Tonight's Game: The Sounds and Storm Chasers play game four of the six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. After dropping the first game of the series, the Sounds have won the last two. Right-hander Chad Patrick is on the bump for Nashville. He will go against right-hander William Fleming.

Chad Patrick: The 25-year-old righty is making his third start of the season for the Sounds. He is 0-0 with a 5.14 ERA (7.0 IP/4 ER) with three walks and three strikeouts in his two starts. Last season for Triple-A Las Vegas, Patrick had six appearances (five starts) posting a 7.89 ERA (21.2 IP/19 ER) with 25 strikeouts. He was traded twice in 2023 with the first being on July 31 from Arizona to Oakland for Jace Peterson. He was then traded to Milwaukee from Oakland in exchange for Abraham Toro on November 15, 2023. He is 9-13 with a 4.97 ERA (183.0 IP/101 ER) in 44 appearances (38 starts) in his minor league career. He was drafted in 2021 by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 4th round from Purdue University-Northwest.

William Fleming: The 25-year-old righty is making his third start of the season for the Storm Chasers. He is 0-0, with a 5.00 ERA (9.0 IP/5 ER), two walks and nine strikeouts. In his first start at Columbus, Fleming went 4.2 innings, two hits, zero earned runs and six strikeouts. His second start he struggled through 4.1 innings by allowing eight hits, five earned runs, two walks and three strikeouts. These were his only career starts at the Triple-A level with his 2023 season split between High-A and Double-A. Last year, Fleming went 5-2 with a 4.11 ERA (107.1/49 ER) and 91 strikeouts in 23 appearances (19 starts). He was drafted in 2021 by the Mariners in the 11th round from Wake Forest. In 2022, he was traded along with Wyatt Mills to the Royals for Carlos Santana.

Runners Beware: With Isaac Collins' assist from left field last night, the Sounds have three-straight games with an outfield assist. In game one of the series, Chavez Young threw a runner out at home from center and Young nabbed another runner at second base while playing right field in game two. The three-game stretch includes assists from all three outfield spots to second base, third base and home. In 2023, the Sounds only had one three-game outfield assist streak on June 28-30 at Memphis (Sal Frelick, Tyrone Taylor, Michael Reed). Chavez Young's back-to-back games with an outfield assist also only occurred once during the 2023 season for Nashville with Roman Quinn accomplishing it versus Gwinnett (June 15/June 17).

Black, Black, Black: Tyler Black had a triple in back-to-back games for the second time in his career with the first on July 20-21, 2023 at Montgomery. Black is tied with Gwinnett's Luke Waddell for the International League lead with three triples this season. He is currently riding a six-game hitting streak (11-for-26) and has hit safely in nine of his last 10 games (.378, 8 RBI, 7 BB). The No. 41 prospect in baseball (MLB Pipeline) is tied for seventh in the International League with 21 hits.

Bullpen Beat: The Sounds bullpen was stingy last night with 5.2 scoreless, one hit, one walk and nine strikeouts. Nashville relievers continue to lead the Triple-A level in most statistical categories, including ERA (1.21), WHIP (0.94) and opponent batting average (.152). The next closest bullpen ERA at the level come in at 3.26 (Tacoma), with only Tacoma having a sub-.200 opponent batting average among relievers.

Big Z: Rob Zastryzny picked up his third win of the season moving his record to 3-0. He is tied with five other players for the Triple-A lead in that category. Zastryzny has yet to give up a run in six innings this season allowing one hit, zero walks while striking out eight. He is second on the team in appearances behind Enoli Paredes and has held batters to a .053 batting average posting a 0.14 WHIP. He has a 9.0 inning streak dating back to August 24, 2023 without giving up an earned run.

Mr. Minnesota: Isaac Collins put together his second multi-hit performance in his last five games. During his five-game hitting streak, Collins is 8-for-21 with three doubles, a triple, and six RBI. He is second on team with 11 RBI and is batting .462 (6-for-13) with runners in scoring position. Collins' .650 slugging percentage would lead the Sounds if he were qualified.

Sounds to the Show: Wednesday, Tobias Myers became the seventh Sound this season to be called up to Milwaukee's 26-man roster this season. He joins the list of JB Bukauskas (4/3), Aaron Ashby (4/6), Kevin Herget (4/9), Joey Wiemer (4/14), Jared Koenig (4/14) and Owen Miller (4/16).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 692-592 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,284-2,112 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

LAST OUTING: Patrick pitched 4.0 innings and allowed six hits (two home runs) four earned runs, three walks and had three strikeouts. He left the game with the Sounds trailing 4-3 and ultimately was charged with a no-decision.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's first start against Omaha. He faced the Royals Double-A affiliate on April 22, 2023 where he faced off against current Royals big leaguer Alec Marsh. He went 2.2 innings, four hits, two earned runs, three walks and one strikeout in a losing effort.
