Sacramento River Cats (37-24) vs. Sugar Land Space Cowboys (27-36)

MAKING IT RAIN: The River Cats won Sunday's game, 5-3, securing their fourth-straight series win...marked the first time they have won four-straight series since May/June 2024...the game took just two hours and six minutes, their shortest game time of the year and shortest since April 14, 2024 vs. El Paso (2:04)...marked the sixth time since 2009 Sacramento has had a game 2:06 or shorter...the Cats totaled 13 hits on the afternoon, hitting double-digit hits for the 34th time this year...they are now 27-7 when recording 10-plus hits...was their 26th game this season without recording a home run; they are now 9-17 in no-homer games...the Cats have knocked 48 doubles, three triples, and 18 home runs since May 20, totaling 65 extra-base-hits; the third most in Triple-A since that date, behind St. Paul (73), and Albuquerque (72)...Blade Tidwell was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed three runs on four hits with three walks and six strikeouts in 5.2 innings...went scoreless through five innings before allowing all three runs in the sixth...picked off Carson Taylor in the third, his second pickoff of the season (also, May 9)...is his first time with multiple pickoffs in a season since 2024 with Double-A Binghamton...threw his fifth wild pitch of the season in the sixth, he is one of 12 PCL pitchers to have five-plus wild pitches so far this season.

▶ Scott Bandura went 3-for-4 with an RBI single, his fifth three-hit game of the season and first with the River Cats...his last three-hit game was April 30 with Double-A Richmond...he is batting .279 (19-for-68) with four doubles, one home run, 10 RBI, four walks, two stolen bases, and a .701 OPS in 17 games with Sacramento.

▶ Will Brennan went 2-for-4, his 10th multi-hit game of the season and third in his last four games...he is batting .450 (9-for-20) with two doubles, one RBI, one walk, a .476 on-base percentage and a 1.026 OPS since rejoining the River Cats on June 2.

JUST HOW WE DREW IT UP: Drew Cavanaugh went 2-for-3...he has knocked 12 extra-base-hits since May 20, tied for the most in the PCL since that date...he is batting .411 (23-for-56) with seven doubles, five home runs, six walks, two stolen bases, an .804 slugging percentage and a 1.288 OPS in that span...marked his ninth multi-hit game with Sacramento...threw out Alejo Lopez at third, his sixth catcher-caught-stealing of the season, and third with the River Cats (also, May 23 and May 24).

SAVE FOR A RAINY DAY: Sacramento won Saturday's game, 7-4, securing at least a split on the series...Scott Bandura went 2-for-4 with two doubles, marked his first extra-base-hit since May 28 at Reno...was his fifth multi-extra-base-hit game of the season, and first with the River Cats...he is batting .250 (26-for-64) with four doubles, one home run, nine RBI, four walks, two stolen bases, and a .653 OPS in 16 games with Sacramento...Nate Furman (0-for-4) did not hit, ending his 13-game hitting streak.

▶ Carson Whisenhunt was the starter and earned the win, his third consecutive winning decision...allowed two runs on four hits, with one walk and 10 strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings...threw 99 pitches, just one short of his Triple-A career high...10 punches tied his Triple-A career-high (done 2x previously in 2024)...he has totaled 72 strikeouts on the season, putting him in sole possession of first place in Triple-A, and T-5th in all of the minor leagues...he is the second PCL pitcher to record a 10 strikeout game this season (also, Josh Stephan, May 5)...allowed his second home run of the season (also, April 22 vs. ABQ).

▶ Michael Fulmer earned his sixth save of the season...threw 1.0 scoreless inning, allowing one hit and fanning three batters...his six saves are second most in the PCL, behind Albuquerque's TJ Shook (7).

WHAT UP I'M JARED: Jared Oliva began his major league rehab assignment on May 30...joined the River Cats on rehab after being placed on the 10-day IL on April 15, and transferred to the 60-day IL on April 29 due to a left wrist hamate fracture...on May 31, he went 1-for-3 with a leadoff double in the first...was the 14th leadoff extra-base-hit of his career, and first since he hit a leadoff homer on May 3, 2019 with Double-A Altoona...marked his first back-to-back games with an extra-base-hit since August 24 and 26 last season.

▶ On Sunday, Oliva went 1-for-4 with a walk...he is batting .292 (7-for-24) with three doubles, four RBI, one walk, three stolen bases, a .417 slugging percentage, and a .725 OPS in seven games with Sacramento on MLB rehab.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL(KINSON), THERE'S A WAY: Southpaw Matt Wilkinson is set to take the mound for tonight's series opener at Sugar Land...Wilkinson was acquired on May 9 from Cleveland in exchange for catcher Patrick Bailey...was promoted to the River Cats on June 2 from Double-A Richmond alongside LHP Joe Whitman.

▶ Made his Triple-A debut on June 3 vs. Tacoma where he was dealt the loss, his third of the season...allowed two runs on one hit, with a career-high-tying four walks and two strikeouts in 1.1 innings...marked the second shortest outing of his career.

▶ In nine starts at Double-A between the Akron RubberDucks and Richmond Flying Squirrels, Wilkinson has gone 3-2, posting a 1.87 ERA (43.1 IP, 9 ER) with two home runs, 13 walks and 49 strikeouts.

BOYS IN THE BIGS: Last night, the Giants were defeated by the Washington Nationals 4-3...Bryce Eldridge went 2-for-4 with a double that gave San Francisco a 2-1 lead before the Nats scored two in the ninth to go up 4-3, and Eldridge struck out swinging in the bottom of the ninth to end the game with the tying run on third and winning run on first...five batters and three pitchers are currently on the major league roster, here is a look at their stats:

AN HONOR AND A PRIVILEGE: On June 2, Minor League Baseball announced the Player and Pitcher of the Month Award winners for May:

▶ Carson Whisenhunt earned the honor for the Triple-A Pacific Coast League...Whisenhunt went 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA in six starts in the month of May, as he allowed 10 earned runs on 28 hits and 11 walks over 32.0 innings...he led the league in strikeouts (32) and hits allowed per nine innings (7.88) and was second in ERA (2.81) and WHIP (1.22)...he was one of two pitchers in the league with over 18.0 innings of work that did not surrender a home run.

▶ Joe Whitman earned the honor for the Double-A Eastern League...Whitman went 3-0 with a 0.96 ERA in five starts with the Flying Squirrels as he allowed three earned runs on 14 hits and five walks while striking out 37 over 28.0 innings...he led the league in ERA (0.96), strikeouts (37), WHIP (0.68), average against (.146), hits allowed per nine innings (4.5) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.89)...he began the month with a 23.0 inning scoreless streak before being tagged with three runs in his final start of the month.
