able to work out of jams and avoid any further trouble. He exited with a lead, but the bullpen surrendered the lead. King was relieved in the bottom of the sixth by Gunner Mayer.
