Last One Before the Break

The Fightin Phils are back on the road for the final series before the All-Star Break against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the 14th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and eighth-of-12 at TD Bank Ballpark in Bridgewater. Entering play on Wednesday, Reading leads the season-series 7-6 after the teams split a series in Somerset (Apr. 14-19) and at Reading (May 5-10). This is the final series of the season between the teams.

Heredia's Homer the Difference in a Pitchers Duel

The Reading Fightin Phils (8-5, 38-44) opened their series against the Somerset Patriots (5-8, 42-40) with a 2-1 victory on Tuesday night at TD Bank Ballpark as five pitchers combined to hold Somerset to one run. Gage Wood struck out four over three scoreless innings in his final tune-up before Sunday's MLB All-Star Futures Game, while Evan Gates (1-3) earned the win with two scoreless innings and Jack Dallas, Estibenon Jimenez and Alex McFarlane combined to finish the game. Raylin Heredia provided all of Reading's offense with a two-run home run in the fourth inning, his 17th of the season, giving the Fightins a lead they would not relinquish. Dallas surrendered the lone Somerset run on a DJ Gladney solo homer in the sixth before McFarlane worked a scoreless ninth for his 11th save. Reading's pitching staff struck out 11 batters without issuing a walk, while Pedro León collected two hits and Raider Tello added his first Double-A double in the win.

The Future is in Reading

Last night's starter Gage Wood, along with R-Phils reliever Wen-Hui Pan, were named last week to the MLB All-Star Futures Game. The game is scheduled for noon on Sunday at Citizens Bank Park in Philadelphia and will be broadcast on NBC. It marks the first Futures Game appearance for both players. Wood, the Phillies' 2025 first-round pick out of Arkansas, has posted a 3.44 ERA with 79 strikeouts over 55.0 innings in 16 starts between Clearwater and Reading this season. Pan, who joined the Fightins on June 13 after beginning the year on the injured list, owns a 2.92 ERA with 29 strikeouts in 24.2 innings and is a perfect 4-for-4 in save opportunities. The duo joins recent Reading representatives Mick Abel, Justin Crawford and Aidan Miller in the annual showcase of baseball's top prospects.

Hettiger Hits

Fightin Phils Catcher Kehden Hettiger turned in perhaps his best series of the season against New Hampshire. The 22-year old slashed .400/.471/.933 (1.404 OPS) across four games, while adding five runs, two doubles, two home runs and four RBI. Rated as one of the best defensive catchers in the Phillies organizations, Hettiger saw his average increase by 13 points last week.

Raking Raylin

Raylin Heredia extended his hit streak to 12 hits with his 17th home run of the season on Tuesday night. This came on the heels of a four-hit game on Sunday against New Hampshire. The four hits were a season high and matched a career best for the fourth time in his pro career. Heredia had four hits twice in 2022 with the DSL-Phillies (ROK) and once in 2025 with the FCL-Phillies (ROK). Over his 12-game hit streak, dating back to June 24, Heredia is slashing .375/.407/.692 (1.103 OPS), along with 12 runs, three doubles, five home runs and nine RBI. Over the hit streak, Heredia has multiple hits in six of the games, which included four contests in a row from June 26-30. Entering play on Wednesday, Heredia is 6th in the Eastern League in average (.291), T-5th home runs (17), eighth RBI (48), eighth SLG (.529), second hits (94), 1st doubles (24), 1st extra-base hits (42), 1st total bases (171) and T-3rd runs scored (53).

On Base Binelas

Alex Binelas saw his 23-game on-base streak come to an end on Friday, a mark that was second-longest by a Fightin Phil this season and tied for sixth most in the Eastern League in 2026. Over the streak, that dated back to June 7, Binelas slashed .341/.437/.705 (1.142 OPS), along with 22 runs, eight doubles, eight home runs and 17 RBI. Entering play on Wednesday, Binelas is ninth in the Eastern League in average (.286), tied for second in home runs (18), seventh RBI (49), 4th OBP (.399), 6th SLG (.545), 3rd OPS (.944), 10th hits (73), T-7th BB (46), 6th total bases (139) and tied for fifth in runs (51).

Bryan Gets on Base

Bryan Rincon's season-best 26-game on-base streak came to an end last Thursday night. It was the longest on-base streak by a R-Phil since Keaton Anthony's 25-game on-base streak in 2025. The Phillies' 27th ranked prospect's on-base streak was the longest by a Fightin Phil this season and was the fourth longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. The shortstop posted a .378 on-base percentage over the streak, which dated back to May 19.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 8, 2016: At Reading, the Fightin Phils score 21 runs over the first 5 innings en route to a 21-4 blasting of Bowie. Reading rips 5 home runs, with Rhys Hoskins and Dylan Cozens going back-to-back in the 1st inning to tally their 11th game in which they both hit home runs. Andrew PULLIN (3-for-4, HR, 2B, 3 RBI, 4 R) goes deep for his 3rd straight game while Osmel Aguilera (3-for-6, HR, 2B, 5 RBI, 3 R), Hoskins (2-for-4, HR, 4 RBI, 2 R) and Cozens (3-for-4, HR, 3B, 3 RBI 2 R) all have big games. Bowie pitchers issue 11 walks to go with 17 Reading hits.

Sup Somerset

Somerset enters play today with a 42-40 overall record and 5-8 mark in the second half, which is tied for fourth in the Northeast Division. The Patriots split a series at home against Hartford last week, and following this week and the All-Star Break, hit the road for a nine-game road trip at Portland and New Hampshire. Somerset's roster features nine of the Yankees' top-30 prospects: Ben Hess (5), Chase Hampton (8), Brock Selvidge (15), Cade Smith (16), Jace Avina (19), Xavier Rivas (23), Jack Cebert (25), Harrison Cohen (27) and Tony Rossi (30).

Patriots' Pitcher

Righty, and Yankees' No. 25 prospect, Jack Cebert makes the start for Somerset today. Over 10 appearances and nine starts, Cebert is 2-3, with a 5.98 ERA (33 ER, 49.2 IP), along with 61 strikeouts (11.05 SO/9.0 IP). Cebert last pitched last Thursday against Hartford, allowing two runs on five hits over six innings (Double-A high), with six strikeouts. He faced Reading on May 8, allowing four-earned runs over five innings, with six strikeouts in a no-decision. Cebert began the season with Hudson Valley (A+), going 2-1, with a 0.98 ERA over three games. He began his pro career with Hudson Valley in 2025, tossing in five games. The Yankees drafted the 24-year old in the 15th round in 2025 out of Texas Tech.
