FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders tied their season-high, clubbing three home runs in a 7-3 victory over the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels on Tuesday night at LECOM Park. Garret Forrester led the offense with three hits and reaching base four times. He also swatted his first professional home run in the win. In just his second game of the season, Kalae Harrison also homered while Shalin Polanco blasted a three-run HR to right field. Carlos Jimenéz struck out seven in three scoreless frames on the mound.

GETTING HOT: INF Garret Forrester has reached base in nine straight games in which he's collected a hit in eight of his last nine. Over this span, Forrester is hitting .467 (14-for-30) with 3 doubles, a HR, 6 RBIs, 6 walks, and 5 runs. It's currently the longest active on-base streak for the Marauders. The former Oregon State Beaver has also recorded five multi-hit games in this span with the highlight being a 3-for-3 night at the plate versus Fort Myers on Tuesday night.

IN HIS GROOVE: With another scoreless outing on Tuesday night, **LHP Hunter Furtado** has extended his season-long scoreless streak to 5.2 innings. Over his last three outings, the 2023 Sixth-Round pick has struck out seven and walking one while allowing just three hits.

ROSTER MOVE: Priot to Tuesday's contest, the Pittsburgh Pirates announced OF Joshua Palacios was to begin his Minor League rehab assignment with the Bradenton Marauders. Palacios was acquired in the Minor League Rule 5 Draft by the Pirates in Dec. 2022. He went on to appear in 91 games last year for the Buccos, hitting .239 AVG with 10 HR and 40 RBIs. He was originally drafted by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 4th round of the 2016 MLB Draft. Palacios spent almost the entire season with the Dunedin Blue Jays in 2018 where he was named a Post-Season All-Star. In 125 games, the left-handed hitter slashed .292/.357/.418 with 30 doubles, 8 HR, 78 RBIs while stealing 15 bases.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Saturday night's loss marked their 10th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own a 3-7 record in those games with 17 of their first 22 (79.8%) games having been decided by three runs or less. In last week's series against Clearwater, all six games were by a total of eight runs. The series featured four-one run contests with another two decided by two runs each.

FINDING THEIR GROOVE: Since April 17, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff owns the third-best ERA in the Florida State League at 2.84, only trailing the Daytona Tortugas who sport a 2.24 ERA and the Clearwater Threshers at 2.69 ERA.

OMAR HAS IT: Pirates' No. 28 prospect **Omar Alfonzo's** hitting streak came to an end at seven games on Tueday night against Fort Myers. Over that stretch, Alfonzo slashed .409/.519/.591 with four doubles, two RBIs, five walks, and five runs.

GOT EM!: Hunter Furtado picked off Aidan Miller in the sixth inning on Saturday night for the Marauders eighth pickoff of the season. As of Wednesday, the Marauders currently sit tied for first in all of MiLB with the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (Triple-A, PHI) the Hudson Valley Renegades (High-A, NYY), and the Fredericksburg Nationals (Single-A, WAS). Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MiLB.

Mr. Consistent: For the second straight start on Saturday, LHP Michael Kennedy tossed five innings. The Pittsburgh Pirates' No. 15 prospect is the only Marauders starter to go at least five innings in two different starts and currently leads the team with 17.0 innings thrown.

ROAD TRIP: Friday night's victory over the Clearwater Threshers at BayCare Ballpark was the Marauders first road victory of the season. Bradenton dropped all six games in their first road trip in Lakeland and lost the first three games of this series. Five of those nine losses were decided by just one run with another two games decided by just two runs.

DAYTIME IS BETTER: Prior to Friday night's win, all! three of the Marauders previous wins this season came during day games at home with two of them occuring on Sunday's
