NEWS & NOTES

WASHED OUT: The Renegades and Cyclones will play a doubleheader on Wednesday. It marks the second doubleheader of the season at Heritage Financial Park, and the fourth doubleheader overall for Hudson Valley. The Renegades are 2-4 in doubleheader games this season.

NEW BEGINNINGS: After a 4-3 loss on Sunday, Hudson Valley dropped four of six to Wilmington at Frawley Stadium. It marks just the second time this season that Hudson Valley has dropped three straight games. The Renegades went 5-6 overall on a two-week road trip. With 13 series under their belt in 2025, the Renegades have won six, split five, and lost two.

WELCOME BACK: On Monday, **Alexander Vargas** was announced as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week. Last week in Wilmington, Vargas went 12-for-22 (.545) at the plate with a double, home run and three RBIs. He led the SAL last week in five offensive categories. Vargas also has a current nine-game hitting streak, where he's hitting .444 (16-for-36) with two HRs, eight RBIs, and a 1.126 OPS. He has multi-hit games in five of his last seven appearances, including a three-hit performance on Saturday.

AIN'T IT GRAND?: With **Josh Moylan's** grand slam in the sixth inning of Saturday's game at Jersey Shore, the Renegades have hit five grand slams this year in 72 games, the most by the team in the Portal Era when game logs are available online (2005-Present). The Renegades hit four grand slams in 2021, 2023 and 2024.

BEST IN SHOW: The Renegades have the lowest team ERA (2.85) among full-season MiLB teams in 2025. Since the start of the 2021 season, the Renegades own a cumulative 3.54 ERA, the lowest in MiLB among MiLB teams who have played every season.

SCORING DROUGHT: After averaging 5.5 runs per game through the first two months of 2025, the Renegades offense cooled down in the month of June. They averaged 3.9 runs per contest in 24 games, hitting just .224 as a team with a .649 OPS. Through 49 games, they hit .249 with a team OPS of .757.

DOUBLE DIGIT RARITY: The Hudson Valley pitching staff had a tough time on Friday against the Blue Rocks, giving up double-digit runs for just the second time in their last 120 games in a 11-0 defeat. The Renegades hadn't allowed 10-or-more runs since May 21 vs Winston-Salem.

CRAZY EIGHT: The Renegades struck for eight runs in the fifth inning on Wednesday, setting a season-high for runs in an inning. It is the first time Hudson Valley has scored eight runs in an inning since August 27, 2022 vs Hickory. That contest featured a four-hit game from Jasson Dominguez, as well as an eight-run seventh inning.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST: Hudson Valley struck for 10 runs on 12 hits in their victory on Thursday. It marked the 16th time this season that the Renegades scored nine-or-more runs, having surpassed their 2024 season total of 14 in half of the games played. In their first 69 games, the Renegades also have 20 games of 10 or more hits and 14 games of 12 or more hits. In 2024, they had a total of 12 games with 12+ hits.

HIGH-A SUBWAY SERIES: Hudson Valley begins a six-game home-and-home-series with the Brooklyn Cyclones at Heritage Financial Park. The Renegades have seen their former NY Penn League foe just once this year previously. In their final 57 games this season, Hudson Valley will play Brooklyn 18 times. The two teams split a six-game series in frigid temperatures on Coney Island in April. They will play 12 games against one another in the month of August. Brooklyn won the first-half time in the SAL North with a 46-20 record. Hudson Valley also faced Brooklyn 24 times in 2024.

LENGTH: **Josh Grosz** continues to display an ability to pitch deep into games. On Saturday, Grosz tossed 7.1 innings, becoming the first Renegades pitcher to throw more than seven innings this season. No Hudson Valley starter has recorded at least one out in the seventh inning since Drew Thorpe threw eight innings on July 22, 2023. It's the fourth time Grosz has gone seven innings this season, and the fifth time in the last six starts that he has thrown at least six frames.

MIDDLE INNINGS: Between the fourth and seventh innings, Hudson Valley is outscoring opponents 171-90 this season. They are outscoring their opponents 50-18 in the seventh inning alone.

