### TODAY'S HEADLINES

**LAST GAME'S RESULT** - The Saints struck out 15 Indianapolis Indians hitters, but had their three game losing streak snapped 7-4 on Saturday night at CHS Field. Spencer Steer hit his second home runs with the Saints and Ronny Henriquez fanned eighth. The difference in the game was a four-run fifth inning for Indianapolis.

**HENRI "K" UEZ:** Ronny Henriquez set a season high with eight strikeouts on Saturday night against Indianapolis. In the process he fanned six in a row, the final out of the second, the side in the third, and the first two outs in the fourth. The six straight strikeouts tied a franchise record set by Joe Ryan on August 20, 2021.

**CAVE DWELLINGS:** Jake Cave has set a new season high with a 10-game hitting streak. Over that time he is hitting .295 (13-44) with a double, triple, three home runs, and 10 RBI.

**MUSCLE BEACH:** The St. Paul Saints got two more home runs on Saturday night and have now homered in four straight games. During the four-game stretch they have hit six long balls. The four-game homer streak is tied for the second longest of the season. The Saints hit a home run in five straight from May 18-22.

**QUALITY OVER QUANTITY:** Mario Sanchez became just the second Saints pitcher to toss 6.0 innings in a game this season on May 27 against Indianapolis. He joins Chi Chi González who threw 6.0 innings on May 11 at Columbus. While González didn't allow a run, he also got a no decision as the Saints lost 6-5 in 12. Sanchez became the first pitcher to throw a quality start, allowing just one run, and get the victory.

**DUKS ON THE POND:** The Saints are producing with the bases loaded and came through in game one of the May 25 doubleheader. They were 3-4 and produced eight RBI. Overall this season, the Saints are hitting .326 with the bases loaded, 11th out of 30 Triple-A teams. Their 49 RBI in that situation are seventh most. Jake Cave leads the way with three hits and 10 RBI, including a grand slam. Elliot Soto has the second most RBI with six.

**RUNNIN' ROYCE:** Royce Lewis swiped his 12th base of the season on May 28 vs. Indianapolis in just his 34th game. He has stolen a base in 12 of the 34 games he's played, stealing two on May 4 vs. Iowa. In just over a month, Lewis has tied the franchise record for stolen bases. He tied Keon Broxton (88 games), Mark Contreras (95 games), and Drew Maggi (95 games) who all stole 12 in 2021.

**ERROR OF OUR WAYS:** The St. Paul Saints were fourth in fielding percentage in all of Triple-A over the first month of the season with a .987 fielding percentage and had committed just 13 errors in 28 games, fourth fewest errors in Triple-A. Since then the Saints have committed an error in a franchise record 18 consecutive games, surpassing the five straight from August 26-September 1, 2021. They have committed 30 errors in the last 18 games, a .954 fielding percentage, the worst in Triple-A during that time. The next closest is Indianapolis at .961.

**IMPRESSIVE ERRORLESS STREAK ENDS:** July 1, 2018. That was the last time Mark Contreras committed an error. That streak ended with two outs in the 1st inning on Thursday, May 19. The throwing error by Contreras was his first error in 343 games, a total of 1985.1 innings played since his last error when he was at High-A Fort Myers.

**WAS THAT A BUNT?:** It took until game 105 last season before the Saints laid down a sacrifice bunt. On May 11, the Saints laid down their first of the season when David Bañuelos dropped one down in game 30 of the season. They surpassed their entire total from a year ago when Cole Sturgeon put down a sacrifice bunt just nine days later on May 20.

**TWINS UPDATE** - Luis Arraez and Carlos Correa each collected three hits, but it wasn't enough as the Minnesota Twins lost 7-3 to the Kansas City Royals on Saturday afternoon at Target Field. Trevor Larnach hit his second homer of the season. Juan Minaya made his 2022 Twins debut and allowed two runs in 2.1 innings pitched while Jovani Moran made his return to the Twins and pitched 1.2 scoreless innings of relief.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** 5/24 vs. IND...pitched 2.2 innings of relief allowing three runs (two earned) on two hits while walking two and striking out two...did not receive a decision in an 8-5, 11 inning Indians victory.

**START PRIOR:** 5/18 @ OMA...pitched 3.0 innings allowing four runs on four hits, giving up a home run, while walking three and striking out two...did not receive a decision in an 8-7 10 inning Storm Chasers victory.

**THE CALIFORNIA WAY:** If you're from California you swear by one burger and one burger only. When Jake and his wife, Jessica, married in 2018 in Newport Beach, CA (the couple attended high school together at Gahr High School in Cerritos, CA) they paid tribute to their California upbringing. How did they do that? The couple had an In-N-Out truck arrive towards the end of the wedding reception.

