MCGINNIS MAGIC: Connor McGinnis tied a Somerset Double-A franchise record on Friday with 12 total bases as part of his first ever four-hit game and his first ever two-home run game. The 12 TB tied Tyler Hardman (7/1/23 at BOW) and Agustín Ramírez (6/7/24 vs. HFD), who both had three-homer games in their occurrence. Finishing a double shy of the cycle, McGinnis became the first Patriot in franchise history to hit two home runs and a triple in the same game and the first Eastern League player to accomplish that sequence since Trei Cruz (ERI, 7/25/23). McGinnis became the ninth Patriot to ever have a triple and home run in a single game and first since Tyler Hardman on 9/13/25 at Reading.

CAN'T STOP CONNOR: Over his last seven games, Connor McGinnis has reached base safely in 15 of his last 28 plate appearances (.536 OBP) by going 13-for-26 (.500 AVG) with 7 XBH, 2 BB and four multi-hit games in that stretch. Across his last 16 games dating back to 6/24, McGinnis is batting .382/.424/.673 (1.097 OPS) with 7 RBI, 11 XBH and six multi-hit games.

SPLITTING THE GS: Over the last 23 games since hitting his first Double-A home run on 6/16 @POR, Connor McGinnis is slashing .333/.388/.628 with 4 HR, 15 RBI and 14 XBH with a 1.016 OPS. In his first 20 Double-A games, he was slashing .221/.312/.235 with 1 XBH, 4 RBI and a .547 OPS.

THE MORE, THE MERRIER: On Friday, Connor McGinnis became the 11th Patriot this season to record a multi-home run game and the first since Josh Moylan (6/30 vs. HFD). McGinnis' effort was the 14th total multi-HR game by a Patriot this season. With his career-high four hits, he joined George Lombard Jr., Jace Avina, Tyler Hardman, Marco Luciano and Nick Torres as the sixth Patriot to record a four-hit game this season.

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: The Somerset Patriots enter today leading all Double-A teams with 126 HR, which is also tied for 7th in MiLB. The Patriots have recorded multiple HR in 37 of 86 games this season, already surpassing their total of 35 multi-home run games during the entire 2025 season (in 138 games).

WHERE'S THE CATCH? In the first 77 games this season from April through May, Somerset's catching corps batted .212 with 10 XBH (4 HR), 31 RBI and a .555 OPS. In nine games during July, Somerset's catching corps is batting .377 with 6 XBH (2 HR), 12 RBI and a .959 OPS. Miguel Palma is currently on a four-game hit streak that includes his first two three-hit games of the season. Over his last six games, Palma is 10-for-22 (.455 AVG) with 2 HR, 1 2B, 8 RBI, 7 R and 1 BB (1.251 OPS). Manny Palencia enters today with hits in five of his last six games, including his second and third three-hit games of the season. During the streak, he is 10-for-23 (.435 AVG) with 3 RBI and 3 XBH (1.023 OPS). In this week's series opener, Frick pieced together his first Double-A three-hit game.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR! Patriots reliever Ben Grable has been added to the American League's roster for the MLB All-Star Futures Game on Sunday, replacing Carlos Lagrange, who is currently on the 7-day IL for Triple-A SWB. Grable was selected by the Yankees in the 11th round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of Indiana. Over his first 28 career appearances (22 with Somerset), Grable is 3-1 with a 2.61 ERA, 49 K and 10 BB in 31.0 IP with a .131 BAA, 0.77 WHIP and 14/23 K/9 IP. Over his last 12 appearances, Grable has posted a 0.73 ERA, 0.65 WHIP, .075 BAA with 18 K to 5 BB in 12.1 IP.

THE SCOOP ON COOP: Somerset Patriots manager James Cooper will represent the Patriots and the Yankees as the third base coach for the AL at the MLB All-Star Futures Game in Philadelphia on July 12th. Currently in his fifth season with the Yankees and his fourth as a manager, Cooper was the 2023 FCL Manager of the Year in his first year managing. He also managed the Arizona Fall League's Mesa Solar Sox in 2023.

ALL-STAR HONORS: Ahead of MLB All-Star Weekend, Cam Schlichter and Ben Rice were both named American League All-Stars. The duo became the first two former Somerset Patriots to ever be named Major League All-Stars. Rice will also become the first former Patriot to participate in the Home Run Derby on Monday 7/13. Rice's 28 home runs this season rank 3rd in MLB.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.

2024-2025

After being drafted by the Yankees in 2024, Rivas did not pitch and instead recovered from Tommy John Surgery. He opened professional career in 2025 by pitching in four games with the FCL Yankees. He won Florida Complex League Pitcher of the Week honors after tossing 4.2 IP without surrendering a hit, striking out eight at the FCL Tigers on 5/13/25. He finished his stint with the FCL Yankees winning FCL Pitcher of the Month honors for May after racking up a 1-0 record, 1.15 ERA, 0.83 WHIP, .078 BAA and 22 K, allowing just four hits in 15.2 IP. He was promoted to Single-A Tampa on 6/1/25. Against Fort Myers on 6/27/25, Rivas fanned a MiLB career-high 13 K without surrendering a walk in 5.2 IP. Starting all 10 appearances with Tampa on the mound, he posted a 2-3 record, 5.80 ERA, 47 K to 27 BB in 40.1 IP. Rivas was assigned to High-A Hudson Valley on 8/6/25. On 8/15/25 against Aberdeen, he struck out 12 batters, setting a club record for most single game strikeouts by a left-handed pitcher and one short of Hudson Valley's franchise record. In his first month with the Renegades, Rivas started all four of his appearances at pitcher, finishing August with a 2-1 record, 1.50 ERA, 0.75 WHIP, and 34 K in 24.0 IP en route to South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month honors. He led the SAL in BAA (.103), H/9 (3.0) and was second in SO/9 (12.75) across that span. He ended his five game stint with Hudson Valley with a 3-1 record, 1.23 ERA, .095 BAA, 0.78 WHIP and 44 K in just 29.1 IP.

College

Began his college career at Division II Indianapolis in 2021 and 2022. After serving as the Sunday starter his freshman year (2021), Rivas returned for his sophomore year (2022) with added velocity and went 7-0 with a 2.44 ERA, 0.98 WHIP and 128 K in 80.1 IP en route to D2CCA First Team All-America, Midwest Region Pitcher of the Year and 2022 GLVC Pitcher of the Year honors. That summer of 2022, he pitched in seven games as a starter with the Northwoods League's Wisconsin Rapids Rafters in 2022, tallying a 2.25 ERA and 41 K in 24.0 IP. He then transferred from the Great Lakes Valley Conference to the SEC, with Mississippi. In what ended up being his final college season (2023), Rivas finished fourth in the SEC with 89 K and 10th with 68.0 IP, totaling a 5-5 record and 6.35 ERA. Rivas did not pitch in 2024, after sustaining a UCL tear during a preseason intrasquad game 2/2/24 - exactly two weeks before the season opener at Hawaii.
