# GET TO KNOW YOUR C'S

## NICK FRAZE, PITCHER

*You had your best game of the year so far on May 28 against Everett when you went six shutout innings.*

*What was working so well that night?*

I tried to get ahead, throw strikes, trust my stuff and make them hit it. In my last start I got a bunch of nice defensive plays early on. [Luis] De Los [Santos] made a great catch on a line drive in the first, Phil [Clarke] threw a runner out, so that kind of momentum really helps a pitcher and settles you down when the defense makes big plays like that. Everything was just going well, some calls went my way and it was a good night.

*Tell us ore about your overall approach.*

For me, my approach is to get everybody out in three pitches or less. I just try to attack the zone. If I get a call on the corner that's cool, I'll start to go after the corner. My goal is force contact by throwing it in there to make them hit it.

*What's going through your mind before a start? Do you have certain things you do or think about?*

I get together with both Phils [pitching coach Phil Cundari and catcher Phil Clarke] and come up with a game plan to have an idea what I'm going to do. I tend to struggle with left-handed hitters, so if I'm going to go in then go IN, don't miss middle. I've been working on throwing my changeup more and getting that dialed in. My slider has been good, especially going front door to lefties, and it's all clicked together. I've been working on things in the pen and it has translated over. My goal is to consistently throw strikes and attack the zone, that's the most important part.

*It's a weird year playing away from Vancouver all season. What's it been like for you and your teammates?*

I miss Nat Bailey, I miss Vancouver. That was an amazing time there [in 2019]. That's a special place for sure. It's definitely weird sharing a field and not having a home field setting. You just have to adapt. Most of these guys have played all over the word, all over the country, so we're kind of use to playing in random places in the middle of nowhere. It's all good, I like it out here.



# GET TO KNOW YOUR C'S

## NICK FRAZE, PITCHER

*When you were in college at Texas State, you pitched against Rice and won seven shutout innings with a career-high 12 strikeouts, one hit and no walks in a 1-0 win. What do you remember from that day?*

Rice had a bunch of right handed hitters in the lineup. I think we threw my slider the entire time [laughs]. The game was at Minute Maid [Park, the home of the Houston Astros], and hitters on my team said it's kind of hard to see with the shadows. I thought "I'm just going to throw my slider and see what happens." Things worked out.

*What is your vision for the 2021 season?*

My main focus this year is to go out, give it my all, stay healthy and take it day by day. All I can control is what is right in front of me. I'll make a start, do my recovery the next day [light catch, plyometrics, stretching, muscle maintenance] and continue to go with the daily plan. I don't try to think too far in the future. If I throw strikes and attack hitters, it's going to work out for me.
