SUNDAY'S RECAP: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats won their fourth straight against the Harrisburg Senators on Sunday afternoon, winning 7-2 for their first home series win of the season. The Fisher Cats bullpen of **Andrew Bash, Luis Quinones, Gabriel Ponce, Jimmy Burnette and Parker Caracci** combined for 6.1 shutout innings of relief, allowing just two hits while striking out eight. **Will Robertson** opened the scoring in the first by grounding into a fielder's choice, his fourth RBI of the series. Trailing 2-1 in the sixth, **PK Morris** tied the score with an RBI single grounded off Harrisburg pitcher Tim Cate's leg. Next batter later, **Kekai Rios** gave the Fisher Cats the lead with an RBI groundout to second while **Sebastian Espino** drove in Morris for an insurance run with a single to right to make the score 4-2 after the sixth. **Steward Berroa** put the game away with a three-run home run to right-center in the eighth, his third home run of the year.

SHUTTING DOWN THE SENATORS: In the six-game series against the Senators, Fisher Cat relievers did not allow a single run, amounting to 23.2 shutout innings. On Friday and Saturday, the Fisher Cats posted back-to-back shutouts, which last occurred in 2019. The last time back-to-back shutouts were recorded was Aug. 14 & 15, 2019. The Fisher Cats have punched out 38 combined hitters in the last three games.

ON-BASE PALMEGIANI: IF **Damiano Palmegiani** is at the top of the Eastern League leaderboard in on-base percentage. The corner infielder is getting on-base at a .430 clip, second-best in the league. The Blue Jays No. 29 prospect is second in the Eastern League in walks (22). He has more walks than hits (18). Palmegiani has reached base in an impressive 21 of 24 games played this season and has walked in 17 games.

HIS NAME IS LEONARDO: IF **Leo Jimenez** has reached base in all 15 games played so far this season. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect has the longest active hit streak on the team (six games) and has collected a hit in 13 of 15 games played while playing solid defense up the middle at shortstop and second base.

WILLING US TO VICTORY: In the last three games, **Will Robertson** has driven in the first Fisher Cat runs of the game in each of the last three wins. His two-run home run in the fourth on Friday proved to be the difference and his go-ahead sac-fly in the eighth on Saturday was the only run needed. His RBI fielder's choice on Sunday opened the scoring for New Hampshire in the series finale victory. He has four RBIs in his last three games after collecting only three RBIs the entire month of April.

GREAT TO HAVE ZACH BACK: Ever since being activated off the injured list on Apr. 25, **Zach Britton** has been feasting on opposing pitching during the 12-game homestand. The catcher/outfielder hit .409 (9-for-22) with two doubles and two steals in eight games. Britton has also walked in eight consecutive games and had more walks than strikeouts during this stretch (11 BB/5 K).

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (May 9, 2008)- Fisher Cats 12 Rock Cats 11- The Fisher Cats scored three times in the bottom of the eighth to pick up the wild win. Scott Campbell delivered the two-run single that proved to be the game-winner. Each team had 15 hits. Ryan Klosterman and Kyle Phillips had four hits each for New Hampshire, and Campbell finished 3-for-5 with 5 RBIs.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (21-14) won 10-1 against Pittsburgh to sweep the Pirates on Sunday. They continue their road trip with a two-game set in Philadelphia....Triple-A Buffalo (13-20) took only one of six at Worcester last week. They host Syracuse this week....High-A Vancouver (14-9) won five of six at Hillsboro. They host Everett this week....Class A Dunedin (15-12) won five of six at Fort Myers and will host Clearwater this week.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats continue their road trip at Reading for a six-game series against the Fightin Phils'. The next home stand for New Hampshire begins on Tue. May 16 when they host the Binghamton Rumble Ponies for a six-game set.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss last Wednesday against Harrisburg. Allowed four runs in five innings in a 4-0 loss. He allowed four hits, walked four, and struck out four.

v. READING: Made three 2022 starts against the Fightin Phils, winning on July 15 at Reading 1-0. Pitched a career-high 6.2 innings in that start, one of two quality starts for Schultz last year.

2023: Did not allow a run in first start at Altoona 4/7, and allowed only one run in follow-up start vs. Portland 4/14. Matched career-high with 9 K's in loss to Hartford 4/26.

2022: His 20 starts led the 2022 Fisher Cats, as did his 99 strikeouts..Struck out season-high 9 with 5.2 scoreless vs. Richmond 8/3...Earned a win in first NH appearance on 4/10 in Portland...On Fisher Cats Opening Day Roster – 2nd year in Blue Jays system.

2021: Spent the entire season in the rotation for Adv. A Vancouver, making 21 starts. Went a career-best six innings five times. Struck out 114 in 102.1 innings, including nine batters twice in June against Eugene. Did allow 108 hits and 45 walks with a 1.50 WHIP.

2019: Appeared in nine games (one start), working 23.1 innings for the Rocky Mountain Vibes (Rookie League).

Career/Personal Notes: Earned Academic All-WAC honors for the third time. Tied a Utah Valley single-season record with 99 strikeouts in 2019. Struck out 11 batters in a game against South Carolina. Prepped at Orem (Utah) High School. As a senior in 2016 named first-team All-State after going 11-1 with a 2.90 ERA. Also batted .426 with 11 doubles and 31 RBIs.

Obtained: Selected by the Brewers in the 14th round of 2019 draft (Utah Valley). The Blue Jays acquired Schultz from the Brewers 5/2/21. The move completed a past move between the two clubs, as Schultz was the player to be named later in a February trade that saw Derek Fisher head to Milwaukee.

LHP Jimmy Robbins will start tomorrow night. 25-year old makes his sixth start of the season. 20-th round pick of the Blue Jays in 2019 (Rollins College) 1 start vs. Reading in 2022 – 5 scoreless to win 9/11 at Reading (5-0).
