MISSED OPPORTUNITIES HAUNT SHRIMP

Troy Johnston's home run on Wednesday wasn't enough in the Jumbo Shrimp's 3-2 loss to the Bulls. Johnston went deep in the top of the first inning, only for a Curtis Mead homer to tie the game in the bottom of the first. Mead launched a two-run shot in the third to put Durham ahead 3-2. Deyvison De Los Santos notched an RBI single in the fifth to make it 3-2, but Jacksonville failed to cash in on several opportunities, going just 2-for-12 with runners in scoring position and stranding 10 runners on base. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen tossed 5.0 hitless innings.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS AGO

Heading into play on Thursday, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 24 of their last 34 games (70.6 percent), including 19 contests with five tallies or more. Prior to this stretch, Jacksonville had plated four runs or more in just 30 of their first 63 games (47.6 percent). Perhaps the biggest reason for the increase in runs scored has been home runs; the Jumbo Shrimp rank tied for first in Triple-A with 54 home runs over the last 34 games. They swatted just 52 bombs over the first 63 games of the season, tied for 26th in Triple-A.

MARSEE-SAW

Heading into play on June 8, Jakob Marsee was hitting just .193 with a .651 OPS. Since that point, the Allen Park, Mich., native has registered hits in 26 of his 34 starts, including 13 contests with multiple hits. During this stretch, Marsee is 44-for-128 (.344/.437/.672/1.109 at the plate with eight doubles, two triples, 10 home runs, 23 RBIs, 22 walks and 25 runs. On the season, Marsee leads the IL in steals (43) and walks (63) while sharing the league lead in triples (5). He also ranks 18th in OBP (.383) and tied for 19th in both hits (82) and homers (13).

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry mustered just a .126 batting average and .452 OPS with 35 strikeouts through his first 33 games on the season. The former LSU Tiger has completely changed around his season since that point. Over his last 49 games. Berry has drawn more walks (25) than strikeouts (24) while going 46-for-149 (.309/.413/.477/.890) at the plate with 11 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 23 RBIs and 25 runs.

THE BOOK OF MORGAN

It took Jacksonville right-hander Morgan McSweeney 22.0 innings to finally allow his first tally with the Jumbo Shrimp, the best such streak for a Jacksonville pitcher since Sixto Sánchez went 24.0 consecutive scoreless frames from July 23-August 10, 2019. McSweeney has only yielded that lone run in 22.2 innings (0.40 ERA) thus far with Jacksonville. Among the 330 IL pitchers who have logged at least 20.0 innings this season, McSweeney has the fifth-lowest BABIP (.183), sixth-lowest swinging-strike rate (6.6 percent) and 16th-lowest line drive rate (16.9 percent).

THE MORE. THE MERRIER

In 2024, Jacksonville shattered the city's previous Double-A/ Triple-A era (1962-present) record of 20 different starting pitchers over the course of the season and used 28 different starters in 149 games. Meanwhile, through 97 games this season, the Jumbo Shrimp have already used 26 different starting pitchers. Perhaps unsurprisingly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have totaled just 380.1 innings (3.9 per start) this season, the sixth-fewest in Triple-A. That said, their 3.72 starters' ERA ranks third at the level.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD

With their starters working such a small amount of innings, Jacksonville's bullpen has been forced to shoulder the load throughout the 2025 campaign. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have worked 464.0, or 55.0 percent, of the club's 844.1 innings this season. Despite the huge workload, which marks tied for the fourth-most innings of any bullpen in Triple-A, Jacksonville relievers have posted the level's best ERA (3.74), while also leading Triple-A in BAA (.215).

In 30 games from May 10-June 21, Joe Mack went just 18-for-113 (.159) at the plate, totaling just a .428 OPS. The East Amherst, N.Y., native has been on an absolute tear over his last 19 games, however. During this stretch, Mack is a whopping 26-for-74 (.351/.385/.689/1.074) with seven doubles, six home runs, 11 RBIs, four walks and 13 runs.
