RIDERS EXPLODE LATE FOR 9-4 VICTORY OVER AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored five runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to anchor a 9-4 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles Wednesday night from Riders Field. The RoughRiders (8-3) struck first when **Alejandro Osuna** hit a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the third and **Abimelec Ortiz** hit a solo home run in the bottom of the fourth to make it 2-0. Ortiz's lead-off blast was his 19th with the RoughRiders. In the top of the sixth, the Sod Poodles (2-9) responded with RBI singles by Gavin Conticello and Andy Weber to tie the game at two. With the bases loaded in the bottom of the seventh, **Josh Hatcher** and Ortiz drew back-to-back walks to secure a 4-2 RoughRiders lead. The RoughRiders then blew the game open with a five-run bottom of the eighth inning. **Ian Moller** and Ortiz ripped RBI singles, **Sebastian Walcott** served a two-run single into center and Hatcher hit a sacrifice fly. The four RoughRiders combined to drive in eight of Frisco's nine runs. Despite two runs from the Sod Poodles in the top of the ninth inning, the RoughRiders secured their sixth win in the last seven games. RoughRiders reliever **Gavin Collyer** (3-0) earned his third victory of the season, tossing two scoreless innings. Sod Poodles reliever Logan Clayton (0-1) picked up the loss, allowing two runs in 1.1 innings. Frisco starter **Kohl Drake** twirled five shutout innings, allowing just one hit while striking out six on 63 pitches (47 strikes).

NO PROBLEM IN THE NINE HOLE:

RoughRiders nine-hole hitters have been fantastic to start the team. Through 11 games, players batting ninth are slashing .316/.413/.553/.966. **Tucker Mitchell** and **Luis Mieses** have led the charge, collectively hitting two homers from the nine spot. Their 7-8-9 batters have a combined batting average of .266 (29-for-109).

BANGFORD IS BACK:

Rangers outfielder Wyatt Langford begin his rehab assignment on Thursday. Langford hit .244/.333/.561/.894 with four home runs and six RBI in 12 games with Texas before being placed on the 10-Day Injured List with a right oblique strain on April 10th. At the time of his injury, Langford ranked tied for sixth in the American League in home runs (4) and 11th in slugging percentage (.561).

HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he has reached safely in all nine games he's played in, batting .463 (19-for-41)/.465/.756/1.221 with three doubles, three home runs, nine RBIs, a stolen base and eight runs scored over his first nine games. His 19 hits are the most among Double-A, High-A and Low-A players and tied for 19th in all of MiLB. His .463 batting average is fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. Hatcher already has six multi-hit games and is 6-for-7 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs. Hatcher's 18 hits were the most by a Texas Leaguer through the first eight team games since five-year Major Leaguer Jesus Guzman had 19 with Midland in 2008.

POWER BRINGS WINS:

The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been amazing on offense during their first 11 games. Frisco's 14 home runs through 11 games are second in the Texas League. They are tied for second in BA (.279), second in SLG (.453) and second in OPS (.832). **Josh Hatcher** and **Copper Johnson** have both hit three home runs, tied for the league lead.

VERSUS THE SOD POODLES:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 16-8 against Amarillo and showed off their offensive might against the Diamondbacks affiliate. The Riders as a team hit .292/.351/.494/.845 with 37 home runs in 24 games. Their 37 homers were the most against a single team since 2022, when they hit 47 in 18 games against Amarillo. **Keyber Rodriguez** crushed them in 16 games, batting .367/.433/.617/1.050 with 19 RBIs. **Josh Hatcher** (seven) and **Abimelec Ortiz** (six) both bashed six or more homers against the Sod Poodles as well.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz clubbed his first home run of the season on Wednesday.

WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:

The RoughRiders have nine players in MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30 Prospects rankings to start 2025. **Sebastian Walcott** (No. 1) headlines the bunch and is the only member of the top 100 as well (No. 17). On the mound, **Winston Santos** (No. 5), **Kohl Drake** (No. 13), **Mitch Bratt** (No. 21) and **Josh Stephan** (No. 22) all slot into the starting rotation while **Skyler Hales** (No. 25) will work from the bullpen. On offense, outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** (No. 8) and first baseman/outfielder **Abimelec Ortiz** (No. 14) round out the nine players.



ABOUT JOSH

-Attended South Grand Prairie High School, going 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA, striking out 20 over 14 innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Alabama, and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate the new contract.

2025 SEASON

-Enters into 2025 in the 5th spot in the rotation.

2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Made only relief appearance of the season on 7/9 vs. NWA, coming out of the bullpen behind MLB rehabber Tyler Mahle.

2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.
