ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Led by Nick Gonzales' four-hit day, the Indianapolis Indians boomed with eight of nine starting position players recording at least one run, hit and RBI in a series-opening 10-6 win over the St. Paul Saints at Victory Field on Tuesday. The Saints took an early first-inning lead on back-to-back triples to begin the game, the first of which came off the bat of former Indian Diego Castillo. The lead was short-lived, however, as a run-scoring groundout by Pirates rehabber Yasmani Grandal knotted the game in the bottom half. A back-and-forth contest continued from there. Down 2-1 in the third inning, the Indians were off to the races with a three-run third inning, sparked by back-to-back doubles by Smith-Njigba and Bae. It was their first of three consecutive run-scoring frames, countering a two-run fourth by St. Paul with an RBI triple by Gonzales in the fourth and pair of RBI singles by Gilberto Celestino and Smith-Niigba in the fifth. Indianapolis never relinquished the lead, but the offense continued rolling. Following a two-run Will Holland homer in the sixth to bring St. Paul within one, another three-run frame in the eighth took the game out of reach. RBI singles by McKinney and Smith-Njibga sandwiched a double by Matt Gorski

GONZO STREAKING: Nick Gonzales, who hit for the cycle at Victory Field on Sept. 19, 2023, vs. Rochester, went 4-for-5 last night and was a home run shy of becoming just the first batter in franchise history to accomplish the feat twice. He doubled, singled and tripled in consecutive at-bats through the fourth inning before flying out in the sixth and knocking another single in the seventh. He has been on fire to begin the season, logging a team-high eight-game hitting streak from 4/6-16 and a league-leading, career-high tying 15-game on-base streak from 3/29-4/16. His last 15-gamer came with Double-A Altoona from 4/9-30/22. Eight of his 15 games have featured multi-hit performances, and he currently leads IL leaders in batting average (.397), hits (25) and doubles (9) while also ranking in extra-base hits (T-2nd, 11), runs (3rd, 16), total bases (4th, 39) and OPS (9th, 1.060).

CANAAN CATCHES FIRE: In his first game acting as Indianapolis' designated hitter this season, Canaan Smith-Nijgba went 3-for-3 with two runs, a double, two RBI and walk in last night's victory over St. Paul. It was just his second multi-hit game in nine contests with Indy this season and jumped his batting average from .200 to .286 (8-for-28). After not driving in a run through his first six games, Smith-Nijgba now has two extra-base hits and five RBI since 4/13 (2) at Toledo.

OFFENSIVE WOWS: The Indians as a team are currently hitting .283 (149-for-526), good for the second-best batting average in all of Triple-A behind Durham (.298, 173-for-581). Led by Nick Gonzales' nine, they also rank second in the league with 41 doubles, only trailing Omaha (43). In additional offensive categories, Indy ranks 6th in hits, ninth in slugging percentage (.441) and 10th in OPS (.805).

NOT TRIPING OVER TRIPLES: After leading the International League with 42 three-baggers in 2023, the Indians jumped on the triple train yesterday with a pair off the bats of Nick Gonzales and Liover Peguero. It was each of their first triples of the season and Indy's third overall, with Gonzales tying for the league lead with eight three-baggers a year ago. The Indians are now tied for the sixth-most triples this season, with Nashville's seven leading the league.

BAE'S BACK: After hitting .500 (5-for-10) through three games of his rehab assignment, utilityman Ji Hwan Bae continued his hot streak in Triple-A with a 2-for-4 showing in his first game after being optioned. He joined the double parade with an RBI two-bagger to spark Indy's momentum for a comeback win, and also scored two runs of his own. It was his first appearance with Indy not on a rehab assignment since making his big-league debut in September 2022, and in 13 total games since then he is hitting .391 (18-for-46) with 13 runs, six extra-base hits and a 1.126 OPS.

CELLY'S SNATCH: Indians left fielder Gilberto Celestino made a leaping grab against the LED videoboard in left field last night, swiping extra-base hits and a game-tying run away from St. Paul in the top of the seventh inning last night. The Indians were leading, 7-6, when a long fly ball off the bat of catcher Patrick Winkel soared Celestino's way. He also had another stellar catch in the game, leaping for a fly ball down the right-field line. Statistically, his best corner-outfield position has been right field, logging a .982 fielding percentage (one error in 55 total chances) in 317.0 career Triple-A innings at the position. He owns a .978 fielding percentage (2 errors, 93 total chances) in center field and a .933 fielding percentage (2 errors, 30 total chances) in left.

TODAY: The Indianapolis Indians will look to build on their series-opening victory last night in the second contest of a six-game series vs. the St. Paul Saints this week. It is their first of three head-to-head series this season, two of which come at Victory Field (also: 8/13-18). Last season, the Saints narrowly edged the Indians, 10 wins to eight, with four wins coming in six games in Indianapolis. Continuing the series for Indy today is LHP Cam Alldred (0-2, 10.00), who is looking for a bounce-back start in his fourth outing of the year. Countering for the Saints is RHP David Festa (0-0, 2.16), who is currently ranked as Minnesota's No. 5 prospect and top pitching prospect via MLB Pipeline.

THIS DATE IN 1997: In front of 13,899 fans — Bush Stadium's largest Opening Night crowd ever — the Indians were no-hit by Oklahoma City for eight innings but still won the game 1-0 thanks to a bases-loaded walk drawn by shortstop Wil Cordero in the bottom of the sixth that forced home left fielder John Vander Wal. OKC's starting pitcher Roger Pavlik walked seven in 5.1 innings pitched to suffer the loss. Indy drew 10 walks offensively, and Mark Gardner (4.2ip, Oh, 5bb, 7k), Dana Ridenour (W, 3.1ip, 2h, 0bb, 4k) and Doug Piatt (S, 1.0ip, 0h, 0bb, 0k) combined on the two-hit shutout.

Cam Alldred: Southpaw Cam Alldred is set to make his fourth start of the season today vs. Toledo.

Last Outing: Alldred surrendered seven runs in 2.0 innings in Game 2 of last Saturday's doubleheader at Toledo.

Against the Saints: Alldred made three starts vs. St. Paul in 2023, going 0-1 with a 5.56 ERA (7er/11.1ip) and 13 strikeouts.

Cam is the Man: Cam Alldred spent the 2023 season as the Indians' ultimate go-to man, making 17 starts and 14 appearances out of the bullpen. He recorded his first career quality start on 6/16 at lowa (6.0ip, 2r) to kick off a stretch of three consecutive such starts and four total on the season. He went 3-7 with a 4.44 ERA (39er/79.0ip) and 74 strikeouts as a starter and 5-1 with a 7.43 ERA (22er/26.2ip) and 24 strikeouts in relief.
