TODAY'S GAME: Sugar Land heads to Sutter Health Park for the first time this season to kick off a six-game set against the River Cats on Tuesday.

ABOUT SUNDAY NIGHT: Tyler Ivey worked around a one-out single in the top of the first to keep Tacoma off the board before firing a scoreless second. Ivey rounded out his outing by retiring six of the final seven batters he faced in the fourth and fifth to hurl 5.0 scoreless innings. Sugar Land took their first lead of the game in the home half of the fifth as Jacob Hurtubise tripled, and with two outs in the frame, Jacob Melton drove him in with an RBI single. Two innings later, the Space Cowboys doubled their advantage in the seventh. Bryan Lavastida led off the frame with a single and was driven in by Brice Matthews who scorched a two-out RBI double. Tacoma scored a run in the top of the eighth, but Taylor Scott picked up his second save of the season with a shutout ninth to help Sugar Land to secure the 2-1 series-finale victory.

HOW THE TEAM WAS BUILT: The Space Cowboys roster features 11 players drafted by the Astros, 6 free agent signings, 3 international free agents, 2 players acquired in trades, 1 player claimed off waivers, 1 undrafted free agent and 5 players on Major League rehab.

PROSPECTING: Sugar Land's active roster features seven of the Astros Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline, including INF Brice Matthews (#1), OF Jacob Melton (#2), RHP Miguel Ullola (#4), the highest ranked pitching prospect in the Astros' organization, RHP Ethan Pecko (#10), RHP Alimber Santa (#11), RHP Jose Fleury (#16) and RHP Michael Knorr (#27).

NASTY NICK: With a scoreless seventh on Sunday, Nick Robertson now leads the Pacific Coast League in holds with nine. Since July 2, Robertson has a 1.29 ERA across seven appearances and 7.0 innings pitched with only one earned run allowed and seven strikeouts. Over that span, Robertson has lowered his ERA by 66 points.

MAGICAL MIGUEL: Miguel Ullola went 5.1 relief innings on Saturday, tying a season high in innings pitched and setting a Sugar Land season high in innings pitched from a reliever this season. In his last five appearances, Ullola has a 3.38 ERA in 24.0 innings. Also during that span, Ullola holds a 1.33 WHIP and a .148 opposing batting average while striking out 31 batters.

COMEBACK KIDS: Sugar Land tied their largest comeback win of the season on Saturday as they overcame a 6-0 deficit after five innings to defeat the Tacoma Rainiers 7-6 in 10 innings. The Space Cowboys scored seven unanswered runs, including three two-out RBI. According to Baseball Savant, with two outs in the ninth and nobody on base, Sugar Land had 1.4% win probability trailing 6-4. With Saturday's win, the Space Cowboys ran their record to 3-1 in the second half in extra innings and 6-2 on the season.

1-2-3? NOT US: The Space Cowboys have put a runner on base in 20-straight innings dating back to Friday night against the Rainiers. Sugar Land reached base in the 8th and 9th on Friday, were not retired in order in 10 innings on Saturday and had a man on base in every frame on Sunday. Also during that span, the Space Cowboys have a hit in 18 of their last 20 innings with 23 hits in their last two games.

SMASHIN' SALAZAR: César Salazar extended his on-base streak to nine games on Sunday with a 1-3 night. Over his on-base streak, Salazar is 8-23 (.348) with a double, two homers, six RBI, seven walks and five runs scored. The catcher has raised his batting average by 28 points during his on-base streak. Salazar is also on a six-game hitting streak, the longest active streak from a Space Cowboy, going 7-20 (.350/.480).

SHAY ALL DAY: Shay Whitcomb went 1-4 on Friday in his second game back since being optioned to Sugar Land on 7/31. A day earlier, Whitcomb whipped two doubles as part of a 2-5 night. In his last 11 games with the Space Cowboys dating back to June 27, Whitcomb is 14-for-45 (.311) with two doubles, a homer, five RBI, three walks and seven runs scored. Whitcomb is also on a five-game on-base streak, going 6-19 (.316) with two doubles, an RBI, two walks and two runs scored.

KENEDY COMES THROUGH: Kenedy Corona went 4-5 on Saturday with a double, an RBI and a run scored. Corona's four-hit night was his first at the Triple-A level and his first four-hit game since May 31, 2022 with the Fayetteville Woodpeckers.

DAVIDSON DELIVERS: Logan Davidson was the walk-off hero for Sugar Land on Saturday as he drove in Colin Barber with a sacrifice fly in the 10th. Davidson went 2-5 with two RBI on Saturday, his first multi-hit and multi-RBI game with Sugar Land.

MOVIN' ON UP: On Monday, C Miguel Palma and RHP Ethan Pecko were promoted to Sugar Land from Corpus Christi for the first time in 2025. Palma made six appearances with the Space Cowboys a season ago, including starting Game One of the PCL Championship Series. Pecko, the #10 prospect in the Astros' organization, earned his first Triple-A callup and is slated to appear for the Space Cowboys on Wednesday.

SUGAR LAND TO THE SHOW: The Space Cowboys have had six players from the 2025 team debut with the Astros this season, with RHP Logan VanWey debuting on April 11 vs. LAA, RHP AJ Blubaugh debuting and starting on April 30 vs. Detroit, LHP Colton Gordon debuting and starting on May 14 vs. KC, OF Jacob Melton debuting on June 1 vs. TB, OF Kennedy Corona debuting on July 7 vs. CLE and INF Brice Matthews debuting on July 11 vs. TEX. Additionally, 2024 Space Cowboys starter RHP Ryan Gusto made the Astros' Opening Day roster and debuted on March 31 vs. SF.

