WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

High-A Wilmington put an end to a two-game skid with an 11-6 win over Jersey Shore (PHI) last night...CF **YEREMY CABRERA** homered and tripled to extend his hitting streak to four games.

WEDNESDAY'S ARE FOR THE WINGS: The Rochester Red Wings bounced back with a 6-3 victory over the Buffalo Bisons on a hot Wednesday afternoon, evening the series at one game a piece...RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** hit two solo home runs on the afternoon, with one coming in a second inning that saw the Red Wings hit three home runs on four pitches...a collective effort on the mound for seven Rochester arms resulted in RHP **JACK SINCLAIR'S** sixth victory of the season...the Red Wings look to take a series lead in game three of the six-game set tonight, sending RHP **JACK CEBERT** to the mound for his Triple-A debut...Buffalo will counter with 24-year-old right-hander John Klein...

- Yesterday marked the first time since at least 2004 that the Red Wings homered four times in a game where they logged no more than six hits.
- Rochester now has 77 wins, tied for their most in a season (77 in '22) since they won 80 games in 2017.

JACKED UP: Making his highly anticipated Triple-A debut tonight will be Nationals No. 14 prospect (MLB.com) RHP **JACK CEBERT**...the 24-year-old Florida native was acquired by Washington from New York-AL on 8/3 as part of the Luis Garcia Jr. trade...he was assigned to Double-A Harrisburg prior to the trade, where he logged a 2.70 ERA (3 ER/10.0 IP) across three starts which included a six-strikeout performance across 4.0 scoreless innings in his organizational debut on 8/9...Cebert enters tonight's start with 99.0 career innings in his professional career...

- Since 7/1, the right-hander has posted a 2.05 ERA with 37 strikeouts and just 19 hits allowed across 30.2 innings.

PINEDA COLADA: RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** connected on a pair of solo homers in last night's victory, going 2-for-3...it marked his second career multi-homer game and first since 5/2/2023 with High-A Jersey Shore (PHI)...the Valencia, Venezuela native has picked up five multi-hit performances over his last 10 games since 8/15, boasting a .371/.450/.743 slash line with four homers, a double, eight RBI and 11 runs scored over that stretch...he now has 11 total homers this season across Double and Triple-A, including eight with Rochester in just 24 games, which ties his career-high set in 2024...

- Across six day games with the Red Wings, Pineda is hitting .389 (7-for-18) with four homers, a triple, and a 1.167 SLG.

WALL TO WALL(ACE): 2B **CAYDEN WALLACE** put together his fourth consecutive multi-hit performance for the first time in his professional career last night, going 2-for-3 with a homer, a double, a walk, and a run scored...the home run came off the bat at 104.1 MPH and traveled 422 feet, the furthest of the Red Wings four home runs in the contest...the Arkansas native is hitting .314 (27-for-86) across 21 games in August, with 13 XBH (5 HR, 3B, 7 2B), 17 RBI, a .593 SLG, and .865 OPS...across the full season with both Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg, Wallace ranks second among all Nationals Minor Leaguers with 25 total homers, 126 hits, 52 XBH, and 232 total bases...he trails teammate **TREY LIPSCOMB** in all four categories...he is now one of 22 players with at least 25 homers at the Double and Triple-A levels this season...

- Six of his seven Triple-A homers have traveled at least 400 feet (398 ft. on 8/18 at OMA).

QUEST OFF THE RECORD BOOK: The Red Wings used three long balls to score four of their six runs in the second inning alone yesterday...2B **CAYDEN WALLACE** and RF **LEANDRO PINEDA** went back-to-back on just two pitches, CF **SAM PETERSEN** laced a first-pitch single and DH **LIOVER PEGUERO** smoked a two-run shot on the very next pitch to give the Red Wings three home runs on just four pitches...it marks the second time since at least 2004 that Rochester has done so, with the only other time coming on 6/5/2021 at WOR...it also marks the eighth time since '04 that the Red Wings have homered at least three times in an inning (last 5/30/25 vs. COL)...Wallace's homer to kick things off extended the Red Wings streak to 19 consecutive games with a home run, which is the longest streak by an International League team since Louisville went deep in 24-straight in 2024, and the Red Wings longest since at least 2004...Rochester has also notched an extra-base hit in 73 consecutive games dating back to 5/29, the longest active streak in professional baseball and Rochester's first time doing so since 2008 (85 G, 5/19-8/16)...

