### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST SEASON:** Behind second-year manager Miguel Perez, the Indianapolis Indians' season was a tale of two halves in the International League's new regular-season format which pitted the first-half champion against the second-half champion in a best-of-three playoff series at the end of September. The Indians finished 70-78 overall, with a 33-41 record during the first half and 37-37 record in the second half. In the full-season standings, they finished tied with Gwinnett and Toledo for 12th in the 20-team International League, 19.5 games behind league-leading Norfolk. Their sub-.500 overall record marks Indy's fourth consecutive and ninth in 18 seasons as Pittsburgh's Triple-A affiliate dating back to 2005. In 74 games at Victory Field, the Indians went 37-37 for their first even .500 record at home since 2010 (36-36) and third since moving to the corner of West and Maryland in 1996.

**OPENING DAY:** The Indians begin the 2024 season on the road for the first time since 2021 after opening at home against Omaha in the past two seasons. In the Victory Field era, the Indians have opened their season on the road in 12 of 26 seasons and own a 5-7 record in those games. In 2021 at Iowa, their last opener on the road, the Indians blanked the I-Cubs, 3-0. Last season vs. Omaha, the Indians put up a five-spot in the first inning behind a two-run homer off the bat of Endy Rodriguez, RBI single by Malcom Nuñez and two-run double by Tucupita Marcano. The Storm Chasers then came back with four runs in the ninth inning, defeating the Indians 8-6 on their home turf.

**MARCHING IN:** The Indianapolis Indians are entering their 122nd season in franchise history, with the 28th campaign in Victory Field history beginning on Tuesday. Today, March 29, marks the earliest Opening Day in franchise history, narrowly besting last year's March 31st opener at Victory Field. The past two seasons have featured the first regular-season March games in the Indians illustrious history.

**PROSPECTUS:** Six prospects ranked among the Pirates top 30 (according to Baseball America) are slated to begin the season in Triple-A, led by right-hander Paul Skenes as the organization's No. 1 farmhand. Others include right-hander Quinn Priester (No. 8), infielder Nick Gonzales (No. 9), former Ball State (Muncie, Ind.) University right-hander Kyle Nicolas (No. 13), outfielder and Fishers, Ind. native Matt Gorski (No. 15), and right-hander Colin Selby (No. 30).

**THE TOP DOG:** Right-handed pitcher Paul Skenes, who is rated by the No. 3 prospect in Minor League Baseball, No. 1 in the Pirates organization and No. 1 among right-handed pitchers (according to MLB Pipeline) enters the season on Indy's Opening Day roster and is expected to make his Triple-A debut in Saturday's contest in Louisville. He was selected by the Pirates as the No. 1 overall pick in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft. Following a College World Series championship season at Louisiana State (Baton Rouge) University in which he was named the tournament's Most Outstanding Player, Skenes struck out 10 batters over 6.2 innings of professional ball with the FCL Pirates, Single-A Bradenton and Double-A Altoona.

**VETERAN PRESENCE:** Eleven members of Indy's Opening Day roster were signed by Pittsburgh as minor league free agents in the 2023-24 offseason, a group that is led by 2017 National League All-Star infielder Jake Lamb. Others include southpaws Brady Feigl, Eric Lauer and Michael Plassmeyer, right-handers Brent Honeywell, Kade McClure, Willy Peralta and Connor Sadzeck, infielder Sergio Alcántara and outfielders Gilberto Celestino and Dustin Peterson.

**LAMB CHOPS:** Leading the veteran group is 33-year-old infielder Jake Lamb, who was selected as NL All-Star during his 2017 campaign with Arizona, a season that also saw him named as the NL Player of the Week for the second time of his career on 5/22 and a four-hit performance during the NL Wild Card Game vs. Colorado. Across 10 years and over 700 games of big-league action, Lamb owns a .235 batting average (543-for-2309), 112 doubles, 96 home runs, 342 RBI and 7.3 bWAR.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE A BIG LEAGUER:** The Indians 2023 ace, right-handed pitcher Jared Jones, had his contract selected by the Pirates on 3/28 to officially add him to the big-league Opening Day roster. Jones, 22, will make his MLB debut on Saturday at Marlins Park as the Buccos continue their opening series vs. the Marlins. With Indianapolis last season, he went 4-5 with a 4.72 ERA (43er/82.0ip) and 99 strikeouts. Indianapolis sent 12 players to Pittsburgh for their major league debuts during the 2023 season, which is tied with 2016 for the most since Indianapolis became a Pirates affiliate in 2005.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians and Bats will kick off the 2024 International League season tonight at Louisville Slugger Field in a 7:15 PM ET first pitch. It is the first time the two teams have faced off to open the season since 1997, when the Aaron Boone-led Indians were defeated in Louisville on 4/3, 10-3. Last season, the Indians finished with a 13-5 record against Louisville while going 9-3 on the road. Leading Indianapolis on the mound will be LHP Michael Plassmeyer (0-0, ---), who was signed by the Pirates as a minor league free agent after spending the majority of the '23 season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley. Countering for the Bats will be RHP Carson Spiers (0-0, ---), who surrendered seven runs (six earned) in his lone career appearance vs. Indy on 9/2/22.

**ON THE MEND:** The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that right-handed relief pitcher Colin Holderman will begin a rehab assignment with the Indianapolis Indians as they open their 2024 season tonight at Louisville. Holderman is the first major league rehabber assigned to Indy this season. Holderman was placed on the 15-day injured list (illness) on March 28 (retroactive to March 25). He appeared in four spring contests from Feb. 28-March 12 and recorded eight strikeouts in 3.2 innings pitched. Holderman went 0-3 with a 3.86 ERA (24er/56.0ip) and 58 strikeouts in 58 appearances with Pittsburgh in 2023.

## TONIGHT'S STARTER

**Michael Plassmeyer:** The southpaw Plassmeyer will kick off the season for the Indians as their Opening Day starter tonight at Louisville.

**Against the Bats:** Plassmeyer has never faced Louisville.

**Walk It Off:** Of his 14 starts last season with Lehigh Valley, four ended in walk-off fashion – three in favor of the IronPigs. In those three team wins, two of which were come-from-behind victories, Plassmeyer was backed by 27 runs of support.

**2023:** Began the season with Triple-A Lehigh Valley and went 3-4 with a 5.05 ERA (38er/67.2ip) and 74 strikeouts in 16 games (14 starts). ... Struck out a season-high seven batters over 6.0 two-run innings on 4/21 vs. Worcester; matched that mark on 9/2 vs. Syracuse. ... Was placed on the 7-day injured list on 5/31 and was transferred to the 60-day IL on 7/25 with an undisclosed injury. ... Made three rehab starts with High-A Jersey Shore and allowed one run with nine strikeouts in 8.0 innings of work. ... Reinstated from the IL on 8/27 and went 2-0 with a 1.52 ERA (4er/23.2ip) and 27 strikeouts in his next five games (four starts) with Lehigh Valley. ... Made his final start of the season with Philadelphia on 9/30 (2) at New York (NL) and surrendered a career-high nine earned runs in 3.2 innings.

**Miscellaneous:** Selected by Seattle (4th round, 118th overall) in the 2018 First-Year Player Draft. ... Had his contract first selected by PHI on 8/22/22 and made his MLB debut on 8/23/22 vs. Cincinnati. ... Signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on 12/29/23.