STARTING WITH A BANG: Zack Short and César Salazar have each recorded a lead-off home run in 2025. Short hit his fourth lead-off homer on 6/12 @ Reno and also hit lead-off blasts on 5/24 against Las Vegas, on 5/14 vs. Reno and scorched the first pitch of the game on 4/23 @ TAC 364-feet to right. It was the first homer on the first pitch of the game for Sugar Land since Bligh Madris on June 11, 2023 against the Round Rock Express. Salazar blasted his lead-off home run on April 17 against the Las Vegas Aviators.

ONE-HIT WONDER: Sugar Land used four pitchers (Ullola, Whitley, Ivey and Hernandez) to throw a one-hitter against Albuquerque on 4/13... It's the first time Sugar Land spun a one-hitter since 4/5/24 at Constellation Field against Las Vegas... It is the fourth nine-inning one-hitter in franchise history, with the others coming on 9/28/22 at Round Rock and 5/30/21 vs. Albuquerque... It's the second time this season Sugar Land has only allowed one hit in the first nine innings of a game, but Sugar Land ultimately surrendered a walk-off single in the 11th for a second hit in a 2-1 defeat at Durham on April 5.

A DOZEN DUBS: Sugar Land ripped off 12 consecutive wins from May 7 to May 21, the longest winning streak in Sugar Land affiliated history and tied for the longest winning streak in MiLB this season. During the winning streak, the Space Cowboys were tied after five innings or trailed in nine of their 12 wins, including a five-run comeback, their largest of the season. Sugar Land's winning streak also included a six-game sweep over the Reno Aces, the Space Cowboys' first six-game sweep of 2025 and first since June 6-11, 2024 against the Salt Lake Bees. The Space Cowboys previously won seven consecutive games on two occasions in 2022, first from June 10 -17 and then again from August 4 -11.

RIDING THE BRI-CYCLE: INF Brice Matthews hit for the cycle on 5/10 @ SL, the first cycle of his career. Matthews doubled in the 1st, singled in the 5th, tripled in the 7th and homered in the 8th, going 4-for-6 with 2 RBI and 4 runs scored. It is the second cycle in Space Cowboys history, after Pedro León hit for the cycle at Smith's Ballpark on June 24, 2023. Matthews' was also the first Space Cowboys hitter to score four runs in a game since Will Wagner on April 20, 2024 vs. Round Rock.

HOW RARE IS THAT?: The Space Cowboys won on Opening Night after trailing going to the ninth inning... During their 2024 campaign, Sugar Land went 6-49 in games that they trailed after eight innings... Per Baseball Savant, after OKC collected the first out in the 9th inning, Sugar Land had just a 2 percent win probability.

BEEN A LONG TIME: With 93 regular season wins in 2024, the Space Cowboys became the first team in the Pacific Coast League to win more than 92 games since the Albuquerque Dukes, who won 94 games in 1981... Sugar Land also won the most games in the regular season in Minor League Baseball, the only team to surpass the 90-win mark in 2024... Their 48 road victories were also the most by any team in Minor League Baseball.

WHERE TO FIND US: All 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on audio streaming at SLSpaceCowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can also be seen on the Bally Sports Live App for free, MiLB.TV, MLB.TV and the MiLB App. Garrett Greene returns for his third season as the primary play-by-play broadcaster for Sugar Land and will be on the call for all 150 games. He'll be joined at home and on select road games by Gerald Sanchez, who continues in his fifth season calling games for Sugar Land.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: Mickey Storey returns for his sixth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his fifth with Sugar Land, continuing as the only manager in Sugar Land's history since they became affiliated with the Astros. Storey earned his 500th professional win on June 4 over the Sacramento River Cats. He was named the Pacific Coast League Manager of the Year in 2024 after guiding Sugar Land to their first Pacific Coast League title. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with four seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

REST OF THE CREW: Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Sean Buchanan, hitting coach Joe Thurston and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Thurston joins the Space Cowboys after working as the hitting coach for Triple-A Lehigh Valley the last three seasons. Prior to joining the Phillies organization, Thurston coached in the Mariners system from 2017 - 2021, including serving on the Major League staff for Seattle in 2020. As a player, Thurston appeared in the Major Leagues with the Dodgers (2002-24), Phillies (2006), Red Sox (2008), Cardinals (2009) and Marlins (2011). Buchanan comes to Sugar Land following one season as the pitching coach with Double-A Corpus and one year with High-A Asheville (2023), along with a year in the Florida Complex League (2022). Buchanan previously coached in the collegiate ranks, working for eight seasons with stops that included Lehigh University, Albright College and DeSales University. Sutil enters his fourth season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds the Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

- Ranked second in opponent batting average (.157) and seventh in ERA (2.40) in May after going 4-0 in 30.0 IP.
- Represented the Dominican Republic in 2023 World Baseball Classic, earned a win against Nicaragua with 4.0 shutout frames.

2022:

- In the AL, ranked second in K/9 (11.74) and 4th in WHIP (0.95) while posting highest fly ball percentage (56.9) in 2022 (min. 140 IP).
- Tossed first 6.0 innings of Houston's no-hitter in Game 4 of the 2022 World Series...Became first pitcher ever to start two combined no-hitters.
- Struck out a career-high 14 hitters on 7/1 vs. LAA.

- Recorded a 3.55 ERA in 101.1 IP in 2021 with 130 strikeouts and a .186 opponent batting average.
