LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn clinched the series victory with a 4-3 win at Aberdeen on Saturday night...RHP Paul Blackburn made his 2025 debut in a Major League rehab start, allowing 1 run on 2 hits over 2.0 innings, walking 2 and striking out 1...RHP R.J. Gordon, Saturday's originally scheduled starter, earned the 1st win of his professional career in reliefi...He permitted 2 runs on 3 hits in 4.0 innings, issuing 3 walks and punching out 4...3B Boston Baro picked up a pair of hits including a double...SS Jesús Báez recorded a pair of knocks to snap an 0-for-15 stretch...LF D'Andre Smith collected his 2nd-straight multi-hit game, adding a double and a stolen base...Brooklyn took the lead for good in the top of the 8th, breaking a 3-3 tie on C Chris Suero's RBI ground out...DH Eli Serrano III and 2B Diego Mosquera produced RBI singles in the 1st and 7th innings, respectively.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On April 20, 2022, 1B JT Schwartz reached base 4 times with a pair of singles and walks, driving in 2 in a 4-3 win at Hudson Valley...ln 2023, the Cyclones used a 5-run 6th inning to beat Wilmington at home, 7-1...CF Alex Ramírez tallied 2 hits and drove in 3...RHP Raimon Gómez (4 K), RHP Trey McLoughlin (5), RHP Jace Beck (5), and LHP Quinn Brodey (1) combined for 15 strikeouts in the win...ln 2024, Brooklyn scored 5 times in the 5th in a 9-7 win at Jersey Shore...DH Nolan McLean went 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles and an RBI.

A THORN-TON IN THEIR SIDE: LHP Zach Thornton has been utterly dominant to start 2025...The Lawrence, Kan. native posted a career-high-tying 6.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball, striking out a career-high-matching 8, while facing the minimum...Thornton is 1 of only 3 arms at the High-A level to toss 15.0 or more innings without allowing an earned run (Aberdeen's RHP Braxton Bragg and Vancouver's RHP Grant Rogers)...Thornton is the only arm not to allow a run at all....He is also 1 of 2 arms to not allow a run over 15.0+frames across all of Minor League Baseball in 2025 (Double-A Corpus Christi RHP José Fleury)...Entering play on Sunday, the 23-year-old is 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball in WHIP (0.44) and 6th in batting average against (.098)...Among South Atlantic League arms, Thornton leads the circuit in wins (3) and WHIP (0.44)...He is also tied for the league lead in strikeouts (22), 3rd in batting average against (.098), and tied for 3rd in innings pitched (16.0)...Since 2005, Thornton's 44-to-4 strikeout-to-walk ratio (11.0) is the best in Cyclones' history among pitchers with 40.0 or more innings of work (43.0)... RHP Benito García's 9.50 ratio (38-to-4 in 42.2 IP) is 2nd...His WHIP (0.91) is 6th...Trailing only LHP John Mincone (0.71), García (0.75), RHP Hansel Robles (0.78), RHP Marcos Molina (0.84), and RHP Dylan Owen (0.87).

SUPER SUERO: C Chris Suero has been one of the best hitters in Minor League Baseball to start 2025...On Thursday, he delivered the go-ahead 2-run double in the 9th, in a 7-3 comeback win at Aberdeen...On Tuesday, the 21-year-old recorded the 2nd multi-home run game of his career in an 8-7 victory...Suero powered a 2-run blast in the 2nd and added another 2-run shot in the 3rd...The Bronx native homered in 3-straight at-bats dating back to his solo shot in the 6th inning on Sunday vs. Hudson Valley...Entering play on Saturday, Suero is 4th in all of Minor League Baseball in sluggling percentage (.773)... He also ranks tied for 5th in home runs (5), tied for 6th in extra-base hits (11), and 10th in OPS (1.153)...He also leads the South Atlantic League in sluggling percentage (.773), home runs (5), extra-base hits (11), and OPS (1.153)...Suero is also 2nd in doubles (6), tied for 3rd in total bases (34), and tied for 7th in runs scored (11)...Suero was recognized on Mil.B's "Prospect Team of the Week" on Monday after going 10-for-29 (.345) with 5 doubles, 3 home runs, and 9 RBI over his first 8 games.

REIM TIME: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Reimer has registered multiple base hits in each of the first 4 games of Brooklyn's series in Aberdeen and 5-straight since last Sunday at Hudson Valley...The Yucaipa, Calif. native is an impressive 19-for-51 (.373) at the plate with 12 RBI and 10 extra-base hits...Reimer recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Reimer is tied for 3rd in all of Minor League Baseball in triples (3) and 10th in slugging percentage (.706)...Reimer leads the South Atlantic League in triples (3)...Reimer is also 2nd in slugging percentage (.706)...OPS (1.145), extra-base hits (10), and total bases (36), tied for 2nd in hits (19) and runs scored (13), 3rd in batting average (.373), tied for 3rd in doubles (5), tied for 6th in RBI (12), and 7th in on-base percentage (.439).

