DURHAM BULLS (7-12) vs MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (10-9)

RHP EASTON MCGEE vs RHP CONNOR THOMAS

TODAY'S GAME

The Bulls are back in action on Wednesday against the Redbirds for game two of a six-game series. Durham is looking to bounce back from Tuesday's loss in game one of the series. RHP **Easton McGee** is anticipated to get the nod for the Bulls, while LHP **Connor Thomas** is expected to start for the Redbirds.

LAST TIME OUT

The Bulls fell to the Redbirds 10-0 in game one, where the team struggled to get any offense. Memphis hit four home runs and racked up 15 hits for the game as, 1B **Juan Yopez**, RF **Conner Capel**, CF **Ben DeLuzio** and SS **Evan Mendoza** all had three hits in the contest, with DeLuzio smashed 2 home runs. CF **Ryan Boldt** for the Bulls had two hits, and the team had five hits for the game. Redbirds starter **Zack Thompson** (6.2 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 9 K) earned the win with 6.2 outstanding frames, while Bulls righty **Robert Dugger** (4.0 IP, 7 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 1 BB, 3 K) suffered the defeat.

BULLS vs. REDBIRDS

Durham & Memphis square off for the 1st time this season in a 6-game series. The Bulls last year won 9 of 12 matchups against the Redbirds, including 4 of their 6 meetings at Durham Bulls Athletic Park. The 2 teams also began their respective seasons against each other last year, marking the 1st time the 2 clubs have faced each other in the regular season. Durham defeated the Redbirds 5-4 in the 2009 Triple-A National Championship Game, in addition to a 5-3 victory in the 2017 Triple-A National Championship Game, while Memphis beat the Bulls 14-4 in the 2018 Triple-A National Championship Game. INF/OF **Vidal Brujan** last season hit .422 (19-45) with 13 runs, 4 doubles, 4 homers & 12 RBI in 11 games against the Redbirds, while INF/OF **Miles Mastrobuoni** batted .316 (6-19) in 6 matchups with Memphis in 2021.

BULL-ET POINTS

- OF **Ryan Boldt** has tallied at least 1 hit in 6 of his last 7 contests with Durham after posting at least 1 knock in just 2 of his 1st 5 tilts with the Bulls.
- Following yesterday's defeat, the Bulls have lost each of their 4 series-opening contests this year.
- Durham has posted a 5-2 mark when scoring 1st, compared to a 2-10 clip when their opponents strike 1st.
- The Bulls are 7-3 when leading after 6 innings, compared to an 0-9 mark when trailing at that point.
- Since being caught in 3 of their 1st 7 stolen base attempts this year, Durham baserunners have been successful in 14 of their most recent 16 tries dating back to 4/10
- Bulls relievers have pitched 114.0 of the squad's 164.1 total innings so far in 2022, equaling 69.3% of those total frames.

IT'S QUIET...TOO QUIET...

Yesterday's 10-0 defeat to Memphis marked the 3rd time in 19 games this season the Bulls have failed to score a run. Those 3 shutout losses are tied for the most among Triple-A squads alongside Gwinnett & Sacramento. Durham was shut out in just 5 games all of last season, with their 3rd shutout loss not coming until their 68th game of the season on 7/23/21 versus Charlotte.

MILES & MILES OF HITS

INF/OF **Miles Mastrobuoni** has recorded hits in 6 of his last 7 contests dating back to 4/16. In that span he owns a .400 average (12-30), adding 5 runs, 3 doubles, 1 homer & 9 RBI, along with 2 steals. That stretch also includes 5 multi-hit efforts, including 3 straight from 4/22-24. Mastrobuoni has raised his 2022 batting average 106 points from .171 to .277 in that time frame. He has also totaled 12 hits over his last 7 games after recording 6 over his 1st 9 contests combined.

OH SNAP

INF **Jonathan Aranda** saw his team-best 6-game hit streak snapped in yesterday's defeat. During that stretch, Aranda hit .444 (11-25) with 5 runs, 4 doubles, 1 homer & 8 RBI, posting 4 multi-hit efforts. Aranda in 18 contests with Durham this year has recorded 8 games with 2 or more hits, leading the team in that category.

WALK THIS WAY

OF **Cal Stevenson** enters play today having drawn 15 walks this season, which ranks tied for 2nd-most among International League players. Only Columbus' **Mitchell Tolman** (18) has recorded more bases on balls than Stevenson. Stevenson's walk percentage of 29.4% ranks 2nd among all MiLB players according to FanGraphs, behind only Single-A Tampa's **Anthony Garcia** (32.2%). Stevenson has reached base via a hit or walk in 21 of his 51 plate appearances, good for a .420 OBP.

A RARE OCCURRENCE

INF **Isaac Paredes** yesterday failed to record a hit for just the 3rd time in his 16 games with Durham this year. He enters play today T-6th in the International League with 10 extra-base hits, in addition to ranking T-7th in doubles (6), T-8th in RBI (15) & T-9th in total bases (35). He was acquired by Tampa Bay just before the regular season began from Detroit in exchange for former Bulls OF **Austin Meadows** & optioned to Durham.

GOOD KNIGHT

RHP **Dusten Knight** has not allowed a hit in each of his 1st 6 outings with Durham this year, and is a perfect 2-for-2 in save situations. He has faced 21 batters this year & only 3 have reached base, all via a walk. Knight has also struck out 10 of those 21 batters, meaning just 8 of 21 Triple-A batters that have faced Knight this year have put the ball in play.

LAST TIME OUT: McGee did not factor in the final decisions on 4/16 versus Jacksonville after allowing 4 earned runs on 8 hits in 4.0 innings of work, adding no walks while striking out 1 batter. The right-hander threw 71 pitches (50 strikes) in the Bulls' 13-5 defeat to the Jumbo Shrimp.