**FAMILY VALUES:** Faria's Grandfather, Joe, emigrated from Portugal in 1959 at the age of 17 without a dime to his name and unable to speak a word of English. To honor his grandfather, who paved the way for a life in America for the family, Jake has kept his grandfather's old work shirt with him during the season since 2015. The shirt hangs in his locker to remember his grandfather's hard work and sacrifice

**DRAGNET:** Law enforcement runs in the Faria family. Jake's Dad, Davis, spent 33-years as a cop, retiring as a Deputy Sheriff with LA County. He also has a pair of Uncles, Joe Faria & Julian Rodriguez, who are also police officers. Jake has gone on ride alongs once or twice a year with family or friends that are police officers.

**WELCOME TO THE TEAM:** In 2015, Faria was promoted to Double-A Montgomery on June 24 and in his second start on July 4 vs. Double-A Biloxi, he did not allow a hit in 7.0 innings and recorded what remains a career high 14 strikeouts, his first career double-digit strikeout game. Unfortunately, the bullpen couldn't finish off the the no-hitter as it was broken up against the Biscuits bullpen in the eighth inning.

**NUMBERS SPEAK FOR THEMSELVES:** On June 7, 2017, Faria made his major league debut for Tampa Bay and went on to yield three-or-fewer runs in 12 of his 14 major league starts. He was named the Rays' Outstanding Rookie by the Tampa Bay Chapter of the BBWAA. Faria led American League rookies (min. 75.0 IP) with a 3.43 ERA (86.2 IP, 33 ER). .225 (71-for-316) opponent batting average. .377 opponent slugging percentage, 8.72 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate and 1.18 WHIP. He ranked fourth among AL rookies with 84 strikeouts, and ranked second to New York-AL's Jordan Montgomery (91) after his June 7 recall.

**HISTORIC START:** It doesn't get much better than the start Faria had to his Major League career. He became the second pitcher in Rays history to win his major league debut and pitch more than 6.0 innings, joining Hellickson in 2010, and became the eighth pitcher in Rays history to win his major league debut as a starter, first since Alexander Colomé on May 30, 2013 at Miami...became the second Ray to earn the win in the first three outings of his career, all as a starter, following Hellickson in 2010, and the fifth pitcher since 1913 to go 6.0 innings-or-more, allow one-or-fewer runs and earn the win in his first three games, joining St. Louis' Andy Rincon (1980), Cincinnati's Wayne Simpson (1970), St. Louis' Stu Miller (1952) and Detroit's Alex Main (1914).

**HISTORIC START II:** Along with the W's, Faria totaled 35 strikeouts and five walks through his first five starts, becoming the second pitcher since 1913 with at least 35 strikeouts and five walks-or-fewer in his first five career starts, with no relief appearances in between; he joined Seattle's Félix Hernández (38 K, 5 BB) in 2005.

**HISTORIC START III:** Wins, strikeouts, and quality starts, oh my. Faria was the first pitcher to begin his career with seven-consecutive quality starts since New York-AL's Masahiro Tanaka (16) in 2014, and one of only nine pitchers since 1913 to begin his career in this fashion; joined also Tanaka, Montreal's Steve Rogers (16) in 1973, Los Angeles-AL's Jered Weaver (9) in 2006, San Diego's Joey Hamilton (9) in 2004, Oakland's A.J. Griffin (7) in 2012, New York-AL's Scott Kamieniecki (7) in 1991, New York-AL's Ron Darling (7) in 1983-84 and Boston's Dave Ferriss (7) in 1945.

- Struck out 10 batters in 6.1 innings (2 H, 2 R/ER, 1 HR, 2 BB) on June 10, 2021 vs. Albuquerque. Marked his seventh career minor league game with 10-plus strikeouts (minor league career high is 14)
- Went 0-0, 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP, 3 ER) with seven walks and 11 strikeouts over four stints in 2019 with the Rays (April 20-4/21, June 15-18, July 4-14 and July 28-30)
- Was traded to the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for first baseman Jesús Aguilar on July 31, 2019
- Had two stints with the Brewers (August 5-13 and September 1-end in 2019), appearing in nine games and going 0-1, 11.42 ERA (8.2 IP, 11 ER) with five walks and eight strikeouts in those outings
- Named to the Rays' Opening Day roster in 2018. It was his lone opening day roster of his career

- Won his first four Major League decisions, joining James Shields in 2006 as the only Tampa Bay Rays pitcher to accomplish the feat
- Named to the Southern League Midseason All-Star Team, his third-straight season with Midseason honors in 2016
- Named to the Florida State League Midseason and Postseason All-Star teams in 2015
- His 17 wins between High-A Charlotte & Double-A Montgomery in 2015 led all minor leaguers and tied Heath Rollins in 2007 for the organization's single-season minor league record. Also ranked among minor league leaders (min. 120.0 IP) in ERA (2nd to Blake Snell, 1.41), opponent batting average (.194, 4th) and WHIP (1.04, 6th)
- Named to the Midwest League Midseason All-Star Team in 2014 while with Bowling Green