- The Red Wings now have a total of 171 homers in 2026, three shy of their franchise record of 174 set in 2019...they also have 49 homers in August, tied for their most in a month since at least 2004 (49 in July 2019).
- Peguero's homer was his first as a Red Wing, and second of 2026 (5/31 at BUF, with LHV).

JUST WINGIN' IT: Seven different Red Wings pitchers combined to hold Buffalo to two earned runs in yesterday's victory...rehabbing southpaw DJ **HERZ** kicked things off with 2.0 one-hit innings while allowing an unearned run in his first appearance in Rochester since 2024...RHP **BEN GRABLE**, who was acquired from New York-AL as part of the Luis Garcia Jr. trade, made his Triple-A debut in the fourth inning...the California native turned in a scoreless frame and became the 71st player to suit up for the Red Wings in 2026...RHP **JACK SINCLAIR** picked up the win after tossing 2.0 clean innings on one hit with three strikeouts, his sixth of the season to tie a career-high (6 in 2022)...RHP **GUS VARLAND** locked down the ninth and picked up his fifth save with Rochester (all in August, most in the IL)...since returning from the All-Star Break on 7/17, Red Wings pitchers lead all Triple-A teams and rank second in full-season MiLB with a 3.47 ERA (118 ER/306.0 IP)...they have also allowed the fewest earned runs (118) in the IL over that stretch, third-fewest in full-season MiLB.

- Slated to make his Triple-A debut tonight, becoming the 72nd Red Wing to suit up for the club in 2026...made three starts with Double-A Harrisburg following the trade on 8/3 until his call-up to Rochester on 8/25...allowed three earned over 10.0 innings of work (2.70 ERA) with 13 strikeouts.
- Since 7/1, boasts a 2.05 ERA with 37 strikeouts and 17 hits across 30.2 innings, with a 1.21 WHIP and .171 BAA.
- Enters tonight with 99.0 professional innings and 120 strikeouts.
- Ranked as the Nationals No. 14 prospect (MLB.com)...has made 17 starts (19 G) this season between High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset (both NYY) and Harrisburg...has gone 4-4 with a 3.88 ERA and 109 strikeouts in 92.2 innings, with a 1.21 WHIP and 3.41 K/BB.

Entering his sixth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after signing as a Minor League free agent on 3/31/2026... originally selected by New York-AL in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Southern California...named Texas League Pitcher of the Week with Northwest Arkansas on 5/19/2024 and 7/30/2023...named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week with Quad City on May 7, 2023.

- Ranks second among qualified International League pitchers in WHIP (1.07), and ERA (3.82), fourth in BAA (.238), and fifth in innings pitched (110.2) and winning percentage (.583).
- Picked up his sixth win of the season and 30th of his professional career on 7/11 at Worcester, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth before finishing with 6.0 full innings, one hit, and one earned run while striking out three and walking two.
- Across four Saturday games this season (3 GS), the 27-year-old is 2-0 with a 2.75 ERA (6 ER/19.2 IP), a 0.56 WHIP, .138 BAA, and a BB/9 of 0.92.
- Recorded 500th career strikeout on 6/9 vs. Worcester.
- Made his 100th career start in game two of a doubleheader on 4/17 vs. Buffalo.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 4/4 before appearing in a game.
- Made 29 appearances (25 GS) with Triple-A Omaha in 2025...went 4-9 with a 7.84 ERA (204 ER/119.1 IP), while compiling 100 strikeouts against 51 walks...ranked second among all Royals Minor League pitchers in games started, fourth in innings pitched, and T-9th in strikeouts.
- Finished the season with three consecutive scoreless appearances in relief, combining to allow four hits with six strikeouts and no walks across 6.0 innings

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Christian University.

- Optioned to Rochester on 8/4 after pitching 10.5 innings for the Nationals since his recall to the team on 6/29...allowed just one hit in his last four appearances with Washington.
- Since returning to the mound for Rochester on 8/4, the right-hander has tossed 11.2 innings across six appearances, only allowing one earned run (0.77 ERA), striking out 21 with three walks.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Currently owns the 12th-best K/9 (13.86) in full season MiLB (min. 50.0 IP).
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Began the 2025 season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23, and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).
- Across seven appearances (6 GS) from 6/8-7/27 with Double-A Harrisburg, allowed just five earned across 39.2 innings (1.13 ERA) while holding batters to a .163 BAA.
