YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the RubberDucks, 10-2. Richmond took a 1-0 lead in the first inning when **Ismael Munguia** scored after an Akron error. Julian Escobedo tied the game with a groundout in the second. In the fourth, Akron scored four runs to take a 5-1 lead, including RBI hits by Michael Berglund, Escobedo and Angel Martinez. The RubberDucks scored four more runs in the sixth to open a 9-1 lead. **Wade Meckler** singled in **Vaun Brown** in the bottom of the eighth, but Akron answer with a sac fly by Petey Halpin to extend its lead to 10-2 in the ninth. **Randy Rodriguez** pitched 2.1 scoreless innings and struck out three batters.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the first set between these two teams this year. They will play 18 total games against each other this season. Richmond will travel to Akron for a six-game series from July 18-23. The RubberDucks return to The Diamond for the Flying Squirrels' final regular-season homestand from September 5-10.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are 2-7 in their last nine games but have won two-of-their-last four after a season-long five-game losing streak to open last week's series in Erie. Richmond has been in first place in the division all but five days this season but are currently in third place, the first time the team has fallen outside the first two spots in the standings this year. The Richmond pitching staff is second in the Eastern League in ERA (3.54).

THE RUBBERDUCKS have won seven-of-their-last-10 games, including taking four-of-six in last week's series in Altoona. Akron's pitching staff is ranked third in the Eastern League in ERA (3.67) and tied for first in saves (12). The RubberDucks have the third-lowest team batting average (.219) in the EL. Akron's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including SS Angel Martinez (No. 8), INF Jose Tena (No. 14), LHP Joey Cantillo (No. 18), INF Gabriel Rodriguez (No. 21), OF Petey Halpin (No. 25), LHP Doug Nixhazy (No. 27), RHP Tanner Burns (No. 29) and C Bryan Lavastida (No. 30). There are seven Akron players on MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects list, including Martinez (No. 9), Halpin (No. 15), Cantillo (No. 17), Burns (No. 20), Tena (No. 21), Nixhazy (No. 28) and Jack Leftwich (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Landen Roupp** makes his third start of the season. He last pitched on Sunday at Erie and worked one inning, throwing 31 pitches, and allowed one run with two strikeouts. He made his season debut against the SeaWolves on April 23 and worked three scoreless innings with six strikeouts. In his first full professional season in 2022, Roupp climbed three levels in the Giants system. He began the year working primarily as a reliever with Low-A San Jose, going 5-2 with a 2.59 ERA in 14 outings. Roupp moved to High-A Eugene in late-June for seven starts, going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA. He was promoted to Richmond on August 18 for the remainder of the season and went 2-1 with a 3.76 ERA in five starts. Roupp made one start against the SeaWolves last year, allowing two runs over five innings in his final outing of the year on September 15 at The Diamond. Roupp was selected by the Giants in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UNC Wilmington, where he was the 2021 CAA Pitcher of the Year. **For more on Roupp, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Hunter Stanley makes his sixth start and seventh appearance of the season. He last pitched last Friday at Altoona and worked a season-high 6.1 innings, the longest outing by an Akron pitcher this year, and allowed one run with four strikeouts. Stanley was selected in the 11th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by Cleveland out of Southern Miss. He made his professional debut last season with High-A Lake County and made four appearances with a 1.84 ERA before an injury ended his season in May. He made six starts in the Arizona Fall League last year, going 2-2 with a 4.43 ERA.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels' sold out crowd of 9,810 fans on Wednesday was the largest crowd in the Eastern League this year. It was the first sellout of the 2023 season (Opening Day was sold out but rained out) and the fourth crowd of at least 8,000 at The Diamond this year. For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead all 30 Double-A teams in average attendance (6,385). Last year, they led Double-A in average (6,160) and total (406,560) fans for the first time in franchise history.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On May 4, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. Luciano added a homer in Sunday's win over the SeaWolves and hit his third home run on Wednesday, tying a career high with four RBIs. He has reached base in nine-of-his-12 games started this season.

FULL MUNGUA: **Ismael Munguia** is batting .369 (24-for-65) with two homers, eight doubles and six RBIs over his last 17 games, including nine multi-hit games, since April 27. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. He went deep for the third time on Wednesday night, part of his third three-hit game of the year. Munguia is seventh in the Eastern League in batting average (.300), fourth in hits (39) and tied for fifth in runs scored (23). His .300 batting average out of the leadoff spot in the order is the second-highest in the league, trailing only Hartford's Bladimir Restituyo (.303).

VAUN RETURNS: Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. He picked up his first Double-A hit on Thursday night.

WELCOME, WADE: The Flying Squirrels activated **Wade Meckler** on Wednesday and he made his Double-A debut that night, picking up three hits and scoring two runs. He knocked an RBI single in the second inning for his first Double-A hit and added an RBI single on Thursday. At the time of his promotion from High-A Eugene, Meckler ranked fourth in the Northwest League in hits (36). He is rated by Baseball America as having the "best strike-zone discipline" in the Giants system. Among batters with at least 80 plate appearances this year, Meckler leads the minors in batting average (.455). Meckler was selected by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State. He played 23 games last year after the draft, including 11 games to close the season with Low-A San Jose, where he hit .439 in 11 games.

BURGOS THE KING: Reliever **Raymond Burgos** has pitched 11 games without allowing an earned run this season, the longest streak in the Eastern League this year. The only run Burgos has allowed overall this season was an extra-innings placed runner in a loss to the Curve on May 3. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 8 G, no starts), Burgos ranks first in runners left on base (95.0%). He is one of only four pitchers in the minors this year who has pitched at least 15.0 innings and has not allowed an earned run.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Luis Matos** is ranked fourth in batting average (.304), ninth in OBP (.398) and tied for eighth in hits (35). **Ismael Munguia** is ranked seventh in batting average (.300), fourth in hits (39) and tied for fifth in runs scored (23). **Hayden Cantrelle** is ranked seventh in OBP (.405). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for first in triples (3). **Kai-Wei Teng** is fourth in strikeouts (42).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).
