#### LAST GAME OUT

**(Thurs, April 12)** - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Norfolk Tides 6-4 on Friday night. The team totaled thirteen hits, including seven for extra bases. It was their fifth straight victory.

Brandon Lockridge led off the game with a base hit and scored the first run off a Carlos Narvaez single.

The Tides took the lead right back with back-to-back home runs from Heston Kjerstad and Coby Mayo. Norfolk added another on another solo shot from Mayo in the third.

The RailRiders got to work after that. Everson Pereira led off the fourth with his fourth homer of the season, a team-high. Narvaez and Rojas popped consecutive doubles to tie the game at three a piece.

In the next frame, Pereira singled to reach and raced home on another Narvaez double. Again Rojas notched a two-bagger to plate a run for a 5-3 lead.

Caleb Durbin recorded the team's sixth double this time bringing in Lockridge for a 6-3 advantage.

The Tides got one back off an RBI single in the eighth inning by Michael Perez. However, with help from Rojas in right field, he was nabbed off the bag at first to end the inning.

Yankees #8 prospect Will Warren (W, 1-0) got the start allowing three runs on just four hits. He struck out eight. Yerry De Los Santos was hot with two scoreless innings, striking out four. Oddanier Mosqueda (S, 1) slammed the door shut in the ninth.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**TOP TEAM:** Scranton/Wilkes-Barre knocked the Norfolk Tides out of first place in the International League with five straight wins. The RailRiders a half of a game ahead of four other teams including division rival Buffalo. The team is four games above .500 for the first time this season.

**LOCKRIDGE LEADING-** Brandon Lockridge is now batting .318 in ten games this season. He has recorded seven hits, including three doubles, and has batted in six runs. The righty has walked eleven times compared to just five strikeouts. Lockridge also has eleven total steals, leading all of professional baseball. The 27-year-old has already played all three outfield positions.

**FIVE IN A ROW-** SWB has now won five games in a row, tracking back to their final game at PNC Field versus Syracuse. The last time they won this many straight was between July 26-July 21 at Rochester in 2022 when they swept a seven game series.

**SAVED IT-** The RailRiders have now gone have five straight games with consecutive saves in the after going 0-5 in that category to start the season. This number is tied for second in Minor League Baseball with only the Oklahoma City Baseball Club having just one more. Last night Oddanier Mosqueda recorded the save in his team-high sixth appearance as a RailRider. Each save has been recorded by a different bullpen arm.

**HIGHS AND LOWS-** The RailRiders pitching staff boasts a 3.72 ERA which is #6 in Triple-A. The team has the most wild pitches with 17 in the level, but Myrtle Beach has them beat in baseball with 23 mishrows. Tanner Tully has three to his stat line. However, SWB pitchers have not hit any batters this season and remain the only team in Triple-A not to do so. Only two other staffs have not hit a batter in all of baseball: Columbia and Erie.

**EXTRA EXTRA:** Yesterday SWB recorded seven extra base hits including six doubles and a home run. Carlos Narvaez and Jose Rojas each had a pair of two-baggers. While Jeter Downs and Caleb Durbin had doubles of their own. Everson Pereira had the teams 12th home run of the season.

**HE GETS ON BASE:** Both Everson Pereira and Caleb Durbin have each played in all one dozen games getting on base safely each time. Durbin has 17 hits and eleven walks. He has a team-high 15 runs batted in. Durbin's on-base percentage is .509, putting him third in the International League. Pereira has eleven hits, including four homers. His OBP is .370.

**PITCHING PRESENCE-** The RailRiders starters and relievers have combined for a 3.69 earned run average in the first eleven games of the season. It #6 pitching staff in Triple-A baseball.

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** -The RailRiders will showcase top outfielding prospect Everson Pereira (#6 per MLB Pipeline) alongside starting pitchers Will Warren (#8), Clayton Beeter (#14), and Yoendrys Gómez (#18).

