YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 5-4, in 11 innings on a walk-off single by Cody Wilson. It was the second straight game Richmond lost on a walk-off to begin the series in Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels opened a 4-0 lead in the third inning with an RBI bunt single by **Jimmy Glowenke** and a three-run double by **Andy Thomas. Carson Ragsdale** started and threw five innings, his longest start since 2021. Jordy Barley picked up the Senators' first hit with a double in the fifth and later came in to score from second on a wild pitch. Stone Garrett brought in a run with a single in the sixth to close the score to 4-2. In the seventh, Andrew Pinckney hit an RBI single and Dylan Crews brought in a run with a groundout to tie the game, 4-4. **Evan Gates** stranded the bases loaded in the ninth to force extras.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the first of three series between the two teams this season. The Senators come to Richmond for a six-game series from July 9–14. The Flying Squirrels return to Harrisburg for a six-game set from August 13-18. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels went 13-8 against the Senators, including a 3-6 mark at FNB Field and a 10-2 record at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS reached the postseason for the second consecutive season in 2022 and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 3-3 in their last six games. The 4-7 start is the worst record for the Flying Squirrels through their first 11 games since 2017.

THE SENATORS went 59-77 last year and finished in last place in the Southwest Division for the third consecutive season. This year, they started the season 1-5 but have won their last two games. They went 2-3 in last week's road series at Altoona. Among the Eastern League leaders, Dylan Crews is tied for second in RBIs (9) and Brady House is tied for fourth in hits (11). The Harrisburg roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Dylan Crews (No. 1), 3B Brady House (No. 3), 3B Yohandy Morales (No. 4), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 8), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 17), RHP Cole Henry (No. 24) and C Israel Pineda (No. 25). Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes seven Harrisburg players, including Crews (No. 1), House (No. 3), Morales (No. 5), Hassell (No. 7), Pinckney (No. 19), Henry (No. 22) and LHP Andrew Alvarez (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his third start of 2024. He last pitched on Friday against the RubberDucks and allowed two runs over four innings in a no-decision. Murphy spent all of last season with the Flying Squirrels, going 2-9 with a 4.36 ERA in 29 outings. His 27 starts were tied for the most in the Eastern League. Murphy struck out 107 batters last year, sixth-most in the Giants organization. He had a 5.21 ERA (28 ER/48.11 P in his first 14 outings through June 22, but over his next 14 outings from June 28-September 10, he posted a 2.77 ERA (17 ER/55.1 IP) with 61 strikeouts. Murphy made his Double-A debut in June of 2022, one of two starts with Richmond that year before he was shut down with an injury. In his first professional season in 2021, he pitched for Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene and struck out 164 batters, which was the third-most in the minors for the year. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College in New York, which was then an NCAA Dll program. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Andrew Alvarez makes his third start of the season. He was the Opening Day starter for the Senators on April 5 against Erie and threw five hitless innings with seven strikeouts. Alvarez last pitched on Saturday at Altoona and worked two innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on 59 pitches. He began last season with High-A Wilmington and went 7-4 with a 2.61 ERA in 21 outings (18 starts) before a promotion to Double-A in mid-August. In his five games (four starts) with the Senators, he went 0-3 with a 4.50 ERA. He made his Double-A debut on August 18, 2023 at The Diamond against the Flying Squirrels and allowed two runs over five innings in a loss. Alvarez was selected by the Nationals in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Cal Poly. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 30 Nationals prospect.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt hit his first homer of the year on Saturday night, a three-run shot to give the Flying Squirrels a lead in the third inning. His next game in the lineup, the series opener at Harrisburg on Tuesday, he added a solo homer in the second inning. Last year, Wyatt combined to hit 17 homers between High-A Eugene and Double-A Richmond, which was tied for fifth in the Giants organization. He hit nine homers in his 64 games with Richmond last season. Since his Double-A debut on June 14, 2023, Wyatt leads the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.250), SLG (.450) and OPS (.783), ranks second in homers (11) and third in RBIs (39).

GRANTING WISHES: Grant McCray has worked eight walks this season, which is third in the Eastern League. After hitting .050 (1-for-20) in his first six games to open the season, he is batting .333 (4-for-12) with a homer, a double and three RBIs in his last three games. On Sunday afternoon at The Diamond against Akron, McCray hit his first Double-A homer, a three-run shot in the sixth to extend Richmond's lead in a 5-1 win. Last season with High-A Eugene, McCray hit 14 homers led the Northwest League in hits (126), totals bases (206), runs (101) and stolen bases (52).

GLOW SHOW ON THE ROAD: Jimmy Glowenke is batting .412 (7-for-17) in his four road games this season compared to .105 (2-for-19) at The Diamond. Last season with Richmond, Glowenke hit .323 (42-for-130, 7 HR, 28 RBI, .963 OPS) in his Double-A road games compared to .171 (20-for-117, 0 HR, 2 RBI, .501 OPS) in his 37 home games at The Diamond.

GRAND LARCENY: The Flying Squirrels are the only team in the Eastern League perfect in its stolen base attempts this season, going 13-for-13. The 12 stolen bases are tied for sixth in the league overall. **Brett Auerbach** is 4-for-4 in steal attempts and his four steals are tied for fifth in the league. In 2023, the Flying Squirrels were 124-for-153 (81.1 percent) in stolen base attempts, the highest percentage in franchise history, surpassing the previous record of 77.6 percent in 2021.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 111 strikeouts this season, which is third in the Eastern League. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.21 ERA (15 ER/42.0 IP) this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (1.69) and Erie (2.50).

CLOSE CALLS: This season, the Flying Squirrels have played six games decided by one run, going 2-4 in those games. Their six one-run games are the most in the Eastern League this season. The Flying Squirrels began the season with a 5-4 loss at Somerset on April 5, lost 2-1 to Akron last Tuesday, won 2-1 on a walk-off error last Thursday against the RubberDucks, picked up a 3-2 win over Akron on Friday. Richmond lost 3-2 against Harrisburg to open this week' series before falling 5-4 on Wednesday night. Of the Flying Squirrels' seven losses this year, they have dropped four by one run, one by two runs and one by three runs.

FAMILIAR FACES: Sixteen players on the current active roster return from last year's Flying Squirrels team, including Brett Auerbach, Victor Bericoto, John Michael Bertrand, Hayden Birdsong, Vaun Brown, Matt Frisbee, Evan Gates, Jimmy Glowenke, José Cruz, Wil Jensen, Ryan Murphy, Tyler Myrick, Nick Swiney, Andy Thomas, Will Wilson and Logan Wyatt. Of those players, five are in their third season with Richmond, including Auerbach, Brown, Gates, Jensen and Murphy. Two players, Frisbee and Wilson, are with the Flying Squirrels for a fourth season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Reggie Crawford (No. 9), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).
