RIDERS THUMPED BY MISSIONS:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped a 10-3 decision to the San Antonio Missions on Friday at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium despite a strong day from **Aaron Zavala**. Leading off for the eighth time this season, Zavala reached four out of five times with a single and three walks. He scored twice, both on **Evan Carter** base hits. Carter brought a two-out rally to fruition in the fifth inning. Zavala started the rally with a walk after getting behind 0-2 with two outs and the bases empty. **Luisangel Acuña** also walked and Carter doubled down the right field line to score both runners. That cut the lead in half at 4-2. Carter got another two-out RBI in the seventh inning, singling to the shortstop to score Zavala again. Zavala had walked on a 3-2 pitch and swiped second for his fifth steal of the season. Carter is now 7-for-13 (.538 average) in the series in San Antonio and 17-for-36 (.472) with three home runs at Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium this season. **Trevor Hauver** went 1-for-4 to extend his hitting streak to 10 games. **Jack Leiter** (2-4) started for Frisco and went 4.2 innings with five strikeouts, seven hits and eight runs. Juan Lopez (1-0) handled 2.1 relief innings with one earned run to get the win for the Missions. **Triston Polley** made quick work of the Missions when he pitched in the seventh inning, striking two of the three batters he faced. **Michael Brewer** followed with a scoreless eighth inning.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last eight games since his return, he has five multi-hit games, batting .484 (15-for-31)/.528/.806/1.334 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 11 RBIs and seven runs scored. Carter is now seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.309), third in OBP (.423) and eighth in OPS (.877).

TO HAUVER AND TO HOLD:

Trevor Hauver has been one of the best hitters for the RoughRiders recently. He is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak, batting .371 (13-for-35)/.511/.514/1.025 with two doubles, one home run, four RBIs, seven runs scored, 10 walks and a steal.

RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .256, though Frisco is fourth with 281 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 14 games (6-8 record), Frisco is hitting .263 (35-for-133) in those situations.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak, Saggese hit .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is first on the team with a .304 batting average, 10 homers, 54 RBIs, 47 runs scored (tied with Acuña) and .855 OPS. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, second in the Texas League with a .565 average (13-for-23) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.540 OPS on the first pitch, which is second in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .449 (22-for-49) on the initial offering while his 22 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 32 and is on pace for a career-best 63 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 103 bases in 122 attempts (84 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)).

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .304 (81-for-269)/.360/.442/.802 through the first 62 games. In June, Acuña is hitting .300/.336/.460/.796. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (113).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 352 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is third in the Texas League. The Riders have four in the top seven players in Texas League walk rate this season: **Dustin Harris** (4th, 15.8%), **Trevor Hauver** (5th, 15.7%), **Jax Biggers** (6th, 15.7%) and **Evan Carter** (7th, 15.4%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, **Aaron Zavala** is walking at a 17.4% rate so far this season.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 8-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