ROTATION IS ROLLING: Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite over the season's first 14 games...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 1.86 ERA (12 ER in 58.0 IP)...Under the leadership of first-year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 73-to-20 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 1.86 ERA is the lowest among starting pitching staffs in the South Atlantic League...Aberdeen is 2nd (2.37)...It is also 3rd among all High-A franchises...Only Kansas City's Quad Cities (1.79) and Cincinnati's Dayton (1.84) has tallied a lower ERA...Overall, Brooklyn's pitching staff has a SAL-low 2.68 ERA (36 ER in 121.0 IP), which is good for the 2nd-lowest at High-A behind Quad Cities (2.46)...The 2.68 ERA ranks 5th in all of Minor League Baseball...The Athletics' Single-A Stockton (2.45) is 1st.

WHAT A RELIEF!: Brooklyn's bullpen has been dominant in the 2025 season...Entering play on Sunday, Cyclones relievers have a 6-2 record with a 3.43 ERA (24 ER in 63.0 IP), 3 saves, 37 walks, and an eye-popping 91 strikeouts...Brooklyn's 1.10 WHIP from relief arms is the 3rd-lowest at the High-A level and 11th-lowest in Minor League Baseball... Additionally, the Cyclones have accrued a 13.00 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio, which is the best at High-A and 5th-best in Mil.B...Only Chicago-NL's Triple-A lowa (14.10), Boston's Double-A Portland (13.42), Colorado's Double-A Hartford (13.07), and San Diego's Double-A San Antonio (13.04) have better marks...For the season, Brooklyn's bullpen has posted a 152 batting average against, which is tied for 2nd-lowest in Mil.B, and an impressive 36.11% strikeout rate.

NOAH'S ARC: After an injury-shortened 2024, RHP Noah Hall has returned to form in 2025...Over his first 3 starts, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 1-0 with a 1.23 ERA (2 ER in 14.2 IP), 18 strikeouts and only 6 hits allowed...Entering Sunday, Hall is 5th in the South Atlantic League in batting average against (125), 6th in ERA (1.23), and tied for 7th in innings pitched (14.2)...The University of South Carolina product became not only the first player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

vs. ABERDEEN: Brooklyn treks south for their first road trip of the season...The 2-week stretch begins with 6 games against the IronBirds...Aberdeen enters the series after taking 4-of-6 on the road against Jersey Shore...In 2024, Brooklyn went 11-13 against the IronBirds and 4-8 at Ripken Stadium...Aberdeen boasts 11 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects: OF Vance Honeycutt (5), INF Griff O'Ferrall (7), RHP Michael Forret (8), RHP Nestor Germán (11), LHP Luis De León (14), RHP Trey Gibson (15), INF Aron Estrada (16), C Ethan Anderson (18), INF Leandro Arias (21), OF Thomas Sosa (23), and OF Austin Overn (30)...De León and Sosa are currently on the injured list...In 268 all-time meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 141-127 (.526).

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: Despite the loss on Wednesday, Cyclones' pitching dominated...After 4-straight runners reached base in the bottom of the 1st, Brooklyn pitching combined to retire 23 of the final 24 batters in order, allowing just one infield hit in the 3rd inning...14 of those 24 outs were recorded via strikeouts...RHP Noah Hall sat down 14 of the last 15 batters he faced, striking out 7 over 5.0 innings in the 2-1 defeat... The 23-year-old created a team-high 11 swings-and-misses...LHP Ryan Ammons, RHP Ryan Lambert, and RHP Alfred Vega united to sit down the last 9 hitters of the game in a row, 7 of which struck out...Lambert whiffed 4 of the 5 batters he faced, inducing 8 whiffs.

BACK IN BLACK-BURN: RHP Paul Blackburn joined the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment Saturday and allowed 1 run on 2 hits over 2.0 innings, walking 2 and striking out 1...The 31-year-old was placed on the Mets' 15-day injured list on March 27 (retro March 24) with right knee inflammation...Blackburn was acquired by New York from the Oakland Athletics on July 30, 2024, in exchange for RHP Kade Morris...Morris was a member of Brooklyn's rotation at the time of the trade...Blackburn was named an American League All-Star with the A's in 2022...ln 86 MLB appearances (82 starts) with the A's and Mets, the California native has tallied a 22-28 record with a 4.85 ERA (231 ER in 428.1 IP), 17.8% strikeout rate, and a 7.1% walk rate.

