LAST TIME OUT

MOOSIC, PA (April 2, 2023) -The Scranton Wilkes/Barre RailRiders dropped the rubber match to the Buffalo Bisons 3-2 in extras innings on a chilly Sunday. Tied at one after the fifth, the Bisons were able to plate two in the tenth. Though the RailRiders drove in a run in the bottom half, it was just not enough in the matinee contest.

SWB got on the board first in the bottom of the fifth. Jake Bauers took a lead off walk and made his way to third on a pair of groundouts. Willie Calhoun looped a single into shallow left to drive home Bauers.

Buffalo countered immediately, tying things at one in the sixth. Davis Schneider doubled to reach and moved over on Addison Barger's base knock. Wynton Bernard singled him home for their first run.

Even with baserunners throughout the rest of the contest, neither team was able to plate a run sending the game into extras.

In the top of the tenth, Rafael Lantigua started the frame on second as the placed runner. Tanner Morris walked to put two on. When Davis Schneider laid down a sacrifice bunt the RailRiders nabbed for the lead runner at third. A two out double off the bat of Bernard gave Buffalo a 3-1 lead.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre didn't go down with a fight. Jamie Westbrook started the inning at second as the pace-of-play runner and scored on Oswald Peraza's line drive to left. A pop up ended the game with SWB falling 3-2.

Mitch Spence looked strong in his first outing of the season. The righty had five clean frames allowing just three hits. Spence walked three but induced three significant double plays. Matt Bowman was first out of the pen letting up one run on three hits. He walked a batter and struck one out. Greg Weissert and Nick Ramirez had clean outings.. Matt Krook (L, 0-1) was called upon for the tenth inning, the first extras of the summer. He let up two runs, one earned, on one hit and took the loss.

Bowden Francis got the start for Buffalo putting up a zero in four straight frames. Brandon Eisert (W, 1-0) picked up the win after pitching a quiet ninth with two strikes. Thomas Hatch (S, 1) allowed a run in the tenth but shut the door in time to earn the save.

NEWS & NOTES

SNELTEN STRONG - D.J. Snelten took the mound in a professional regular season game for the first time since 2018. He was drafted in the 9th round in 2013 by the San Francisco Giants. Snelten made his Major League debut on April 28, 2018 and went on to pitch just 4.1 innings in four appearances. He was signed by the Yankees in August of 2022 after playing in multiple organizations including independent ball. Last night manager Shelley Duncan needed him in a tight situation. He was called upon in the top of the ninth inning with the bases loaded and two outs. After falling behind in the count, he unleashed a heater to strike out Blue Jays prospect Cameron Eden to end the frame. Snelten is one of just four southpaws on Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's pitching staff.

BOOSTED BY BAUERS - Jake Bauers showed off his power on Opening Weekend with two homers and a double. He leads the team with a .444 average and three runs batted in. Bauers has totalled four hits and three walks. The lefty has played in all three games either in the outfield or as the designated hitter.

BEHIND THE PLATE - Rodolfo Duran, Mickey Gasper, and Jose Godoy open the season as new manager Shelley Duncan's options behind the plate. Godoy has big league time with both Minnesota and Pittsburgh. Duran and Gasper are set to make their Scranton/Wilkes-Barre debuts. Gasper is one of just five players on the roster drafted by the New York Yankees. So far they have split time as catcher with all three getting featured in one game on Opening Weekend.

SCRANTON SPEED - In three games the RailRiders have already stolen five bases. This ranks the team fifth in the International League behind Omaha with 10. Oswald Peraza has nabbed two, but has been caught once.. He even combined with Elijah Dunham for an elite double steal. Jake Bauers and Billy McKinney each have one as well. Jose Godoy was caught in a strike him out throw him out play.

ACTION PACKED - The RailRiders have played three games at PNC Field, two with rain delays and one with extra innings. The first delay came pregame on Opening Night with a 39 minute hold prior to first pitch. The game moved quickly after that wrapping up the full contest in two hours and twenty minutes. Saturday afternoon the game began on time but in the middle of the sixth inning the teams paused for an hour and forty one minutes. Actual playing time only totaled two hours and thirty two minutes. On Sunday, Buffalo and SWB were tied at one after nine innings. Even with having play a tenth frame, the game was just two hours and thirty nine minutes long.

BULLPEN MAGIC - The bullpen has kept it strong in the opening games holding down just a 1.06 earned run average. With eight relievers having having seventeen innings of work they've combined for just eleven hits and two earned runs. Seven walks have been issued with 19 total strikeouts. The bullpen has kept the opposition to a .180 batting average while taking one win and one save. Two relievers, Nick Ramirez, and Greg Weissert, have had multiple appearances and still have a scoreless ERA.

DOUBLE DOUBLE - Mitch Spence and his defense turned three double plays in Sunday's contest. Jamie Westbrook led the charge at second base having a hand in all of them. The first he stepped on the bag and tossed to first and the second he caught a line drive and doubled up the runner on second. The final was a 5-4-3 going from Chaparro to Westbrook covering second to Bauers at first. The team ranks third in all of Triple-A with five double plays turned in three games.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Oswald Peraza (#3 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) alongside outfielder Elijah Dunham (#18). Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle, (#29) will both be essential parts of the pitching staff. Peraza made his big league debut at the end of last season and even aided the Yankees in their postseason race.

ATOP THE FARM: Sean Boyle stacks up well against the other pitchers in the Yankees Minor League system. Last season, he recorded the most games started (27), most wins (13), most innings (155.1), and most strikeouts (160) among the farm system.

PUZZLER PITCHER: Last season, Boyle brought back an old trend of solving a Rubik's Cube. After getting his teammates invested in Somerset, he brought one to the Major League clubhouse at Spring Training this season. It's become a go to distraction and a competitive outlet. His record solve time is 32 seconds, but he likes to practice before every start.

QUALITY & QUANTITY: Boyle's final ten games in Double-A (2022) were quality starts. Across the three starts prior to the streak, Boyle allowed 21 R (19 ER) over 13.1 IP, equaling an ERA of 12.83. In Boyle's first start vs. Binghamton (5/30), he allowed a career-high 10 runs. In his last non-quality start before the streak vs. the Rumble Ponies on 6/5 he gave up three home runs in the first three innings of the game, before proceeding to retire the final 7 batters he faced to earn his 2nd win of the season.

BOYLE'S NO-NO DUO: In his third career Triple-A start, Boyle threw a seven-inning no-hit against the Worcester Red Sox on August 19, 2021. It was the first no-hitter in the history of Polar Park. Max McDowell was behind the plate that night. Boyle was part of another no-hitter, tossing four no-hit innings in a combined no-no on July 10, 2021 with Hudson Valley (A+) against the Brooklyn Cyclones.
