SYKORA DAY: After winning last week's series in Columbia but dropping three in a row here in Kannapolis after a Tuesday win, the FredNats need a win tonight to get back on track as we head down the home stretch of the 2024 season. They send their best pitcher to the mound to try to get back on track as Travis Sykora makes his third start of this two-week road trip. The Freddies won both of Sykora's starts last week in Columbia, and baseball 97th best prospect will look to get the Cannon Ballers back after they beat him the first and only time he faced them back in June in Fredericksburg. Sykora didn't get out of the fourth inning his first time, allowing four hits and two runs with three walks and six strikeouts. Sykora's last home run he allowed was against Kannapolis.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Brandon Pimentel's two-run double in the 4th inning gave the FredNats an early lead for the first time in the series. Then, Cristhian Vaquero scored from second base on a deep flyout to right field in the 6th to give the Freddies a 3-0 lead, and the bullpen that has been so reliable all season long couldn't hold the lead. Merritt Beeker walked four total hitters in two innings and gave up a game-tying three-run homer in the 7th, and Bryan Sanchez gave up the lead in the 8th as Kannapolis took a late lead for the second night in a row to win by a single run, 4-3.

**HE'S BACKKKK:** After winning Carolina League Player of the Month for April, Brandon Pimentel has gotten back to early-season form here in August. He continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 81 including a two-run double last night, and in August, Pimentel is slashing .324/.385/.479 for an OPS of .864. He's driven in 16 runs this month as well.

**STANDINGS WATCH**: With eight games remaining in the regular season, the playoff race is officially on in the Carolina League North. Fredericksburg lost its division lead last night with the loss, but it's the first half champion Carolina Mudcats in first place, but the Mudcats are a non-factor in the second half standings due to them winning the first half, so FXBG could theoretically finish second to Carolina and still make the playoffs. The FredNats lead Salem by 2.0 games heading into play today, and the lead is 5.0 games over Down East and 6.0 games over Lynchburg, the team Fredericksburg finishes the regular season against next week.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. Since beginning his professional career that day, he ranks first in all of MiLB in strikeouts per nine (13.5), 1st in opponent average (.157), 3rd in WHIP (0.85), and is tied for 9th with 116 strikeouts. In his last seven starts, he's struck out at least 10 hitters in three of them, and has an ERA of 1.08 in that time frame. In MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of prospects, Sykora shot up the list to Washington's third overall prospect, and entered the Top 100 prospects in baseball as well.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 210-174 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, is in his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Travis Sykora is making his 19th professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

**QUICK CLIMBER:** Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely. Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

**ANOTHER LEVEL:** Travis went supernova over a three-start stretch recently, covering 15 innings with just one unearned run, 28 K's and two walks. Iwo of those starts included 11 consecutive no-hit innings.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sykora scattered four hits and a walk over five innings last week, giving up just one unearned run against Columbia.