**MLB DEBUT:** Made the 2024 Opening Day roster and his New York Yankees debut on March 29 at Houston...Entered in the ninth inning and threw three pitches, all strikeouts...Allowed one single to Jose Altuve, got an odd 5-6-3 DP, and a flyout; Was optioned to SWB on 3/30

**ORIGINALLY DRAFTED:** Selected in the Competitive Balance B-Round by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 2020 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech... received a \$1.2 million signing bonus, over the \$1 million slot value for the No. 66 overall selection... Competitive Balance Round B pick was acquired as part of the Dodgers' February 2020 trade with the Minnesota Twins

**YANKEES GOT HIM:** Was ranked by MLB.com as the Dodgers' No. 15 prospect at the 2022 Trade Deadline in August... traded by the Dodgers to the New York Yankees for LF Joey Gallo at the Trade Deadline on Aug. 2, 2022... was assigned to Double-A Somerset upon the trade... was a Rangers and Gallo fan growing up

**TJ TIME:** Had Tommy John surgery in December 2017 before his first season at Texas Tech and a follow-up arthroscopic elbow procedure seven months later

**FUTURE FARMHAND:** Was one of two Yankees prospects selected to the All-Star Futures Game in Seattle. The righty tossed just nine pitches, five for strikes, to record two outs in the seventh. He got San Diego's Jackson Merrill to ground out and recorded a strikeout against Jackson Chourio. Chourio is the #3 ranked prospect in all of MiLB according to MLB Pipeline, while Merrill stands at #10.

**COLLEGE HIGHLIGHTS:** Led the Red Raiders' 2019 College World Series semifinalists with eight saves and dominating in four starts as a redshirt sophomore, was a Freshman All-American in 2019 after recording a team-high eight saves in 20 appearances, where he owned a 3.20 ERA and 39 strikeouts

**CAREER:**  
 • **2023:** In Beeter's second start of the season (55th career game) on 4/14 @BNG, he earned his first professional win with a career-high 6.2 IP... Split the 2023 season with Double-A Somerset (12GS) and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (15G/14GS), combining to go 9-7 with a 3.62 ERA (131.2IP, 105H, 54R/53ER, 75BB, 165K, 18HR) in 27 games (26 starts)... among Yankees farmhands, ranked 2nd in strikeouts, 3rd in starts and 4th in wins, innings pitched and opponents' batting average (.216)... his 165K also ranked eighth among all minor league pitchers... Began the season with Double-A Somerset, going 6-2 with a 2.08 ERA (60.2IP, 44H, 14R/ER, 31BB, 76K, 3HR) in 12 starts... was named the Eastern League's "Pitcher of the Week" from 6/5-11 after going 2-0 and tossing a combined 11.0 scoreless innings over two starts at Hartford on 6/6 and 6/11 (6H, 4BB, 17K, 3HP)... Was selected to the 2023 SiriusXM Futures Game... Was promoted to Triple-A SWB on 6/23 and went 3-5 with a 4.94 ERA (71.0IP, 61H, 40R/39ER, 44BB, 89K, 15HR) in 15 games (14 starts)... Had a career high 13K on 9/14 vs BUF... Was named an Eastern League Postseason All-Star... Was added to the 40-man roster on 11/14  
 • **2022:** Spent the beginning of his second season with the Dodgers in Double-A Tulsa making 18 appearances (16 GS), continuing to serve primarily as an opener, working no more than 4 IP in any of his starts, posting an 0-3 record with a 5.75 ERA and 15.33 K/9 IP. Beeter was acquired by the Yankees from the Dodgers hours before the 2022 MLB trade deadline on August 2 as the lone piece received in exchange for outfielder Joey Gallo. At the time of the trade, Beeter was ranked the Dodgers' No. 21 prospect by Baseball America, which credited him with having the Best Curveball in the Dodgers MiLB system. Beeter made his Yankees organizational debut with Double-A Somerset on 8/10/22, pitching three scoreless innings in which he posted six strikeouts and allowed only one baserunner (BB). In seven starts to end the season with Somerset, he posted a 2.13 ERA over 25.1 IP with 41 K and 11 BB (14.57 K/9 IP). Across his 7 GS with Somerset to end 2022, Beeter set and matched a new career-high 9 K on 8/27/22 vs. NH and 9/3/22 @BNG. Over this stretch, he also set a new career high in IP three different times, including in his lone postseason start on 9/22/22 vs. POR. He allowed 2 R (1 ER) • **2021:** Made his pro debut in 2021 and posted a 3.44 ERA between High-A Great Lakes and Double-A Tulsa, working mostly as an opener, going no more than 3.1 IP in any outing
