#### **SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

<u>OFFENSE, OFFENSE AND MORE</u>: With an eight-run performance on Wednesday, the Shuckers have scored at least seven runs in six of their last seven games, going 4-3 over that span... Over that span, which dates back to July 8, the Shuckers' 54 runs are the second-most in Double-A and the sixth-most out of all full-season teams in Minor League Baseball... The Shuckers own a .329/.406/.552 slash line over that span, good for a .958 OPS, over 200-points higher than the Southern League average.

HAPPY HIT PARADE: The Shuckers tallied 10 hits on Wednesday, their third straight games with 10-plus hits... Over that span, the Shuckers have tallied 42 hits, an average of 1.6 per inning... OF Jackson Chourio has led the charge, going 13-27 [.481] with three doubles and three home runs over his current six-game hit streak, with five of the six being multi-hit performances... Six different Shuckers have tallied a multi-hit performance over the first two games, including two straight from INF Tyler Black (6-10, 2B, HR).

**SWIPER, NO SWIPING: C Jeferson Quero** enters today with the fourth-highest caught stealing percentage (36%) out of all qualified catchers in Minor League Baseball... His 38 stolen bases allowed are also the lowest out of any catcher in Double-A with at least 400 innings behind the plate... In July, Quero has allowed two stolen bases in eight games behind the plate.

THE HOME RUN BARRAGE: On Tuesday night, OF Lamar Sparks, INF Tyler Black and OF Jackson Chourio tallied back-to-back-to-back home runs, the first time the Shuckers had done so since May 14, 2022 against the Birmingham Barons at MGM Park... The Shuckers tallied four home runs on Tuesday, tied for their most in a game this year... The Shuckers have also tallied a home run in 12 of 14 games in July, hitting 22 in the month.

<u>HE'S ON THE MOVE</u>: With a stolen base on Wednesday, **INF Tyler Black** has 43 stolen bases in 2023, nine away from tying **OF Johnny Davis**' franchise record of 52, set in 2017... Black enters today with 15 stolen bases against the Biscuits, the most by any opposing player this year... Black currently leads the Southern League and Double-A in the category.
