**DJ LeMaHits:** Through his first three games of Major League rehab with Somerset this week, DJ LeMahieu is 5-for-8 (.625 BA) with 1 HR and 3 RBI.

**CAN'T STOP MR. JONES:** Following his seventh home run of the season on Thursday night, Spencer Jones now leads all Double-A batters in homers, while tying for the highest total in Minor League Baseball. Jones ranks among the league leaders with 14 R (T-5th), 14 BB (4th), .557 SLG (6th), .922 OPS (9th), 9 XBH (T-3rd) and 12 RBI (T-9th).

**RAFA RAKES:** Rafael Flores has hits in eight of his last nine games over which he is 10-for-35 (.286/.297/.486) with 8 RBI, 5 R and 5 XBH. Flores leads the Patriots with 16 RBIs this season, which ranks 5th in the Eastern League.

**THAT JASSO IS SO JOT:** After his RBI-double on Saturday night, Dylan Jasso is now 18-for-50 (.360 BA) in 13 games batting leadoff for the Patriots season. Jasso's .273 BA is the highest of any active member of the Patriots.

**MARTIN'S MASHING:** Dating back to Sunday 4/20, Garrett Martin is 5-for-17 (.294 BA) with 2 HR, 2 2B, 5 RBI, 3 R, 1 BB, and 2 SB. His 5 RBIs in this week's series vs. Hartford lead the Patriots.

**STARTING STRONG:** Somerset's starting rotation enters Friday with a 3.15 ERA through 20 games, ranking 3rd in the Eastern League (BNG-1st, 1.97 ERA). The Patriots' bullpen enters today with a 6.80 ERA (1.55 runs higher than 11th place team, Altoona, 5.25).

**SCHLITZ DOWN:** Yankees No. 11 prospect Cam Schlittler tied his career-best marks in Thursday night's shutout win with 7.0 IP (2nd time in career) and 9 Ks (4th time in career). Schlittler's 7.0 IP tied for the longest outing of any pitcher in MiLB this season and his 22.0 IP are tied for the most of any Eastern League pitcher in 2024. Schlittler also ranks among the Eastern League leaders with 24 K (7th), a 1.23 ERA (5th), .171 BAA (8th) and 0.82 WHIP (6th).

**BULLISH ABOUT THE PEN:** During the road trip in Altoona between Wednesday and Saturday, the Patriots' bullpen went on a season-long 12.1-inning scoreless streak. The Patriots' bullpen trio of Clayton Beeter, Will Brian and Harrison Cohen combined on 5.0 scoreless innings to finish a 4-3 win, the most consecutive scoreless innings by the bullpen in any game this season. Brian tied a season-high with 3.0 IP and earned the win in his Double-A debut. Somerset's bullpen enters today with a 9.2-inning scoreless streak in tact.

## 2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

### RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

### MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

### PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

### DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

### UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

Broke camp with High-A Hudson Valley, where he spent all but one game during his first professional season. Sellers made one spot appearance in relief for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on 5/24, earning the win after he allowed two earned runs in 1.2 innings pitched. Sellers' first 21 High-A appearances of the season came in relief, when he posted a 7-2 record and 3.33 ERA with 29 BB and 56 K over 46.0 IP. On 7/14, Sellers transitioned to become a starting pitcher, starting nine of his final 10 appearances to end the regular season. Over these last 10 appearances, he allowed only 2 ER over 36.0 IP with 8 BB and 42 K, equating to a 0.50 ERA, 0.50 WHIP and .088 BAA. Vargas made it into 13 MLB Spring Training games for the Yankees and went 8-for-14 (.571/.600/1.357) with 7 RBI, 4 R, 3 HR and 2 2B. His first homer on 2/22 @TOR was a game-tying, solo shot in the 8th inning, while his second homer was a go-ahead, three-run homer in the 8th inning on 2/27 @PHI. Vargas' three Spring Training home runs were tied for the most of any player that did not break camp on the Yankees' Opening Day roster. He was a late addition to the Yankees' second annual Spring Breakout roster and made it into the game on 3/15 @BAL, taking over at second base in the game and going 0-for-2.

Broke camp with High-A Hudson Valley and was transferred to Double-A Somerset after five games in which he slashed .200/.316/.400. Vargas spent the remainder of the season with the Patriots and hit .254/.293/.375 with 4 HR, 30 RBI, 23 R and 14 SB.

Made his professional debut on 6/1/19 with the DSL Yankees. Vargas was expected to sign with the Reds as an international free agent, but Cincinnati was penalized for exceeding their bonus pool money the prior signing period leaving them unable to sign a prospect to a contract above \$300,000. The Yankees swooped in to ink Vargas for \$2.5M on 8/1/18, dishing out the third-highest bonus in the class. The Yankees acquired the extra international pool money they needed for Vargas, the 8th-ranked prospect in the class, by sending Caleb Frare to the White Sox, and both Giovanny Gallegos and Chasen Shreve to the Cardinals. Vargas played for Matanzas in Cuba's 15U national league in 2016, batting .296/.395/.449 with 14 walks and eight strikeouts in 116 plate appearances. In 2017, he jumped to the 18U league as a 15-year-old. Vargas was part of the first signing class which allowed Cuban players to be signed by MLB teams without having to defect.

Wegner was named to the Yankees' second annual Spring Breakout roster and went 0-for-1 with a strikeout in his lone at-bat as a pinch-hitter.

Spent the entire season with Double-A Somerset, where he became the first member of the Yankees' 2023 draft class to make his Double-A debut. Wegner played in 93 games for the Patriots over which he hit .211/.316/.342 with 7 HR, 39 RBI and 38 R. Wegner's first Double-A home run on 4/12 @NH was struck at an exit velocity of 116.3 mph. His third Double-A home run on 4/28 @REA was the Patriots' hardest-recorded hit of the season, registering an exit velocity of 116.8 mph.

Prior to high school, he represented Nebraska (Kearney Little League) in the 2012 Little League World Series with his father, Brad, serving as the team's head coach. He went 3-for-4 with a homer and 5 RBI in the state's first ever LLWS win, coming over Germany.

Made his professional debut on 7/29/23 with the FCL Yankees. Selected in the ninth round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Yankees, signing for \$72,500 as a senior-sign.