ENEMY TURNED FRIEND: **Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz** dealt with some defensive mistakes behind him on Sunday, but allowed just one earned runs across 4.2 innings while striking out six. In the month of June, Rodriguez allowed just three total earned runs across 28.2 innings, a 0.94 ERA. The right-hander leads the SAL in ERA with a 2.47 mark and is also first in strikeouts with 91 this season. He has six quality starts to lead the team.

STARTING STRONG: Starting pitching has been instrumental in 2025. During the month of June, the Renegades starting staff leads MiLB with an exceptional 1.67 ERA in 124.0 innings. Through 72 games, Hudson Valley starters have 420 punchouts in 374 innings, good for a 10.2 K/9 clip. Those 420 strikeouts are the most of any team in MiLB including AAA teams. The staff has also issued just 150 walks, a 3.6 BB/9.

RECENT STRUGGLES: Following a 23-9 start to the season, the Renegades have gone 19-22 since. After losing just 19 total games at Heritage Financial Park in 2024, the Renegades are 19-13 at home so far this season. They have gone 8-10 at home since mid-May. At ShoreTown Ballpark against Jersey Shore from June 17-22, Hudson Valley won their first series since May 6-10 vs Wilmington.

DEATH VALLEY LEFTY: **Griffin Herring** had his most difficult start as a pro on Friday, allowing five earned runs in three innings. Herring had allowed eight total runs through his first 12 pro starts. Friday's game was the first time Herring was charged with more than two runs in a start. The Yankees No. 25 prospect still has seven quality starts this season, and three in five starts with Hudson Valley.

WHAT'S IN A SCORE?: After not having played a game with a 1-0 final score since July 19, 2024, the Renegades have seen that score take place four times in a span of 14 games. The 'Gades won back-to-back 1-0 games against Greenville on 6/13 and 6/14, and lost to Jersey Shore 1-0 on 6/17 before losing to Wilmington 1-0 on 6/25.

BOMBS AWAY: The Renegades set a season-high with five home runs last Friday, including three balls alone in the second inning. It is the first time since April 30, 2023 that Hudson Valley has hit three home runs in an inning, and the first time since June 23, 2024 that they have hit five home runs in a game.

UNDRAFTED STAR: **Parks Harber** is off to an incredible start with the Renegades after being called up from Tampa in late April. Harber has built a current nine-game hitting streak where he's hitting .375 with seven RBIs. It is his second straight 8+ game hitting streak in High-A already this year. In 34 games with the Renegades, the infielder is hitting .326 with 11 doubles, 27 RBIs and an .884 OPS.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER: Hudson Valley's bullpen has been outstanding, recording a 2.73 ERA through 73 games, the second-best mark in High-A and the fourth-best in MiLB. The Renegades trail Pensacola (AA, MIA), West Michigan (A+, DET), and Erie (AA, DET), who leads the way with a 2.27 mark. Renegades relievers are holding opponents to a .189 opposing average, while striking out 302 batters in 260.1 innings. On Wednesday, Geoff Gilbert, Chris Keane, Matt Keating, and Tony Rossi for seven one-run innings with seven strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Making his first start in a little over a month, Hess had a short outing last Wednesday against the Wilmington Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium, allowing two runs on one hit and three walks in 1.2 innings while striking out three. After a 1-2-3 first inning with two strikeouts, Hess struggled a little more with command in the second, but his fastball velocity was noticeably up, sitting in the 94-95 range whereas in his first starts of the year he sat more 91-92.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season in on the Renegades Break Camp Roster.
- Struck out nine batters in his professional debut on 4/9 @ Brooklyn: 4.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 9 K on 70 pitches.
- Took a no-hitter into the seventh inning on 5/8 @ Wilmington: 6.2 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 9 K on 88 pitches. Lone hit allowed was an infield single by Caleb Lomavita in the seventh that deflected off Hess' leg.

RECORD SETTER: While at Alabama, Hess set the program's all-time record with 13.34 K/9, while striking out 34.6% of batters he faced in three seasons.

FIRST TIME, LONG TIME: When Hess was drafted by the Yankees in the 1st round of the 2024 MLB Draft, he became the first pitcher taken by the Yankees with their first pick since they took **Clarke Schmidt** 16th overall in the 2017 MLB Draft. In between, the Yankees selected position players **Anthony Seigler** (2018), **Anthony Volpe** (2019), **Austin Wells** (2020), **Trey Sweeney** (2021), **Spencer Jones** (2022), and **George Lombard** (2023) with thier first picks in six consecutive drafts. It was the longest run of position players selected by the Yankees with their first pick in the history of the Yankees. Hess is just the second four-year college pitcher drafted by the Yankees with their first pick since the team selected **Andrew Brackman** 30th overall in the 2007 MLB Draft, and the fourth since the Yankees drafted **Dave Walling** 27th overall in 1999 (also **Ian Kennedy**, 21st overall in 2006).