VETERAN PRESENCE: OF Rafael Ortega remains with the Cyclones on a minor league rehab assignment from Triple-A Syracuse...Through 5 games, the 33-year-old is 2-for-21 (.095) at the plate with a double, 2 RBI, and a stolen base...This is Ortega's second stint in the New York Mets organization after spending most of the 2023 season with the club...The EI Tigre, Venezuela native played 30 games at Triple-A Syracuse and another 47 with the Mets, hitting .219/.341/.272 with a home run and 8 RBI for the Big League club...Ortega has appeared in 425 MLB games with the Colorado Rockies, Los Angeles Angels, Miami Marlins, Atlanta Braves, Chicago Cubs, Chicago White Sox, and Mets, slashing .245/.322/.349/.671 with 22 home runs and 110 RBI...Ortega also played for Single-A Asheville in the South Atlantic League in 2011, hitting .294/.335/.438 with 9 homers and 66 RBI in 113 games.

**YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT:** In a lopsided victory over Wilmington on April 5, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones' offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win... Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS: After 4 former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, 3 alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C Hayden Senger ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF Jake Mangum ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP Mike Vasil debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B Ty France for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager Gilbert Gómez embarks GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK: Cyclones manager Gilbert Gomez embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33-year-old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since Edgardo Alfonzo (2017-2019)...Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls... Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League...The Dominican native will serve as Albert Pujols' assistant manager for Team Dominican Republic in the upcoming 2026 World Baseball Classic.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 8 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez, LHP Jonathan Santucci (13), INF Boston Baro (14), INF Jacob Reimer (21), C Chris Suero (22), OF Eli Serrano III (23) and C Ronald Hernández (27)...Of those 8, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 6 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Suero (20), and Reimer (21).

REPERTOIRE: 4-Seam Fastball, Slider, Curveball, Changeup

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision on Tuesday night in Aberdeen...Allowed 2 runs (1 earned) on 3 hits in 3.2 innings...Walked only 1 and struck out a career-high 6...Threw a career-high 69 pitches and 43 strikes (62.32%)...Retired 7-straight batters to start the game...Retired the leadoff batter in all 4 innings...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** with the bases loaded and 2 out in the bottom of the 4th and the Cyclones leading 8-1...One of three bequeathed runners scored...Aberdeen would rally to pull within one, but stranded the tying run at third base in the 9th, in an 8-7 Brooklyn victory.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Entering the 2025 season, Santucci was ranked as the New York Mets' No. 13 prospect by MLB Pipeline and No. 16 by *Baseball America...* Deemed to have the "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2024 draft class by *Baseball America* for his slider.

**SPRING BREAKOUT:** Santucci was a member of the Mets' 2025 Spring Breakout roster...While still awaiting his official professional debut, the southpaw entered in relief of RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** in the bottom of the 5th inning...Santucci tossed a scoreless inning of work, facing one over the minimum, allowing one hit and one walk, and inducing a double play.

**DEVILISHLY GOOD:** Santucci spent his three-year collegiate career at Duke University...As a junior in 2024, the 22-year-old compiled a 6-1 record with a 3.41 ERA (22 ER in 58.0 IP), 36 walks, and 90 strikeouts in 13 starts for the Blue Devils...Santucci was named to the All-ACC First Team and recognized on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list...Missed three weeks during the 2024 season with a rib injury...Punched out a career-high 14 batters against Akron on 3/1...Was the second of back-to-back 10+ strikeout performances, whiffing 11 against Northwestern on 2/23...Limited to only 7 starts as a sophomore due to elbow surgery to remove bone chips...During his career at Duke, Santucci accrued a 10-6 mark with a 3.86 ERA (55 ER in 128.1 IP), 72 walks, and 198 strikeouts in 40 appearances (27 starts).

**DUAL THREAT:** During his high school career, Santucci was a two-way player at Phillips Academy (Andover, Mass.)...The left-hander registered a .322 batting average in high school, adding six doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 29 RBI...Santucci also received opportunities at the plate during his time at Duke...At the plate in college, the Leominster, Mass. native posted a .217 average (5-23) with two doubles, a home run, and 5 RBI in 24 plate appearances...Santucci played four games in the outfield at Duke, with three in right field and one in center field.

**FAMILY TIES:** Jonathan is not the only athlete in the Santucci family...Dad, **Steven**, played baseball at Assumption University (Worcester, Mass.) from 1991-93...Cousin, **Nick**, also played collegiate baseball at Rollins College (Winter Park, Fla.).
