- The Blue Jays were walked off for the third time this week, 4-3 on Friday night in Fort Myers.
- After four scoreless innings from Fernando Perez for Dunedin and Ty Langenberg for the Mussels, Fort Myers struck first in the fifth. Angel Del Rosario, the former D-Jay, poked a two-out, two-RBI single to make it 2-0.
- Fort Myers tacked on another run in the sixth to chase Perez from the game.
- Dunedin got within one in the eighth, as Victor Arias ripped an RBI triple and scored on a throwing error in the following plate appearance.
- The Jays loaded the bases with no outs to open the ninth, and scored as Maykel Minoso rolled into a double play, but couldn't pull ahead. That cost Dunedin in the bottom half, as Maddux Houghton drove a pinch hit, RBI double to end the game with one out.

HEARTBREAKERS

Last night's walk-off double from Maddux Houghton was the Blue Jays' third walk-off defeat this week, as Byron Chourio's sac fly in the 11th won the game on Wednesday, and Jose Rodriguez's grand slam ended the game in the ninth on Tuesday. Half of Dunedin's 10 road losses have come in walk-off fashion. The Blue Jays have just one walk-off win.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

16 of the Blue Jays' last 19 contests have been decided by four or fewer runs, including last night's 4-3 defeat. Dunedin has gone 4-12 in those games. All three Blue Jays losses this week have been decided by one run. Dunedin is 3-7 in one-run games in 2024.

STAYING UP LATE

Dunedin continued its trend of scoring late runs last night by scoring all three of its runs in the final two frames. The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in eight of their last nine games. 10 of the Blue Jays' 22 runs this week have come in the final three innings.

STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION

Blue Jays outfielder Jean Joseph is off to a strong start in Single-A, having reached in all 11 games he's played with Dunedin. The on-base streak is Dunedin's longest active streak and one of eight active double digit on base streaks in the FSL.

A CAVEMAN COULD DO IT

Nolan Perry is set to make his second start with the Blue Jays this evening after making his Single-A debut last Saturday. Perry was drafted out of Carlsbad HS (NM) in 2022 after winning New Mexico's Gatorade Player of the Year award and a state championship. Carlsbad's team mascot his the Cavemen.

WALKS GIVETH AND WALKS TAKETH AWAY

The Jays are second in the FSL in walks drawn with 151 (behind Tampa). However, Dunedin's pitching staff has walked the most batters in the league at 152.

FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Blue Jays slugger Cristian Feliz's current six-game on-base streak is his longest this season. Across his last 10 games, Feliz is hitting .235 with an .879 OPS.

ROCKY RELIEF

The Blue Jays bullpen has struggled across the last six games. In 25.1 innings, Dunedin relievers have allowed 21 earned runs (7.46 ERA). In the prior five games, the 'pen pitched to a 2.11 ERA (5 ER in 21.1 IP).

YOU AND YOURS VS ME AND MINE

As Blue Jays and Twins prospects square of in the Florida State League this weekend, the two big league clubs are in the midst of a three-game set in Toronto. After graduating Single-A, Blue Jays and Twins prospects don't square off again until International League play in AAA.

TRIPLE THE FUN

After a 2-4 outing Wednesday, Daniel Perez has four hits in Single-A. Three of them are triples.

YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.
