Cameron Masterman drilled his 4th home run of the season to aid the winning cause.

Why the Locos: The Lugnuts chose their Copa de la Diversión identity in translating the fans' "Let's go Nuts!" rallying cry to "¡Vamos Locos!" The potoo bird, as loco as an animal can be, is the logo.

**Division Outlook:** With nine games remaining in the first half, Lansing trails division-leading Lake County by four games and second-place Great Lakes by three games. Only the top team in each division clinches a playoff berth; if the season ended today, therefore, Lake County and West Division-leading Wisconsin would scan their postseason tickets.

**Prospecting:** The Locos boast five MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 25), southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 28) and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 30).

**Past Performance No Guarantee of Future Results:** Lansing has not won a season series against Cedar Rapids since 2012. Since then, then the Locos have gone 0-3, 0-3, 1-2, 1-2, 1-2, 1-2, 1-2, 2-4, 2-4, and – last year – 3-9 vs. the Kernels.

**Team Effort:** The Locos are 2nd in the Midwest League in batting average (.258), 2nd in runs scored (309), 2nd in hits (491), 1st in total bases (765), 1st in doubles (100), 1st in triples (27), 2nd in RBIs (282), 3rd in walks (254), tied for 2nd in OBP (.352), 1st in slugging (.402) and 2nd in team OPS (.754).

Individual Efforts: Henry Bolte is tied for 1st in runs scored (49), 1st in doubles (15), tied for 1st in triples (5), 2nd in extra-base hits (28), 2nd in total bases (110), tied for 2nd in RBIs (43), 4th in base hits (61), tied for 4th in steals (22), 4th in slugging (.521), 5th in OPS (.924), and tied for 9th in walks (33). Brayan Buelvas is tied for 1st in triples (5), tied for 3rd in extra-base hits (24), 5th in runs scored (39), tied for 5th in doubles (13), tied for 6th in total bases (94), 8th in walks (34), tied for 9th in steals (15) and tied for 8th in RBIs (36). Euribiel Ángeles is tied for 2nd in RBIs (43), tied for 4th in triples (4), tied for 5th in base hits (60) and tied for 10th in total bases (91).

**No Relief For the Opponent:** The Lansing offense is slashing .248/.319/.396, a .715 OPS against starting pitchers, 4th-best in the Midwest League, while slashing .269/.382/.408 for a league-leading .790 OPS against relief pitchers (the second-best MWL team is Great Lakes, at .735).

**Welcome to the Show:** Southpaw **Brady Basso**, who pitched for the Nuts in 2021, underwent Tommy John, and returned successfully last season, became the third former Lansing player this season to reach the Majors on May 31 (joining **Max Schuemann** and **Brett Harris**). Brady is the 187th Major League Lugnut in franchise history.

### **Today in Lugnuts History**

**2012:** Carlos Pérez went 0-for-3 with two walks, ending his 18-game home hitting streak, the longest in the Midwest League all year, as the Lugnuts beat Lake County, 7-1, thanks to six runs in the 1st inning. Starter Justin Nicolino pitched four shutout innings and struck out six. Future Major Leaguer Francisco Lindor was 2-for-5 for the Captains in the loss; Lake County had nine walks and eight hits, but stranded 14 runners.

**2018:** The Lugnuts clinched a ticket to the postseason, their 14th in 23 years as a franchise, with a 4-2 victory at the Fort Wayne TinCaps. Starter Colton Laws tossed five scoreless innings in the win. The Nuts have not made the playoffs since 2018.