WE WANT 'BAMA: Hess became only the fifth player from the University of Alabama to be drafted in the first round of the First-Year Player Draft when he was selected 26th overall by the Yankees in 2024. He joined first baseman Joe Vitiello (seventh overall in 1991 by the Kansas City Royals), catcher Jeremy Brown (35th overall in 2002 by the Oakland Athletics), LHP Taylor Tankersley (27th overall in 2004 by the Florida Marlins) and RHP Tommy Hunter (54th overall in 2007 by the Texas Rangers). The Athletics' drafting of Brown was chronicled in the best-selling book Moneyball by Michael Lewis, but was omitted from the Hollywood film of the same name. Arguably the most-successful Crimson Tide alumni to play Major League Baseball was Hall of Famer Joe Sewell, who played for Cleveland (1920-30) and the Yankees (1931-33), batting .312 lifetime and being regarded as the hardest player to strike out in MLB history, fanning just 114 times in 8333 career plate appearances (1.4 K%).

PERSONAL:

- Full name is Benjamin William Hess.
- Signed with the Yankees on July 22, 2024 for a below-slot \$2,747,500 bonus.
- Dealt with injury concerns in high school and during his first two collegiate seasons, including a right flexor strain that limited him to seven games in 2023.
- Over his college career at Alabama (2022-24), Hess posted a 12-6 record and a 4.81 ERA in 33 games (30 starts) and set the program record with 13.34 K/9 in his career.
- Named a preseason 3rd Team All-American by D1 Baseball and Baseball America in 2024.
- At Charleston (IL) HS, ranked #1 right-handed pitcher in Illinois and #2 overall prospect by Perfect Game, and #72 overall in class, while MaxPreps ranked him the #1 player in Illinois.
- Was ranked as the #38 overall prospect by Baseball America and #44 by MLB Pipeline in the 2024 draft class.

LAST TIME OUT: Carr was in the middle of another strong start last Thursday at Jersey Shore when the game was suspended by lightning in the area, halting the game right after the bottom of the fourth inning. The left-hander had thrown 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits and one walk while striking out four and throwing only 48 pitches (31 strikes). It marked the fifth straight start for Carr in which he allowed one-or-fewer earned runs. When the game resumed on Friday, three relievers combined to complete a 2-0 shutout win for Hudson Valley.

MAKING HISTORY: Carr's start on 5/27 against Wilmington marked the 32nd start in Carr's Renegades career, which moved him into first place for most games started in Renegades history. He had been tied with Scott Vandermeer, who started 31 games for Hudson Valley in the 2000, 2001 and 2003 seasons, for the franchise record. He enters Wednesday's start with Brooklyn 2.1 IP away from tying Vandermeer's team record for most innings thrown (169.1).

KEEPING IN IN THE PARK: During his first professional season in 2024, Carr was one of the best pitchers in Minor League Baseball at preventing home runs, allowing only five on the season across 140.0 innings. That total was the second-fewest in the Yankees system, and the fourth-fewest allowed among left-handed pitcher in MiLB in 2024 (min. 100.0 IP). Carr didn't allow a long ball over his final 45.0 innings of the season, and he posted a 49.7% groundball rate, the second-best mark in the SAL (min. 100.0 IP).

INJURIES IN SAN DIEGO: Carr spent two years playing at the University of San Diego before transferring to Palomar for 2023. During that time he struggled with injuries including Tommy John surgery in October 2020, and a broken hand and torn right shoulder labrum in 2022. Carr to the San Diego Union-Tribune: "I struggled with injuries and school at USD. And they were related. As I fought my way through the injuries, I let my schoolwork slip. And you can't do that in college. You have to stay on top of your classes. I didn't do that. I loved the coaches and players at USD. [USD head coach] Brock Ungricht is one of the really good guys, my favorite all-time coach. I felt I let him down."
