A day after his 21st birthday, **Steven Echavarria** struck out nine Captains in six dominant innings, finished off by a 100-mph fastball past top prospect Jace LaViolette, and the Lugnuts' offense backed him up with an eight-run fifth inning for an easy Friday night rout in front of 7,425 at Jackson Field.

LUG-NOTES

The Streak: The Nuts have won seven straight home games entering tonight (which is still ten wins away from the longest streak in franchise history, August 4, 2007-April 9, 2008). A look at the streak...

- July 24: 3-1 over GL. The winning streak begins with a dominant pitching performance from Jorge Marcheco (4 IP, 1 R) and the pen.
- July 25: 8-5 over GL. The Nuts score three runs in the 1st and three more in the 2nd, rolling to victory over the Loons.
- July 26: 8-7 over GL. A four-run 5th inning turns around a 4-2 deficit, and the Nuts go 6-for-16 with runners in scoring position.
- Aug. 4: 7-6 over LC. Devin Kirby-Williams gave up two runs in five innings, and the Nuts built a 7-2 lead and hung on.
- Aug. 5: 6-1 over LC. Jorge Marcheco tossed five innings and Daniel Bucciero walked four times in an easy Wednesday victory.
- Aug. 6: 6-5 over LC. Trailing 5-4 with two outs in the 9th, Breyson Guede and Daniel Bucciero supplied singles for a walk-off win.
- Aug. 7: 13-2 over LC. Steven Echavarria strikes out nine in six innings and Pedro Pineda caps an eight-run 5th with a three-run HR.

Streaking: Outfielder **Jake Reinisch** has homered in each of his last two games and reached base in 20 consecutive games (and in 21 of 22 games played for the Nuts), batting .292/.452/.508 over that stretch.

Welcome Aboard: 18-year-old Breyson Guede (pronounced "GEH-des") joined the Lugnuts at the start of this week from Class-A Stockton. The teenager is ranked the Athletics' No. 2 outfield prospect and No. 8 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline, signing as a top international free agent for about \$1.5 million from San Felipe, Venezuela, in January 2025. He posted a sizzling .359 batting average in his pro debut in the Dominican Summer League, then opened eyes in 2026 Spring Training, collecting singles in his first three Cactus League at-bats before slugging a 450-foot home run off San Diego Padres reliever Michael King on March 13. Thus encouraged, the A's skipped Guede up to Single-A Stockton to open the year and the Guede responded by hitting for a .379 average in June and .375 in July, collecting 73 hits in his last 46 games. He is the top-ranked player on the Lugnuts' roster.

Cooperstownian Nut: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted on July 26 into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andruw Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

2018: The Lugnuts won their third consecutive game by the same exact 5-4 score, knocking off the Dayton Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium. (On August 9th, the Lugnuts beat the Dragons... 4-3.)

What a Year! As a senior at Westbrook Christian H.S., 1) threw four no-hitters, one a perfect game, as a senior, going 9-0, 0.40 ERA, 53 IP, 14 H, 5 BB, 117 K, and 2) batted .515 with .612 OBP, 4 HR, 39 RBI, leading Warriors to 2021 state title (first title in school history)... named Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American.

College - From Tiger to Tiger: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.
