LUG•NOTES

Hey, a Southpaw! Today, the Lugnuts' 23rd game of the season, is the first time this year that Lansing has faced a left-handed starting pitcher. In fact, each of the Lugnuts' next four games will feature a left-handed Captains starter.

The Prolific East: The Midwest League's East Division includes the league's three highest scoring teams: West Michigan (6.4 runs per game), Lake County (5.8) and Lansing (5.4). The West's Cedar Rapids Kernels (5.33) tip Great Lakes (5.27) for fourth.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the Athletics' second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 18. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 28.

Atop the League: The Lugnuts' offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.282), base hits (207), fewest strikeouts (144), on-base percentage (.391) and OPS (.797). The Nuts also rank second in slugging percentage (.406).

Home Cooking: The Nuts have been even better in Lansing, posting a Minor League-best .421 on-base percentage and a batting average .311, second behind only the Iowa Cubs (who have played in five fewer games). The Nuts are averaging 11 hits and six walks per game at home.

Streaking: **Clark Elliott** (1-4, walk last night) enters today on a 16-game on-base streak; **Tommy White** (1-for-2, 3 walks) has hit safely in 13 straight games and reached base in his last 15 games; and **T.J. Schofield-Sam** (2-5) has reached base in his last 14 games.

APRIL 30TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2008: For the second straight day, the Lugnuts and River Bandits played a game in two hours and six minutes. This one featured 18 hits (nine apiece) in a 4-3 Quad Cities victory, played at Duane Banks Field in Iowa City, home of the Iowa Hawkeyes, the third stadium (and third city) to host the Lugnuts/Bandits following flooding in Davenport.

2010: The Fort Wayne TinCaps turned a 4-2 deficit into a 10-4 win over the Lugnuts with eight runs off Dustin Antolin and Brian Slover in the top of the 8th at Cooley Law School Stadium, opening a three-game series.

2022: Jeff Criswell came three outs from a no-hitter, settling for a one-hitter in a doubleheader split at Lake County's Classic Park.

In a Nutshell: One of five 2024 draft picks on the Lugnuts' 2025 Opening Day roster, joining Tommy White (2nd round), Gage Jump (2nd round compensatory), Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (3rd round) and Rodney Green, Jr. (4th round)... made his Lugnuts debut in relief on April 6 at Fort Wayne, tossing two scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn first professional win in Lansing's 5-3 victory... made first MWL start on April 10 vs. Great Lakes: allowed two-out, two-run Joe Vetrano double in 3rd (unearned due to a Sahid Valenzuela error), breaking 1-1 tie; tossed five innings in all; suffered the loss in Lugnuts' 3-2 defeat.

Last Time Out: Second appearance vs. Fort Wayne, second victory! Robinson notched his first professional quality start with six innings of one-run ball, allowing five hits and one walk while striking out one... 81 pitches, 53 strikes... 5 groundouts / 7 airouts... only run allowed was on a Jose Sanabria RBI infield single in the 3rd inning... departed with the Lugnuts leading 7-1... Nuts went on to win, 7-3.

Welcome to Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yunior Tur.

Texas Tech: Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year... notable Texas Tech pros include Josh Tomlin, Danny Coulombe, Josh Jung, and the inimitable Dallas Braden.

High School: Played four years on varsity for George C. Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K... George C. Marshall is best known for the Marshall Plan, which saw the United States give \$13.3 billion to help rebuild Western European economies; it earned Marshall the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize... Marshall's nickname is the Statesmen... other notable Marshall alumni include the first woman to officially run the Boston Marathon, Kathrine Switzer; safety and current Dallas Cowboys special teams coordinator Nick Sorensen; defensive end Michael McCrary; table tennis legend Sean O'Neill; and pitcher Pete Schourek.
