**THE SURGE** – The Wichita Wind Surge wrap up their first ever series with the sixth game of the series tonight. Wichita clinched a series win with last night's victory, leading the series 4-1. Wichita leads the division by one game over NW Arkansas.

**LAST NIGHT** – The Wind Surge hit attack had eight of the nine batters in the line-up with at least a hit and four with multi-hit performances in a 9-3 victory in Springfield. Zach Neff pitched 2.2 innings and earned his second win of the season.

**ON THE HILL** – Josh Winder is set to make his second start of the season. In his debut on Tuesday he pitched 4.2 innings, allowed no runs on five hits and punched out six in a no-decision. Wichita won the game 2-0 as Winder combined with four pitchers on the shutout.

**AGAINST THE CARDINALS** – Wichita Wranglers and Springfield were both in the (AA) Texas League from 2005-2007, and Wichita won the all-time series 49-39. The Surge are 4-1 this season.

**RED HOT WHITEFIELD** – Surge outfielder Aaron Whitefield picked up his fifth multi-hit game in as many games. He is third in the league with a .455 batting average, tied for seventh with 5 RBI through the first five games of the season.

**SHUT EM DOWN** – Four Wind Surge pitchers dealt the first shutout in team history on May 4th. Surge hurlers punched out 14 Cardinals in the game. The Wind Surge hurlers followed up with a 15-strikeout performance on Wednesday evening and have 59 strikeouts this season, third most in AA Central.

**ROTATION COMPLETE** - All five Wichita starters have made a start and through five starts the rotation has no record, worked 18.1 innings, punched out 21 with a 4.91 ERA.

HIT PARADE – The Surge pounded out 14 hits last night and had four players with multi-hit games, Wichita leads the league with a .308 batting average and second on the circuit scoring 33 runs. The team has 20 extra base hits that lead the league.

REMEMBERING LOU – In memory of late Managing General Partner Lou Schwechheimer, who passed away in 2020 before seeing baseball played at Riverfront Stadium, the Surge will wear a "Lou" patch on their jerseys for the entire 2021 season. The patch, designed by well-known graphic designer Todd Radom, features Lou Schwechheimer with a corner of Riverfront Stadium in the background, and Lou's signature below.

**RIVERFRONT STADIUM** – The 90-million-dollar ballpark debut on April 10<sup>th</sup> when the Wichita State Shockers defeated Houston in front of 7,509 fans. The Wind Surge will take the diamond for the first time on May 11<sup>th</sup> against Amarillo.

**NOTES** – Wichita leads AA-Central with a .994 fielding percentage making just one error in their first five games.
