LAST GAME

A routine, albeit deflating, occurrence for the Bowie Baysox on the road this season returned on Sunday afternoon, as Bowie suffered their 12th walk-off loss of the year. Coming back to tie the game twice, Bowie fell to the Erie SeaWolves 5-4 on a sacrifice fly by Quincy Nieporte in the ninth inning. The early game seemed to have Bowie instantly up against the wall, as starter Chance Kirby retired the first 12 batters of the game, and he carried a no hitter into the sixth inning. While Erie built a 3-0 lead, Bowie used big home runs to stay in the running, as Cesar Prieto blasted a three-run shot in the seventh, and Coby Mayo tied the game again with a solo blast in the ninth. Hector Perez could not guide the game into extra innings, being served his second walk-off loss of the season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

In a series that (Bowie hopes) should preview the first round of the Eastern League playoffs, Bowie will try to make one more charge against the team that they have battled tightly with this seaosn. While Richmond went 7-2 against Bowie in the first half of the season, Bowie flipped the record around against Richmond in the second half, bringing the season series to an even 9-9. While they were able to win the first half of the season in a tiebreak with Akron, the second half has been much more difficult for the Squirrels, as they have the league's worst record in the half. Richmond has relied constantly on power this season, as they have the third-most home runs in the league, despite sporting the lowest batting average.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Keaton Winn is vet another high-volume strikeout arm in the Giants organization, and has used that volume to climb through three levels this season. A fifth-round JuCo pick by San Francisco, Winn did not pitch in 2021 after undergoing Tommy John surgery, and made 13 appearances at Single-A to start the season. He only made eight appearances at High-A, but struck out 46 batters in 37 innings to earn his promotion. The strikeouts aren't there for him in Double-A just yet, as he's only punched out 11 batters in 16 innings, and has given up 20 hits, including ten hits in his last start. He's averaging over one hit per inning this season

MEAT LEFT ON THE BONE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in all three slash lines (.269/.366/.461) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off doubles. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 922 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.4 per game. Bowie has also stranded the most runners in scoring position in the league (680). Inversely, Bowie has the second-most strikeouts in the league when batting with runners on base (544).

THE TIMES THEY ARE A-CHANGIN'

Bowie has not been a team this season to put on a big late-inning attack. Bowie still has the lowest batting average (.182) and the fewest runs scored (32) in the ninth inning of games this season, but they have bucked that trend in the last week. In their last four wins, Bowie has scored in the ninth inning in three of them, with two of the wins only possible from Bowie's runs in the ninth inning. Over the last week, Bowie has scored six runs in the ninth inning.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie has had a love-hate relationship with one-run games this season nine of Bowie's last 13 losses have been by only one-run. One-run games have been one of the most common outcomes for Bowie this season, as their 47 one-run games leads the Eastern League. Their .404 winning percentage in one-run games (19-28) is the second-lowest in the Eastern League, trailing only Binghamton. The 28 one-run losses is the most in all of Minor League Baseball, and tied with the Texas Rangers for the most in all of baseball.

The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
