## CORPUS CHRISTI HOOKS (22-43) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (40-26)

RHP JOSE FLEURY (3-1, 2.18 ERA) vs. RHP TINK HENCE (0-0, --- ERA)

**SETTING THE SCENE:** The Cardinals and Hooks (HOU) play the 4th game of a 6-game series and 10th of a 12-game homestand ... Springfield is 2-1 in the series and 8-1 on homestand.

**THE KINGS IN THE NORTH:** Springfield clinched the 1st Half North Division title with its win Thursday vs. CC ... is the franchise's 5th 1st-Half title all-time (2007, 2009, 2016, 2024), first back-to-back 1st-Half titles in team history, and 3rd-straight postseason appearance ... will host Game 2 (and 3 if necessary) of North Division Series on Sept. 18/19 at Hammons Field.

**A RECORD RECORD:** At 40-26, the Cardinals own the best record in the Texas League and, with 3 games remaining in the 1st Half, have a chance to set the franchise's top mark for wins before the mid-season point (41-29, 2016).

**HOW THE TURN TABLES:** Springfield is 28-10 in 38 games since falling to 5th place in the North Div. with a season-low record of 12-16 on May 7.

**HENCEFORTH:** RHP Tink Hence makes his 1st start this season for Springfield Friday night ... named Texas League Pitcher of Year with Cardinals in 2024 after going 4-3 with a 2.71 ERA in 20 starts ... recovering from a rib injury sustained during Spring Training ... has made appearances with Peoria, Palm Beach, and FCL Cardinals this season ... last pitched on June 13 with Peoria, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits over 3.2 IP ... entered season as the No. 3 ranked prospect in St. Louis organization and No. 68 MLB-prospect overall by *Baseball America*.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Springfield clinched the 1st-Half title with a 7-1 over the Hooks ... OF Joshua Baez went 3x3 with 2 HR and 5 RBI ... LHP Pete Hansen allowed just 1 run over 6.0 IP to pick up the win and record a quality start.

**BYE BYE BAEZ:** OF Joshua Baez recorded his 2nd multi-HR game in the TXL on Friday night ... has 6 HR and 20 RBI in 18 games ... has 3 HR and 8 RBI through first 3 games of series vs. CC.

**X MAN:** LHP Ixan Henderson allowed 2 runs and struck out 7 batters over 5.1 IP in a no-decision Wednesday vs. CC ... ranks 1st in TXL in ERA (2.07), SO (77), and OBA (.208) ... allowed just 2 HR in 65.1 IP and has a 1.02 WHIP since May 1.

**WETHER HEATING UP:** IF JJ Wetherholt is 1st in the TXL with a .316 AVG and .441 OBP ... posted multi-hits in 8-of-last-13 games.

**FEEL THE BERN:** C Leonardo Bernal leads the TXL with a .927 OPS and is tied for 1st with 11 HR ... ranks 2nd with 41 RBI.

**BAITING THE HOOKS:** Tonight's game is the 4th of 12 in the season series with CC and 4th of 6 at Hammons Field ... club's will match up in Texas for a 6-game series, July 8-13.

**TUNE IN:** Tonight's game can be heard on the radio home for Cardinals baseball, Classic Rock 106.7 FM, with TV broadcast available on Bally Sports Live & MiLB.TV ... Jason Schwartz provides the play-by-play.

- Enters 2025 ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 3 prospect in Cardinals organization (No. 68 in Top 100 overall MLB prospects)
- Rated as "Best Fastball" and "Best Slider" in Cardinals organization by *Baseball America*
- Added to Cardinals 40-man roster on Nov. 19, 2024
- Was invited to Major League Spring Training for consecutive seasons (2023-24) as a non-roster player and was camp's youngest pitcher at 21-years-old in 2024
- Named 2024 Texas League Pitcher of the Year joining 2017's Dakota Hudson as the 2nd-ever player to win the honor
- Made 20 starts for Springfield in 2024 ... went 4-3 with a 2.71 ERA in 20 starts ... set career-highs for strikeouts (109) and IP (79.2)
- Struck out a career-high 13 batters vs. Tulsa on May 25, tying the Springfield single-game franchise record
