YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox were shut out for a second straight night by a final score of 1-0 on Saturday. The Baysox have not scored in their last 19 innings played. Starting right-hander **Pat Reilly** threw only one inning before being removed from the game due to right elbow discomfort. Chesapeake collected only three hits on the night with two of them from **Adam Retzbach**, including a double. **Peter Van Loon**, **Dylan Coleman** and **Keagan Gillies** combined for 5.1 shutout innings of relief.

ARMS RACE

Chesapeake pitching has allowed four earned runs or fewer in 11 of the 14 games played this season (1.99 ERA in 95 innings pitched), which leads the Eastern League. Baysox relievers threw 15 consecutive scoreless innings to start the year. Last season, the Chesapeake bullpen led all of Double-A in strikeouts (724) and innings pitched (653.2).

CREED CRUSHES

C **Creed Willems** blasted his first homer of the season on Wednesday with a solo shot in the ninth. The Orioles No. 12 prospect matched his career-high with 17 homers last season after hitting 17 the year before. Willems also played in the Arizona Fall League during the offseason and was named a Fall League All Star after batting .338 with an .891 OPS. The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

TEACH ME HOW TO DOUGIE

OF **Doug Hodo** has been an on-base machine for the Baysox to start his first full season at Double-A. The 24-year-old is on an 11-game on-base streak, which is the longest active streak on the team and is the fourth-longest streak in the league. The Orioles 6th rounder in 2022 is currently sixth in the Eastern League in OBP (.458) and is tied for the league lead in walks (14).

GOING LONG

RHP **Ryan Long** is set to make his second start of the series. The 25-year-old dealt his first scoreless start of the season with five scoreless innings and three strikeouts on Tuesday. The right-hander returns after throwing the 3rd-most innings on the team last year (93.0). Long has faced Richmond six times in his career and holds a 1.95 ERA against them.

SEE BALL, HIT BALL

IF **Jeremiah Jackson** is batting .364 (8-for-22) with three doubles and four RBI over his last five games. C **Silas Ardoin** is batting .333 (6-for-18) with two doubles, a homer and three RBI over his last five games. Both players have solid career numbers against Richmond. Jackson is a career .333 hitter while Ardoin holds a career .419 OBP against the Flying Squirrels.

B-Y TO BALTIMORE

Former Baysox RHP **Brandon Young** made his Major League debut yesterday in the Orioles 9-5 win over the Reds. Young worked four innings and allowed three runs on seven hits and three walks and struck out three in a no decision. The 2024 Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year is the 227th former Baysox player to reach the big leagues. Young made 16 appearances with Chesapeake from 2022-2024 and posted a 3.71 ERA in 60.2 innings.

THE SQUIRRELS ARE FLYING

The Richmond Flying Squirrels face the Baysox for the first of 18 total meetings this season. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants finished 64-74 last year but defeated the Baysox in 12 out of 18 games. Richmond's active roster features six Giants' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): LHP Joe Whitman (No. 7), RHP Trent Harris (No. 11), IF Diego Velasquez (No. 15), IF Aeverson Arteaga (No. 16), IF Sabin Ceballos (No. 23) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

LHP Seth Lonsway makes his second start of the week for the Flying Squirrels against the Baysox. Lonsway has given up only eight earned runs in 42.2 career innings at the Double-A level and all eight have been against Chesapeake. The 26-year-old was drafted by the Giants in the 6th round of the 2021 Draft out of Ohio State.

CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasma De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasma de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
